### Top Storylines

- William and Mary will face Longwood for the first time in school history on Wednesday, Dec. 1 at W&M Hall ... The Lancers are the second of three teams that the Tribe will face for the first time in the regular season ... W&M opened the year with an 84-71 win over Hartford in the first game between the two schools ... The Green and Gold will face Kentucky for the first time in Lexington on Dec. 22.
- Sophomore forward **Corey Cofield**, the 2004 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and the conference's player of the week on Nov. 22, leads the Tribe in scoring (16.3 ppg), rebounding (6.8 rpg) and field goal percentage (.559) ... His .844 (27-32) free throw percentage ranks second on the team and is much improved from his .634 performance from the line last season.
- Junior forward **Hawley Smith** is second on the team with 13.8 points and 6.3 rebounds per game ... Smith leads the team with nine steals and a .846 free throw percentage ... In his first season playing for W&M after transferring to the College from Temple, Smith is the only Tribe player to have scored in double figures all four games this year.
- The Tribe's newcomers have played very important roles for the College this season ... After top scorer Cofield (16.3 ppg), a sophomore, the next four leading scorers are in their first season wearing the Green and Gold ... Smith is second with 13.8 ppg, while freshmen **Edwin Ofori Attah** (11.8 ppg), **Nathan Mann** (8.0 ppg) and **Laimis Kisielius** (6.3 ppg) round out the top five.
- Head coach **Tony Shaver** is in his second season at W&M ... Shaver came to the College after a very successful 17-year career at Hampden-Sydney, where he compiled a record of 358-121 (.747), including eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference championships, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, advancing to the national championship game in 1999 and the Final Four again in 2003.

The Tribe opened the season by winning the inaugural W&M Tip-Off Classic with victories over Hartford and Radford ... It is the Tribe's fifth regular season tournament title in school history ... The last time the College won a regular season tournament was in the 1981-82 season, as the Green and Gold defeated Auburn and Davidson to take the 1981 Iron Duke Classic ... W&M is now 39-69 (.361) all-time in regular season tournament games.

## Cofield Named CAA Player of the Week

Last Monday (Nov. 22), sophomore forward **Corey Cofield** received the first Colonial Athletic Association Player of the Week award for the 2004-05 season ... A preseason second team all-league selection, Cofield averaged 22.0 points and 8.0 rebounds in the first two games of the season, leading the Tribe to the W&M Tip-Off Classic championship ... It is the first player of the week honor for Cofield, the 2004 CAA Rookie of the Year, who was picked as the league's rookie of the week three times last season ... Cofield was also voted as the W&M Tip-Off Classic Most Valuable Player ... He leads the team this season with 16.3 points and 6.8 rebounds per game while shooting .559 (19-34) from the field and .844 (27-32) from the free throw line.

## High Scoring Tribe

Under head coach Tony Shaver's fast-paced style of play, the Tribe has scored 80 or more points in nine of his 32 games at W&M, including the first two games this season ... This is the second straight season that the College has opened with two games in the 80s ... The last time that happened, before Shaver came to W&M last season, was the

start of the 1980-81 campaign, with an 85-64 win over Pace (Nov. 29) and an 84-56 win over Christopher Newport ... The Tribe scored 80 or more points seven times last season, the first time a W&M team had done that since the 1995-96 campaign, when the Green and Gold had 80 or more points in nine games ... With an average of 71.7 points per game last season, the Tribe averaged more than 70 points a game for the first time since scoring at a 74.0 ppg clip in 1995-96.

## Best Things in Life are Free (Throws)

W&M has enjoyed a tremendous advantage from the free throw line this season, with the Tribe converting 73.6% (92-125) of its opportunities from the line ... The school record for free throw percentage in a season is .772 (470-609), set in the 1982-83 campaign ... The only other time the College made over 75 percent of its foul shots was in the 1972-73 season (483-636, .759) ... Last season W&M was 442-634 (.697) from the charity stripe ... The Tribe has taken nearly twice as many foul shots as the opposition this season (125 to 66) and is outscoring opponents by 12.0 points per game from the line (23.0 to 11.0) ... Three players who have attempted 10 or more free throws this season are shooting at least .800, led by junior **Hawley Smith**, who is 22-26 (.846) ... He is just ahead of sophomore **Corey Cofield**, who is shooting .844 (27-32) from the line, after shooting .634 (118-186) from the line last year.

## Season Openers

After the season-opening 84-71 win over Hartford, W&M is 53-47 (.530) all-time in the first game of the year, and has won six of its last nine season-opening games ... Last season, Tony Shaver became the 12th head coach to win his first game at the College, as the Tribe defeated Liberty, 91-64, on November 23 ... This is the third straight year and the fifth time in the last six seasons that the Tribe has started the year in W&M Hall.

## ACC Returns to W&M Hall

The Tribe's game against Virginia Tech on Nov. 28 was the first time that an Atlantic Coast Conference team had played in Williamsburg in almost eight years ... The last time was Dec. 4, 1996, when W&M fell to No. 25 Virginia, 75-64 ... The Tribe's last win over an ACC team was Dec. 5, 1984, when W&M defeated Virginia, 54-53, in Williamsburg.

