DEVELOPING A PARTNERSHIP

- BT evaluates the number of children in a specific area and their ability to access a primary school
- In areas where existing educational opportunities are few, BT, partners with the local community
- Together, BT and community construct an eight room school with a kitchen, toilets and soccer field.
- Upon the completion of the school, the building is leased to local government for the day-to-day operations
- Terms of agreement include caps on school fees, the demographics of students served and other specifics.

COST OF EACH SCHOOL: **\$35,000**

THE CHALLENGES

- Meeting demand from interested universities, groups and schools
