### Top Storylines

- William and Mary will play its final home game of the season Saturday at 7:00 PM against long-time rival Old Dominion ... The Tribe comes into the game with a record of 6-18 overall, and tied with James Madison and Towson for eighth place in the Colonial Athletic Association with a 2-13 league record ... The Monarchs are 23-4 overall and lead the CAA with a 13-2 conference mark.
- Saturday's game will be the 65th meeting between W&M and Old Dominion ... ODU leads the series, 50-14 ... The two teams have split the season series in both of the last two seasons, with each team winning at home ... The Tribe has won two straight and three of its last four against the Monarchs in W&M Hall ... Last season, W&M defeated ODU, 86-77, in Williamsburg on Jan. 26, 2004 ... Earlier this season, the Monarchs beat the Tribe, 69-56, in Norfolk on Dec. 4 ... The two teams have met at least once every year, beginning with the 1973-74 campaign ... ODU is W&M's most-often faced opponent in the CAA.
- Wednesday W&M crushed James Madison, 80-54 ... Sophomore forward **Corey Cofield** led all scorers with 24 points and tied junior forward **Hawley Smith** with a game-high eight rebounds ... Rookie forward **Laimis Kisielius** also scored in double figures with 12 rebounds ... The 26 point margin of victory was the most for a Tribe against a CAA opponent since defeating Virginia Commonwealth by 29, 85-56, Feb. 5, 2000 in Williamsburg.
- Cofield leads the Tribe in scoring (13.0 ppg), rebounding (6.6 rpg), field goal percentage (.498) and free throw percentage (.826) ... He ranks 17th in school history in career rebounds per game (6.6), while his free throw percentage this season is 13th in W&M's record book.
- Smith, is second on the team with 9.0 points and 5.4 rebounds per game ... D'Antoni leads the team with 2.7 assists per game ... Including Smith, in his first season at W&M after transferring from Temple, four of the Tribe's top five scorers are new to the team this year ... Freshmen **Laimis Kisielius** (8.7 ppg), Mann (8.2 ppg) and **Edwin Ofori Attah** (7.2 ppg) round out the top five.

## Cofield Leads Tribe in Points, Boards and Shooting Percentage

2004 CAA Rookie of the Year **Corey Cofield**, is again playing well this season, leading W&M in a variety of statistical categories ... The sophomore forward leads the team in scoring (13.0 ppg) and rebounding (6.6 rpg) and is tied with sophomore center **Brian Hutt** for the team lead in blocks (0.67 per game, 16 overall) ... Cofield is also leading the team with a .498 field goal percentage and is shooting a team-best .826 (109-132) from the free throw line, 13th-best in a season at W&M and a significant improvement from his .634 FT% last season ... The CAA Player of the Week in the first week of this season, Cofield has 681 points (13.1 ppg) and 344 rebounds (6.6 rpg) in his 52-game career ... Cofield recorded his ninth career double-double with 21 points and 12 rebounds at UNC Wilmington (Feb. 9).

## Improving With Age

Freshman forward **Laimis Kisielius** hasn't shown any signs of hitting the proverbial wall in his rookie season ... After averaging 7.1 points and a .367 field goal percentage through the first 16 games of the year, he has been heating up lately, averaging 11.9 points to go with a .397 FG% in the last eight contests ... Including his career-high 23-point showing at UNCW (Feb. 9), Kisielius has led the Tribe in scoring in three of the last six games ... Overall this season, he is averaging 8.7 ppg and a .380 FG%, and is second on the team—and seventh in the CAA—with an .793 free throw percentage.

## Tough Transfer

W&M junior forward **Hawley Smith** is the most recent in a long line of significant transfers to the College from other Division I programs ... Per NCAA regulations, Smith sat out last season, following two seasons at Temple University ... He is second on the team with 9.0 points and 5.4 rebounds per game ... W&M has had at least one Division I transfer on the active roster all but one year since the start of the 1995-96 campaign, all of whom have been significant contributors with starting experience ... The trend began with the arrival of **Bobby Fitzgibbons** (Wake Forest), **David Grabuloff** (Florida State) and **Sam Steen** (Loyola [MD]) in 1995-96 and continued with two-time first team All-CAA selection **Adam Hess** (Eastern Michigan), who graduated last season ... Currently sitting out this year is guard **Adam Payton** (Vanderbilt), who will be eligible to play for W&M next year.