## Corey Cofield Voted to Preseason All-CAA Second Team

In a vote of the league's media at CAA Media Day on Oct. 27, sophomore forward **Corey Cofield** was picked to the all-conference second team ... The 2004 CAA Rookie of the Year and third team all-league pick at the end of last season, Cofield is the Tribe's top-returning scorer and rebounder, averaging 13.2 points and 6.6 rebounds as a freshman ... Cofield also led the team with six double-doubles in his first year of collegiate basketball.

## Back-to-Back Games

This is the second straight season, and the third time in the last four years, that the Tribe has opened the season with games on consecutive days ... It is the first time in almost 50 years that the College has opened a season with back-to-back home games on consecutive days ... W&M began the 1956-57 season with home wins over The Citadel (87-74) on Nov. 30 and Hampden-Sydney (98-81) on Dec. 1 ... Last season, the Tribe opened the year with a 91-64 win over Liberty on Nov. 23 before falling on the road to Radford, 89-86, on Nov. 24 ... The Tribe opened at the Red Raider Classic in 2001-02, with a 75-55 loss to Texas Tech on Nov. 16 and a 76-55 defeat at the hands of Northern Iowa on Nov. 17.

## Tribe Hosts First Regular Season Tournament

This season's inaugural W&M Tip-Off Classic was the first regular season tournament ever to be hosted by the College and was first men's basketball tournament of

any kind to be played at W&M Hall since the Tribe hosted the ECAC South Tournament in 1985 ... W&M also played home quarterfinal games in the 1975, 1976 and 1977 Southern Conference and the 1980 and 1981 ECAC South tournaments ... W&M Hall was the location of NCAA Tournament first round games in 1972 and 1973, although W&M did not play in either of those games.

## Happy Birthday

## Head Coach Tony Shaver

William and Mary head coach Tony Shaver is in his second season at the helm of the Tribe men's basketball program. Officially hired on May 2, 2003, Shaver is the 31st men's basketball coach in the history of the College.

"Bringing a coach and person the caliber of a Tony Shaver into the William and Mary program certainly makes this an exciting day for the College," said director of athletics Terry Driscoll at the time of the hire. "His resume speaks for itself in terms of his coaching abilities, but beyond that, I believe that he possesses all the intangible qualities that will make him a perfect fit for our school and program."

Although the Tribe did not have a winning record in 2004, there were a number of highlights that foreshadow the successes that W&M will soon experience under Shaver. In his first game at the College, the Tribe pounded Liberty, 91-64, while shooting 54.0 percent from the field. Shaver also won his first ever Colonial Athletic Association contest, as the Tribe knocked off two-time defending league champion UNC Wilmington, 67-66, in overtime. In his first contest against a nationally-ranked opponent, W&M also performed well, leading No. 15 Pittsburgh by 10 points midway through the first half, before the Panthers, who attempted 28 more free throws than the Tribe, won 70-55.

There were individual successes as well for the Green and Gold. 2004 graduate Adam Hess became the first player in school history to lead the CAA in scoring. An outstanding student and athlete, Hess was named the CAA Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year (for all sports) and was a first team Academic All-America and all-conference selection. Current sophomore Corey Cofield was voted the CAA Rookie of the Year, leading all freshmen in the league in points, rebounds and field goal percentage. Several players saw significant improvement from their prior year, most notably 2004 grad Zeb Cope, who scored more than three times his career average entering the season, and senior Nick D'Antoni, who started every game and ended the year nine assists away from breaking the school record for a season, after averaging just 12.2 minutes per game his previous year.

Shaver came to W&M after coaching 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. The winningest basketball coach in the program's history, he was named the ODAC and South Region Coach of the Year in 1995, 1999 and 2000, and was picked as the Virginia Sports Information Directors Division II-III Coach of the Year in 1997, 1999 and 2000.

In 2003, Shaver took the Tigers to the NCAA Division III Final Four, as his team finished with a record of 28-4, tied for the second-most wins in the program's history. In 1999, Shaver led H-SC to the national championship, where the Tigers lost by one point in double-overtime to Wisconsin-Platteville. The team finished 29-3, setting a school record for most wins in a season.

Shaver also has a firm commitment to his players' success in the classroom. In 1999, one of his charges, Jack Jirak, was named the ODAC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was also awarded the Gammon Cup as the top-student-athlete at the college. Two of Shaver's players, David Hobbs (1999) and Russell Turner (1992) earned Academic All-America honors. A number of his players have been named to the Academic All-ODAC squad, including six student-athletes in 1998.

Shaver first led the Tigers to the national postseason in 1988-89, just his third season as the team's head coach. That year, H-SC won the ODAC championship, ending the season with a 21-8 record.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. He was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally a walk-on, he earned a scholarship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious

Butch Bennett Award, presented to the team's most outstanding freshman.

A native of High Point, North Carolina, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher (23), a standout pitcher on the Tribe's baseball team, who is currently pitching with the Chicago Cubs organization, Austin (19) and Jackson (13).
