Top Storylines

- William and Mary will travel to face Virginia Tech Tuesday ... It will be the 115th meeting between the two teams, with the Hokies holding a 73-41 advantage in the series ... W&M has won the last two meetings between the two teams ... Last season, the Tribe defeated VT, 60-52, in Williamsburg on Dec. 7, 2002, and the College also took a 48-46 decision in Blacksburg on Nov. 20, 2000.
- W&M is led by first-year head coach **Tony Shaver** ... Shaver put together a record of 358-121 (.747) in an outstanding 17-year career at Division III Hampden-Sydney prior to joining the Tribe ... While there, he led the Tigers to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference championships, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Tournament appearances (including trips to the Final Four in 1999 and 2003).
- Tribe senior forward **Adam Hess** was voted the 2003-04 Colonial Athletic Association Preseason Player of the Year at the league's media day on October 29 in Washington, DC ... This season, Hess leads the CAA in scoring with 21.4 points per game, and is ranked in the top-15 in the league in five other statistical categories ... With 20.1 points per game last season, he is the conference's top-returning scorer and is the only returning first team All-CAA selection.
- Shaver was well-known for his up-tempo style at H-SC and he is continuing to implement that philosophy at W&M ... The Tribe is averaging 73.3 points per game in the early going ... The last season in which W&M averaged at least 70 points per game was the 1995-96 campaign, when the Tribe scored 74.0 points per game ... W&M scored at least 80 points in each of the first three games of the season, the first time that had happened in consecutive games since the start of the 1976-77 campaign.

W&M's Adam Hess Voted CAA Pre-season Player of the Year

Senior forward **Adam Hess** was voted the 2003-04 Colonial Athletic Association's Preseason Player of the Year by the media at the conference's annual media day, held at the Washington, DC ESPNZone on October 29 ... Hess was also projected by *Sporting News* as the league's best player ... No W&M player has ever been named CAA Player of the Year at the end of the season ... Only twice in history has a Tribe men's basketball player been selected as any league's player of the year ... **Jeff Cohen** (1961) and **Tom Jasper** (1971) were each named Southern Conference Player of the Year ... Hess has been unanimously picked to be the only player this season to repeat as a first team All-CAA honoree, including predictions by the conference's coaches and media and numerous publications, including *Athlon*, *Basketball News*, *Lindy's*, *Sporting News*, and *Street & Smith's*.

Improved Cope

One player who has been flourishing under head coach **Tony Shaver** is senior forward **Zeb Cope** ... After averaging 3.5 points, 3.1 rebounds and 12.2 minutes per game in his first three seasons, this year Cope is second on the team with 13.0 points and 32.9 minutes per game, and

first with an average of 7.1 rebounds per game ... He recorded the first double-double of his career at VCU (12/6), with game-highs in points (21) and rebounds (11) ... Given the green light to shoot from the outside, he is connecting on 49.3% of his field goal attempts, more than 80 points higher than his career average entering this season (.410), and is shooting .474 (9-19) from beyond the three-point line, after shooting 1-4 from long range in his first three years.

And He's Smart, Too

Not only is **Adam Hess** one of the top players in the conference and the state, but he also excels in the classroom ... Last season he was named a second team Academic All-American and was picked to the Academic All-District III team ... In addition, Hess earned his second selection to the CAA All-Academic Team and was named the league's first ever Men's Basketball Scholar Athlete of the Year.

What Happened?

W&M had been shooting 76.5% (75-98) from the free throw line in the first five games of the season ... Since then, however, the Tribe has connected on just 45.0% (18-40) in its last two games (both losses) ... The most glaring example of the inexplicable inaccuracy is **Adam Hess** ... A career 77.7% free throw shooter, Hess is just 7-18 (.389) in the last two games.

High Scoring Hess

Four times this season, the high-scoring games of **Adam Hess** have ranked him in the top-20 in the nation in scoring on that particular day ... That includes his 27 points on Nov. 23 against Liberty, the second-most points scored by one player that day, and his 27 against Hampton on Dec. 19, tied for the fourth-best total of the day ... Through Dec. 21, his average of 21.4 ppg was tops in the CAA and tied for 17th in America.

