Top Storvlines

- William and Mary will face Longwood for the first time in school history on Wednesday,
 Dec. 1 at W&M Hall ... The Lancers are the second of three teams that the Tribe will face
 for the first time in the regular season ... W&M opened the year with an 84-71 win over
 Hartford in the first game between the two schools ... The Green and Gold will face Kentucky for the first time in Lexington on Dec. 22.
- Sophomore forward **Corey Cofield**, the 2004 Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and the conference's player of the week on Nov. 22, leads the Tribe in scoring (16.3 ppg), rebounding (6.8 rpg) and field goal percentage (.559) ... His .844 (27-32) free throw percentage ranks second on the team and is much improved from his .634 performance from the line last season.
- Junior forward Hawley Smith is second on the team with
 13.8 points and 6.3 rebounds per game ... Smith leads the team with nine steals and a .846
 free throw percentage ... In his first season playing for W&M after transferring to the College from Temple, Smith is the only Tribe player to have scored in double figures all four games this year.
- The Tribe's newcomers have played very important roles for the College this season ... After top scorer Cofield (16.3 ppg), a sophomore, the next four leading scorers are in their first season wearing the Green and Gold ... Smith is second with 13.8 ppg, while freshmen **Edwin Ofori Attah** (11.8 ppg), **Nathan Mann** (8.0 ppg) and **Laimis Kisielius** (6.3 ppg) round out the top five.
- Head coach **Tony Shaver** is in his second season at W&M ... Shaver came to the College after a very successful 17-year career at Hampden-Sydney, where he compiled a record of 358-121 (.747), including eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference championships, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, advancing to the national championship game in 1999 and the Final Four again in 2003.

W&M has enjoyed a tremendous advantage from the free throw line this season, with the Tribe converting 73.6% (92-125) of its opportunities from the line ... The school record for free throw percentage in a season is .772 (470-609), set in the 1982-83 campaign ... The only other time the College made over 75 percent of its foul shots was in the 1972-73 season (483-636, .759) ... Last season W&M was 442-634 (.697) from the charity stripe ... The Tribe has taken nearly twice as many foul shots as the opposition this season (125 to 66) and is outscoring opponents by 12.0 points per game from the line (23.0 to 11.0) ... Three players who have attempted 10 or more free throws this season are shooting at least .800, led by junior Hawley Smith, who is 22-26 (.846) ... He is just ahead of sophomore Corey Cofield, who is shooting .844 (27-32) from the line, after shooting .634 (118-186) from the line last year.

Head Coach Tony Shaver

William and Mary head coach Tony Shaver is in his second season at the helm of the Tribe men's basketball program. Officially hired on May 2, 2003, Shaver is the 31st men's basketball coach in the history of the College.

"Bringing a coach and person the caliber of a Tony Shaver into the William and Mary program certainly makes this an exciting day for the College," said director of athletics Terry Driscoll at the time of the hire. "His resume speaks for itself in terms of his coaching abilities, but beyond that, I believe that he possesses all the intangible qualities that will make him a perfect fit for our school and program."

Although the Tribe did not have a winning record in 2004, there were a number of highlights that foreshadow the successes that W&M will soon experience under Shaver. In his first game at the College, the Tribe pounded Liberty, 91-64, while shooting 54.0 percent from the field. Shaver also won his first ever Colonial Athletic Association contest, as the Tribe knocked off two-time defending league champion UNC Wilmington, 67-66, in overtime. In his first contest against a nationally-ranked opponent, W&M also performed well, leading No. 15 Pittsburgh by 10 points midway through the first half, before the Panthers, who attempted 28 more free throws than the Tribe, won 70-55.

There were individual successes as well for the Green and Gold. 2004 graduate Adam Hess became the first player in school history to lead the CAA in scoring. An outstanding student and athlete, Hess was named the CAA Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year (for all sports) and was a first team Academic All-America and all-conference selection. Current sophomore Corey Cofield was voted the CAA Rookie of the Year, leading all freshmen in the league in points, rebounds and field goal percentage. Several players saw significant improvement from their prior year, most notably 2004 grad Zeb Cope, who scored more than three times his career average entering the season, and senior Nick D'Antoni, who started every game and ended the year nine assists away from breaking the school record for a season, after averaging just 12.2 minutes per game his previous year.