## D'Antoni Ranks Ninth at W&M

Senior guard **Nick D'Antoni** is tied with **Ron Satterthwaite** (1974-77) for eighth in school history with 331 ... Next up for D'Antoni is **David Cox** (1992-95), who is seventh at W&M with 336 assists ... The W&M record is held by **Scott Coval** (1983-86) with 409 career assists ... The nephew of current Phoenix Suns head coach Mike D'Antoni, Nick is averaging 3.25 assists per game in his career, the fifth-best mark in school history ... His career 1.47 assist-to-turnover ratio is third-best in W&M history ... Last season, he totaled 159 assists, second-most in school history and just nine away from tying the school record of 168 set by Coval in 1985.

Junior forward **Hawley Smith**, a transfer from Temple, is second on the team in scoring with 9.0 ppg ... He is followed by freshmen **Laimis Kisielius** (8.7 ppg), **Nathan Mann** (8.2 ppg) and **Edwin Ofori Attah** (7.2 ppg).

## D'Antoni Appears in 100th Career Game

Senior guard **Nick D'Antoni** appeared in the 100th game of his career at UNCW (2/9) ... Now with 78 starts at W&M, D'Antoni has now played in 52 consecutive contests (102 overall) and missed just five games in his college career ... Next on the team in terms of total career W&M games is senior guard **Reid Markham** with 81 ... Junior forward **Hawley Smith** has played in 86 games, although only the 24 this season have been in a W&M uniform ... The last

A league-high 24.9 percent (391 of 1569) of the Tribe's points are coming from the charity stripe ... The next closest percentage of points from the line is James Madison, with 22.4 (310 of 1387) ... The College has three players ranked in the top eight in the CAA in free throw percentage, led by sophomore forward **Corey Cofield**, who is third in the conference (and 15th in school history) at .826 (109-132) ... Freshman forward **Laimis Kisielius** is seventh in the league at .797 (63-79), while junior forward **Hawley Smith** is eighth (.793, 69-87) ... ## Tough Competition

W&M played two of the nation's best teams in the non-conference portion of the schedule with games at Kentucky (Dec. 22) and North Carolina (Jan. 2) ... Two of the most storied programs in college basketball history, UK (1876-577-1, .765) and UNC (1827-677, .730) entered the 2004-05 campaign ranked first and second, respectively, in Division I history for most wins and highest winning percentage ... The Tribe joined Indiana and Tennessee as the only teams in the nation to face both Carolina and Kentucky this regular season, and was the only team to play them both on the road ... This is the first time since the 1995-96 campaign that W&M faced two nationally-ranked teams in the same season ... That year, W&M lost to No. 15 Virginia (87-58) and No. 22 Virginia Tech (71-66).

## Winning with Defense

Despite head coach **Tony Shaver's** preference for a fast-paced, high-offense style of play, the Tribe proved it could also win a defensive struggle, grinding out a 60-51 win over Hampton on Dec. 30 ... The Pirates' 18 field goals, .333 field goal percentage and 51 points are all season lows for a W&M opponent this season ... The 51 points allowed was the Tribe's best defensive effort since a 54-51 win over George Mason on Feb. 18, 2002 ... It is the first time in almost 50 years that the College has opened a season with back-to-back home games on consecutive days ... W&M began the 1956-57 season with home wins over The Citadel (87-74) on Nov. 30 and Hampden-Sydney (98-81) on Dec. 1 ... Last season, the Tribe opened the year with a 91-64 win over Liberty on Nov. 23 before falling on the road to Radford, 89-86, on Nov. 24 ... The Tribe opened at the Red Raider Classic in 2001-02, with a 75-55 loss to Texas Tech on Nov. 16 and a 76-55 defeat at the hands of Northern Iowa on Nov. 17.

### Tribe Hosts First Regular Season Tournament

This season's inaugural W&M Tip-Off Classic was the first regular season tournament ever to be hosted by the College and was the first men's basketball tournament of any kind to be played at W&M Hall since the Tribe hosted the ECAC South Tournament in 1985 ... W&M also played home quarterfinal games in the 1975, 1976 and 1977 Southern Conference and the 1980 and 1981 ECAC South tournaments ... W&M Hall was the location of NCAA Tournament first round games in 1972 and 1973, although W&M did not play

in either of those games.

