Sir,

you will see by the Gazette that the Convention has opened all the ports of the French Colonies to the Vessels of the United States and that the produce imported or exported on board ~~Such~~ Vessels Whether in France or in the Colonies shall pay no other duties ^{than} such as are paid on like articles in French Vessels. I pray you will make this known by all opportunities going to America and particularly that you will forward a copy of this letter to the Secretary of State at Philadelphia
