



Criteria for Deciding to Attend W&M by Residency (1=Not important, 2=Important, 3=Very important)


■ In-State (n=1561) Uut-of-State (n=666)




Criteria for Freshman Deciding to Attend W&M (n=542) (1=Not important, 2=Important, 3=Very important)




Criteria for Freshmen Deciding to Attend W&M by Residency (1=Not important, 2=Important, 3=Very important)




Participation in W&M Activities, Clubs, & Organizations in Past Year (n=2127)
