

WHEREAS, the final section will contain space for various official college functions, faculty and student dining space, and dining accommodations for visiting groups, and student social affairs, and

WHEREAS, In view of the multiple functions which this building will eventually serve, it will gradually assume some of the activities which now take place in the Campus Center,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Visitors approves the naming of the new dining hall "The William and Mary Commons, " and designates this as the permanent name for this building.

At the request of the Rector, President Paschall elaborated on Resolution W-6, Request for Governor's Authorization for Utilization of Proceeds from Sale of Timber for Stadium Improvements. In answer to a question raised by Dr. Ware, he explained that the press box would be placed on the west side of the stadium, and that the sunlight and other factors warranted this location. One modification was made in the first "Resolve" paragraph following the amount of \$35,501 by insertion at that point of the phrase, "or as much thereof as may be the President of the College be deemed appropriate. "