High Praise for Hess

Many people that cover William and Mary and the Colonial Athletic Association know of the abilities of senior forward **Adam Hess**, as evidenced by his selection by the media as the league's preseason player of the year ... Now the national media is also jumping on the bandwagon, starting with a recent piece on the website collegeinsider.com, that focuses on mid-major Division I teams ... In a recent front page article on the site, Matt Drake wrote that he believes Hess may be "the BEST mid-major player in America," adding, "the Michigan native plays with poise and has an excellent shooting stroke, with seemingly unlimited range. Sure there are a lot of players with quicker feet and more pure talent, but few are as complete a player as Hess."

High Scoring Tribe

W&M's 91-point outburst against Liberty was the most points scored by the Tribe since a 92-81 win over Virginia Commonwealth on Jan. 12, 2002 ... It was

also W&M's largest margin of victory since defeating VCU, 85-56, on Feb. 5, 2000.

Tony Shaver Third in Nation

Through Dec. 16, W&M head coach **Tony Shaver** has the third-best winning percentage in the nation among active Division I coaches, taking into account results from every level of college basketball ... With a record of 361-124 (.744), Shaver trails only Roy Williams (Kansas) at 424-101 (.808) and Bo Ryan (Wisconsin) with 432-125 (.776).

Guard the Line

One area that the Tribe is showing significant improvement in this season is its defense of the three-point line ... W&M is allowing opponents to shoot just .306 (44-144) from beyond the three-point line ... In three games this season, W&M opponents have shot under 30.0% from long-range, including a season-low .190 (4-21) by Liberty in the opener ... Last season, Tribe opponents shot .360 (250-695) from beyond the arc ... The 250 three pointers made was by far the most ever allowed in a season by the Tribe ... The previous high was 178 given up in the 2000-01 campaign ... Opposing teams outscored W&M, 750-522, from the three-point line, a difference of 228 points, which was almost twice the margin by which the Tribe was outscored all of last season (119 points).

Tribe Wins Tourney Opener

The Tribe broke a long string of in-season tournament first round losses with the win against St. Francis in the first round of the Red Auerbach Colonial Classic ... The last time the Tribe had won the first game of such an event was Dec. 29, 1981 with a 58-48 win over Auburn

at the Iron Duke Classic in Durham, NC ... Since that season, W&M had played 38 games in 19 in-season tournaments, with a record of 10-28 (.263).

Hess 30-Point Games

Last season, **Adam Hess** set a school record with five 30-point games in a single season ... He also had two games in which he just missed the mark, scoring 29 points ... With 31 points at Campbell on Dec. 30, 2002 and 33 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 2, 2003, he became the first W&M player with 30 or more points in consecutive games since the 1966-67 season, when **Ron Panneton** had 31 against Hampden-Sydney on Jan. 11, 1967 and put up 38 at Richmond on Jan. 14, 1967.

Taking Care of the Ball

The Tribe is averaging just 15.0 turnovers per game this season, continuing a trend from last year ... W&M ranked tied with Akron for 23rd in Division I last season with just 12.5 turnovers per game ... W&M's 349 giveaways that year was the second-fewest in a season since the stat was consistently kept (1975-76 season), trailing only the 1984 season when the Tribe had 340 turnovers.

CAA Openers

The Tribe opened its 19th season of play in the Colonial Athletic Association with a 67-66 overtime win against two-time defending league champions UNCW ... W&M was a charter member of the CAA, which officially started with the 1985-86 season ... The Tribe has a record of 8-11 in CAA openers and has won the last five times that W&M opened the conference season at home.

Head Coach Tony Shaver

On May 2, 2003, the William and Mary athletics department announced the hiring of Tony Shaver as the 30th men's basketball coach in the history of the College.

"Bringing a coach and person the caliber of a Tony Shaver into the William and Mary program certainly makes this an exciting day for the College," said director of athletics Terry Driscoll at the time of the hire. "His resume speaks for itself in terms of his coaching abilities, but beyond that, I believe that he possesses all the intangible qualities that will make him a perfect fit for our school and program."

Shaver came to W&M after coaching for 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. The winningest basketball coach in the program's history, he was named the ODAC and South Region Coach of the Year in 1995, 1999 and 2000, and was picked as the Virginia Sports Information Directors Division II-III Coach of the Year in 1997, 1999 and 2000.