### W&M Prolific From Line vs. Hartford

The Tribe was 32-41 (.780) from the free throw line in the season-opener against Hartford (11/19) ... That was the first time that the Green and Gold had made 30 or more free throws, or attempted at least 40 foul shots, since going 34-43 from the charity stripe against James Madison on Jan. 24, 2001 ... The most free throws the Tribe attempted in a game all last season was 34 against Delaware on Feb. 11.

### Tribe Picked Eighth in CAA Preseason Media Poll

W&M was predicted to finish eighth in the league in a poll of the CAA's media outlets last month ... Old Dominion was picked to finish first in the conference, receiving 13 of 24 first-place votes ... Last season the Tribe ended the season tied for eighth in the CAA, after being picked ninth in the preseason media poll.

The expansion will give the CAA a geographic footprint that extends from Boston to Atlanta ... The league will also have a presence in six of the top nine media markets (#1 New York, #4 Philadelphia, #6 Boston, #8 Washington, DC and #9 Atlanta) ... Delaware, Drexel, Hofstra and Towson all left the America East to become members of the CAA for the 2001-02 campaign.

## Head Coach Tony Shaver

William and Mary head coach Tony Shaver is in his second season at the helm of the Tribe men's basketball program. Officially hired on May 2, 2003, Shaver is the 31st men's basketball coach in the history of the College.

"Bringing a coach and person the caliber of a Tony Shaver into the William and Mary program certainly makes this an exciting day for the College," said director of athletics Terry Driscoll at the time of the hire. "His resume speaks for itself in terms of his coaching abilities, but beyond that, I believe that he possesses all the intangible qualities that will make him a perfect fit for our school and program."

Although the Tribe did not have a winning record in 2004, there were a number of highlights that foreshadow the successes that W&M will soon experience under Shaver. In his first game at the College, the Tribe pounded Liberty, 91-64, while shooting 54.0 percent from the field. Shaver also won his first ever Colonial Athletic Association contest, as the Tribe knocked off two-time defending league champion UNC Wilmington, 67-66, in overtime. In his first contest against a nationally-ranked opponent, W&M also performed well, leading No. 15 Pittsburgh by 10 points midway through the first half, before the Panthers, who attempted 28 more free throws than the Tribe, won 70-55.

There were individual successes as well for the Green and Gold. 2004 graduate Adam Hess became the first player in school history to lead the CAA in scoring. An outstanding student and athlete, Hess was named the CAA Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year (for all sports) and was a first team Academic All-America and all-conference selection. Current sophomore Corey Cofield was voted the CAA Rookie of the Year, leading all freshmen in the league in points, rebounds and field goal percentage. Several players saw significant improvement from their prior year, most notably 2004 grad Zeb Cope, who scored more than three times his career average entering the season, and senior Nick D'Antoni, who started every game and ended the year nine assists away from breaking the school record for a season, after averaging just 12.2 minutes per game his previous year.

Shaver came to W&M after coaching 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. The winningest basketball coach in the program's history, he was named the ODAC and South Region Coach of the Year in 1995, 1999 and 2000, and was picked as the Virginia Sports Information Directors Division II-III Coach of the Year in 1997, 1999 and 2000.

In 2003, Shaver took the Tigers to the NCAA Division III Final Four, as his team finished with a record of 28-4, tied for the second-most wins in the program's history. In 1999, Shaver led H-SC to the national championship, where the Tigers lost by one point in double-overtime to Wisconsin-Platteville. The team finished 29-3, setting a school record for most wins in a season.

Shaver also has a firm commitment to his players' success in the classroom. In 1999, one of his charges, Jack Jirak, was named the ODAC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was also awarded the Gammon Cup as the top-student-athlete at the college. Two of Shaver's players, David Hobbs (1999) and Russell Turner (1992) earned Academic All-America honors. A number of his players have been named to the Academic All-ODAC squad, including six student-athletes in 1998.

Shaver first led the Tigers to the national postseason in 1988-89, just his third season as the team's head coach. That year, H-SC won the ODAC championship, ending the season with a 21-8 record.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. He was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally a walk-on, he earned a scholarship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious

Butch Bennett Award, presented to the team's most outstanding freshman.

A native of High Point, North Carolina, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher (23), a standout pitcher on the Tribe's baseball team, who is currently pitching with the Chicago Cubs organization, Austin (19) and Jackson (13).

**William and Mary 83, Towson 65**  
Jan. 26, 2005 • Williamsburg, VA • William and Mary Hall

**Corey Cofield** scored a game-high 19 points, including 10 in the final six minutes, as the Tribe pulled away from Towson for an 83-65 victory in Colonial Athletic Association men's basketball action Wednesday night at William and Mary Hall.