Shaver came to W&M after coaching 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. The winningest basketball coach in the program's history, he was named the ODAC and South Region Coach of the Year in 1995, 1999 and 2000, and was picked as the Virginia Sports Information Directors Division II-III Coach of the Year in 1997, 1999 and 2000.

In 2003, Shaver took the Tigers to the NCAA Division III Final Four, as his team finished with a record of 28-4, tied for the second-most wins in the program's history. In 1999, Shaver led H-SC to the national championship, where the Tigers lost by one point in double-overtime to Wisconsin-Platteville. The team finished 29-3, setting a school record for most wins in a season.

Shaver also has a firm commitment to his players' success in the classroom. In 1999, one of his charges, Jack Jirak, was named the ODAC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was also awarded the Gammon Cup as the top-student-athlete at the college. Two of Shaver's players, David Hobbs (1999) and Russell Turner (1992) earned Academic All-America honors. A number of his players have been named to the Academic All-ODAC squad, including six student-athletes in 1998.

Shaver first led the Tigers to the national postseason in 1988-89, just his third season as the team's head coach. That year, H-SC won the ODAC championship, ending the season with a 21-8 record.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. He was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally a walk-on, he earned a scholarship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious

Butch Bennett Award, presented to the team's most outstanding freshman.

A native of High Point, North Carolina, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher (23), a standout pitcher on the Tribe's baseball team, who is currently pitching with the Chicago Cubs organization, Austin (19) and Jackson (13).

Freshman **Edwin Ofori Attah** scored a team-high 22 points in his first collegiate game to lead four Tribe players in double-figures, as W&M defeated Hartford, 84-71, in the second game of the W&M Tip-off Classic.

Ofori Attah shot 50% from the floor (7-for-14), including 4-of-6 from behind the three-point line, coming off the bench in his first college game.

Sophomore **Corey Cofield**, the 2004 CAA Rookie of the Year, picked up where he left off last season, scoring 20 points on 7-for-12 shooting from the floor and sharing team-high honors with six rebounds. Cofield added two assists and a block and was a perfect 6-for-6 from the foul line. He capped a strong first-half effort with a put-back layin in the closing seconds of the opening half to give W&M a 32-27 lead at the break.

The Tribe quickly turned a five-point halftime lead into an 18-point advantage in the first six minutes of the second half, using a 13-1 run to extend the lead to 52-34 with just under 15 minutes remaining. The spurt was capped by three consecutive treys, the first two by Ofori Attah, and the last by junior **Hawley Smith**.

After the Hawks cut the deficit to 14, an Ofori Attah free throw and a Cofield three-point play pushed the lead back to 18 with 10:48 remaining. The W&M lead grew to 22, its biggest of the game, just over a minute later, as Cofield, junior **Taylor Mokris** and Ofori Attach connected on six straight opportunities from the foul line, giving the Tribe a 64-42 lead.

Hartford trimmed the Tribe advantage to 11 on back-to-back three-pointers from junior guard Aaron Cook, cutting the deficit to 65-54 with 6:12 left on the clock, but a pair of free throws from Mokris and junior **Adam Dutton** lay up pushed the lead back to 15.

The Hawks got as close as 10 with 2:07 left, but another pair of Mokris free throws and two-straight Ofori Attah field goals put the game out of reach at 79-66 with 50 seconds remaining.

Joining Ofori Attah and Cofield in double-figures were Smith and freshman Laimis Kisielius. Smith poured in a career-high 19 points, which included a 9-for-12 performance from the charity stripe, and pulled down six boards. Kisielius was 3-of-5 from the floor and 4-for-4 from the stripe for 10 points in his first collegiate game.

Mokris did all of his damage from the foul line, going 6-for-6 on the evening. As a team, the Tribe shot 76.2% from the foul line (32-for-42), including 23-for-27 in the second half.

Game #2 William and Mary 81, Radford 76 Nov. 20. 2004 • Williamsburg, VA • William and Mary Hall

Corey Cofield recorded a double-double with 24 points and 10 rebounds, both game-highs, and **Nathan Mann**'s hot shooting in the second half led William and Mary to an 81-76 victory over Radford in the championship game of the W&M Tip-off Classic at William and Mary Hall.

Cofield shot an impressive 7-for-9 from the field and converted 10-of-14 free throw opportunities in the title game to earn tournament MVP honors, as the Tribe captured the title in the first regular season tournament ever hosted by the College.