Last season, Shaver took the Tigers to the NCAA Division III Final Four for the second time in his career, as his team finished the season with a record of 28-4, tied for the second-most wins in the program's history. H-SC opened the 2003 season by winning its first 22 games and was ranked as high as second in the nation as it finished the regular season with a record of 23-1.

In 1999, Shaver led H-SC to the national championship game, where the Tigers lost by one point in double-overtime to Wisconsin-Platteville. The team finished with a record of 29-3, setting a school record for the most wins in a single season.

Together with his team's successes on the court, Shaver also has a firm commitment to his players' success in the classroom. In 1999, one of his charges, Jack Jirak, was named the ODAC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was also awarded the Gammon Cup as the top-student-athlete at the college. Two of Shaver's players, David Hobbs (1999)

and Russell Turner (1992) earned Academic All-America honors. A number of his players have been named to the Academic All-ODAC squad, including six student-athletes in 1998.

Shaver first led the Tigers to the national postseason in 1988-89, just his third season as the team's head coach. That year, H-SC won the ODAC championship, ending the season with a 21-8 record.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. He was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally

a walk-on, he earned a scholarship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious Butch Bennett Award, presented to the team's most outstanding freshman.

A native of High Point, North Carolina, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher (22), a senior pitcher on W&M's baseball team, Austin (18) and Jackson (12).

Hampton 79, William and Mary 72

Dec. 19, 2003 • Williamsburg, VA • William and Mary Hall

Hampton forward Devin Green led all scorers with a career-high 33 points and also had a game-high 10 rebounds as the Pirates defeated the William and Mary men's basketball team 79-72, at William and Mary Hall. The Pirates improve to 3-7 on the season, while the Tribe falls to 3-4.

The first half was a series of runs for both teams as each shot well from the field. The Tribe finished the first half shooting 53.1% (17-32), running out to a 12-6 lead at the 17:06 mark on a three-pointer by sophomore guard **Taylor Mokris**, but the Pirates would use a run of their own to cut into the Tribe's lead, getting as close as 16-15 with 14:25 left in the half, using consecutive three pointers from Rodney Hughes, Green and Jeff Granger. The College responded with 12 unanswered points in less than three minutes, ending with a three by senior forward **Zeb Cope** to give the Tribe its biggest lead of the game, a 13-point, 28-15 advantage.

Hampton, however, survived the Tribe's run and answered with one of its own, a 16-3 romp to tie the contest at 31. After a layup by senior forward **Adam Hess** and the ensuing free throw after he was fouled gave the College a three-point lead, Donald Didlake tied it back up with a three pointer, and a free throw by Jared Woodley gave the Pirates their first lead of the game at 35-34 with 4:42 left in the half. It was short-lived, however, as back-to-back layups from freshman forward **Corey Cofield** gave W&M a three-point lead at 38-35. Another Hampton three point field goal, this one from Granger, tied the game again, but Cofield again gave the Tribe the advantage, converting a layup while being fouled, and then hitting the free throw to give W&M a 41-38 advantage with 2:15 left. After a missed Pirate basket, Hess scored on a layup with 1:56 left, and two Hampton free throws by Green ended the first half with the Tribe leading, 43-41.

The second half was a seesaw affair, that featured eight ties and seven lead changes, as neither team led by more than four points for most of the period. Two free throws from Granger gave the Pirates a 69-68 lead with 4:50 left and HU would never trail again, as Green made one of two free throws and followed that up with a dunk to put the Pirates ahead, 72-68 with 3:14 remaining. A Hess free throw put the Tribe within three, 72-69, with 2:05 to play, but W&M would get no closer, falling to the Pirates, 79-72.

William and Mary's Hess led the Tribe with 27 points, while Mokris had 16 and Cofield added 13. Granger had 14 points to aid Hampton's cause. The difference in the contest came at the free throw line, with Hampton converting 22 of 30 (73.3%) of its foul shots, while the Tribe connected on just 12 of 26 (46.2%). The Pirates out-rebounded W&M, 43-41, and had 16 turnovers to the Tribe's 17.
