The Governor recommends that the general fund reduction implemented in the current year be carried forward as a permanent annual base reduction for the 2008-10 biennium.

#### **Increase Base Operating Support**

The Governor's budget provides additional base operating support for routine costs and rate increases in library materials,

service contracts for high tech scientific and computing equipment, and plant operations as well as faculty and staff support in selected program areas mandated by the *Code of Virginia*.

#### Equipment Trust Funds

\$1.2 million is recommended in the 2008-10 biennium from the Equipment Trust Fund for instructional and research equipment, computers, and network systems hardware.

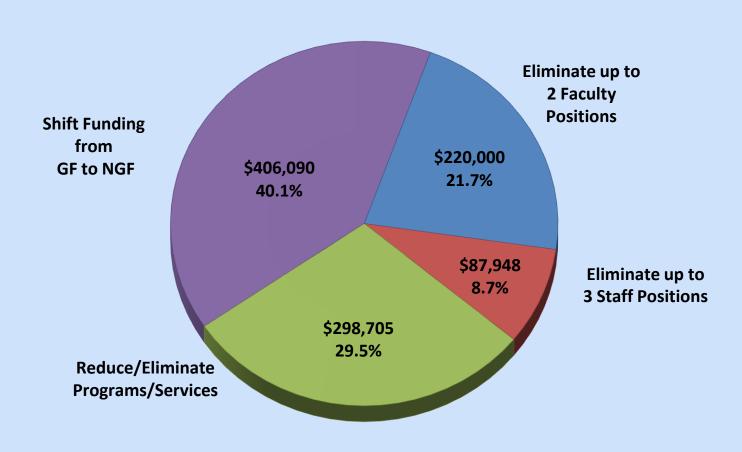