Trailing by as many as 10 points in the second half, Cofield, Mann and **Hawley Smith** keyed a second-half surge that erased the Tribe deficit at the 5:42 mark. Smith knocked down a field goal at the 8:18 mark to cut the Highlanders' lead to five, and then nailed a pair of free throws to shrink Radford's lead to three. The Highlanders restored their lead to five just over a minute later, before Mann's first three-pointer at the 6:11 mark and pair of free throws from Cofield brought about a 69-69 tie.

With just under five minutes remaining, Mann dialed long distance once again, giving W&M its first lead of the game, 72-69, since the 17-minute mark of the second half, when the Tribe led 43-42. Cofield, Mann and **Laimis Kisielius** all hit clutch free throws down the stretch to preserve the victory. Mann finished with 14 points on 4-of-9 shooting, with all nine attempts coming from behind the arc. He added a team-high five assists and four rebounds.

Smith scored in double figures for the second straight game with 15 to join Cofield on the all-tournament team, while Kisielius chipped in with 11 to give W&M four players in double figures.

Both teams struggled from the floor early, as W&M hit on just 2-of-8 attempts from the field in the opening six minutes, while the Highlanders managed only a 3-for-7 effort. Trailing 7-4, Radford began to heat up, hitting five straight field goals, including seven points by all-tournament team selection Olumuyiwa Poopoola, to spur a 13-0 run and take a 17-7 lead with just under 12 minutes remaining in the opening half.

The Radford lead grew to as many as 11 after six straight points from Chris Oliver, another all-tournament team selection with 23 points, before the Tribe began to chip away.

Cofield and Kisielius each knocked down a pair of free throws to cut the deficit to six, and a Kisielius lay-in at the 5:17 mark trimmed the Highlanders' advantage to four, before back-to-back jumpers from Cofield had the Tribe within one at 31-30 with 2:37 remaining in the half.

Taylor Mokris drained two of his three first-half treys in the final two minutes, including one in the closing seconds to knot the score at 36-36 heading into the break.

The loss was the first of the season for W&M, which fell to 2-1 on the year. The Fighting Camels improved to 1-1 with the win.

The Camels opened the contest with an 11-1 lead and never looked back, going ahead by as many as 17 points in the first half before taking a 12-point, 45-33 advantage into halftime. The Tribe started to come back in the second, using a 17-10 run over the first 10 minutes, ending with a layup by junior Nate Loehrke, to close to within five at 55-50. Jamon Gordon poured in a game-high 20 points and Carlos Dixon added 18 to lead Virginia Tech's men's basketball team to an 80-63 victory over William and Mary.

As the first ACC team to visit W&M Hall since 1996, the Hokies outscored W&M 18-5 over the final five minutes of the first half to extend a four-point lead to a 42-25 advantage at the break. Junior Hawley Smith knocked down a pair of free throws with 5:40 remaining in the opening half to pull the Tribe within 24-20, before the Tech run

Dixon scored eight of his 11 first-half points in a 14-3 Hokie spurt, after a put-back layup from Smith cut the Tech lead to 28-22 with four minutes remaining.

Freshman Edwin Ofori Attah buried a three-pointer, his only field goal of the first half, with just under three minutes remaining that made the score 32-25, but Virginia Tech held the Tribe scoreless the rest of the way, using a 10-0 run to close the period.

Gordon was a perfect three-for-three from behind the arc in the second half, as the Hokies opened up as much as a 22-point lead and held off any chance of a Tribe comeback.

After sophomore Corey Cofield sank a pair from the foul line with 12:38 remaining in the game to cut the Tribe's deficit to 53-39, Gordon hit on back-to-back three-pointers to push the lead back to 20.

W&M closed to within 16 at the 7:22 mark after a pair of free throws from junior Adam Dutton, but Dixon answered with another three for the Hokies, who shot 50% (9-for-18) from behind the arc in the game.

Senior Nick D'Antoni cut the deficit to 73-56 with two free throws with 3:55 remaining, but Gordon responded with his final trey, again extending the lead back to

Smith recorded his first career double-double with 10 points and a game-high 11 rebounds, surpassing his previous career-high of seven boards with eight in the first half alone, while Cofield paced the Tribe with 14 points, including an eight-for-eight effort at the charity stripe.

Junior Nate Loehrke narrowly missed his first career double-double with 10 points and a career-high nine rebounds in 18 minutes, and freshman Nathan Mann tallied 11, spurred by a 3-for-4 effort from three-point range, to give W&M four in doublefigures.