Cofield was an efficient 5-for-6 from the field on the night and shot 9-of-11 at the foul line for his 10th double-digit scoring game of the season. One of four in double-figures for the Tribe, Cofield's hot hand was just one of many offensive weapons, as W&M shot a season-high 52.1% (25-for-48) from the field.

The second half started with a bang, as Cofield beat the Tigers down the floor in transition for a dunk that extended a four-point halftime lead to 41-35. After Towson's Lawrence Hamm answered with a two-point field goal, W&M's **Laimis Kisielius** scored the Tribe's next six points to push the lead to nine, 47-38, with 16:07 remaining.

The Tigers' Mike Green, who scored a team-high 16 points, cut the deficit to five with back-to-back buckets, before con-secutive three-pointers from **Nathan Mann** and **Edwin Ofori Attah** made it 53-42 with 13:39 left.

Towson cut it to five again, 57-52, behind free throws from Hamm at the 8:23 mark, but that was as close as the Tigers would get the rest of the way, as Cofield responded with another dunk and Ofori Attah drained his second trey to put the Tribe back up 10, 62-52 with 7:44 remaining.

Cofield pushed the lead to 12, 69-57, with a turnaround jumper at the 5:14 mark, and after Hamm answered with a layin, Cofield was again strong in the post with a jump-hook that made it 71-59 with 4:36 to go. Ofori Attah's reverse layup on the Tribe's next trip down the floor after a Towson score kept the lead at 12, before Cofield put an exclamation point on it with another dunk, bringing the lead to 14, 75-61, with 2:38 remaining.

Kisielius (2-for-2) and Cofield (4-for-4) drained six straight free throws that ballooned the lead to 81-63 less than a minute later, and **Hawley Smith's** put-back with five seconds remaining set the final margin at 83-65.

Ofori Attah finished with 14 points, his first double-figure scoring game since dropping 21 at James Madison on January 12, while Kisielius wound up with 14 and Mann added 10 to join Cofield in double-figures. Mann dished out a team-high six assists, and Ofori Attah pulled down five rebounds. Cofield added six boards, three assists and three steals.

**Nick D'Antoni** drained three three-pointers in the first half, as the Tribe shot a blistering 54.5% (12-for-22) from the floor, including 6-for-12 from behind the arc in the opening 20 minutes to take a 39-35 advantage at the break. **Brian Hutt** also had a strong first half, as he came off the bench to collect four points, three rebounds and two assists.

## Game #18

**George Mason 95, William and Mary 62**  
Jan. 29, 2005 • Fairfax, VA • Patriot Center

William and Mary's **Nathan Mann** tied a career high with 15 points, but the Tribe could not hold off the George Mason men's basketball team's hot shooting, as the Patriots defeated W&M, 95-62, this afternoon at the Patriot Center.

The loss drops the Tribe's record to 5-13 overall and 1-8 in the Colonial Athletic Association, while Mason improved to 10-8 (5-4 CAA).

With W&M trailing, 10-6, following a three-pointer by GMU's Tony Skinn, the Tribe went on a 7-0 run, sparked by a three-pointer and a pair of free throws from **Laimis Kisielius**, to take a 13-10 lead with 14:18 to play in the half. Mason's Folarin Campbell kept the lead from getting any larger, scoring eight points in just over a minute, to bring the score to 18-18. From there the Tribe offense went cold, and the Patriots closed out a 27-12 run to end the half with a three from Skinn at the buzzer, to lead 45-30 at the break.

After shooting 51.6 percent from the field in the first half, GMU's offense got even hotter in the second, converting 73.1 percent (19-26) of its shots in the frame, including seven of 11 (.520) from the three-point line. The Patriots led by as many as 36 points in the period, ending the game with a 33-point lead.

Along with Mann's 15 points, the Tribe's **Corey Cofield** also scored in double figures with 12 points, leading the Green and Gold with six rebounds. Campbell came off the bench to lead the Patriots with 23 points, followed by Skinn with 21 points and 10 rebounds. Lamar Butler had 18 points for George Mason, while Jai Lewis chipped in with 11. For the third time this season the College made over 90 percent of its free throws, shooting 14-15 (.933) from the charity stripe in the game. GMU shot a torrid 61.4 percent from the floor and 52.0 percent from beyond the three-point line in the contest, while outrebounding the Tribe, 36-23.
