W&M Travels to Face Local Rival Hampton Tuesday Night

Tuesday night, William and Mary will travel to Hampton to face the Pirates in the Tribe's first road game of the season ... W&M heads into the game with a 1-1 record this season, having defeated Maine in the semifinals of the W&M Tip-Off Classic, before falling to Holy Cross in the championship game ... Hampton lost at Richmond, 44-40, last week in the Pirates only game this season.

Storylines

Saturday's game will be the 11th between W&M and Hampton, with the Tribe holding a 6-4 lead in the series ... The Tribe has a 3-1 record against the Pirates in Hampton ... Last season, W&M defeated HU, 60-51, in Williamsburg on Dec. 30 ... W&M also won the last game between the two teams in Hampton, defeating the Pirates, 64-62, on Feb. 3, 2003.

Freshman guard **Calvin Baker** was named the Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Week on Monday ... Baker averaged 15.5 points, 3.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals per game in the W&M Tip-Off Classic and was voted to the all-tournament team ... He scored 16 points with four assists against Maine in the first game of his career, then came back to lead W&M with 15 points against Holy Cross.

Against Holy Cross in the final of the W&M Tip-Off Classic on Saturday, the Tribe trailed by as many as 25 points in the second half, before senior forward **Brian Hutt** scored seven straight points, sparking a 13-2 run that brought the Tribe within 12 points with 10 minutes to play ... Hutt scored a career-high 13 points in the game ... Rookie guard **Calvin Baker** led W&M with 15 points, going 9-11 from the free throw line, while junior forward **Corey Cofield** also had 13 points.

Thursday night, W&M's basketball gymnasium was officially named Kaplan Arena, in honor of the longtime support of W&M graduates **Jim** and **Jane Kaplan** ... The sponsors of the W&M Tip-Off Classic for the second straight season, the Kaplans also recently announced a \$7 million commitment in support of the Tribe men's basketball team.

Baker Earns Hardware Early

Just two games into his college career, freshman guard **Calvin Baker** has alreday begun to impress ... After strong performances in both games of the W&M Tip-Off Classic, Baker was voted to the all-tournament team and was also selected as the CAA's first Rookie of the Week for the 2005-06 season ... Baker has started both games this season and is second on the team with 15.5 ppg.

Cofield Starting Strong Again

Junior forward **Corey Cofield** appears to be picking up where he left off last season as one of the top players in the CAA ... The Tribe's leading scorer (13.2 ppg) and rebounder (6.9 rpg) last season, Cofield leads W&M in both categories through two games this season (16.0 ppg and 7.0 rpg) ... He just missed his 12th career double-double in the season opener vs. Maine, with 19 points and nine rebounds in just 23 minutes.

Tribe Reaches Finals of Tip-Off Classic

Although W&M did not win the Tip-Off Classic this season, the Tribe did reach the championship game of its third straight regular season tournament with the season-opening win over Maine ... Last season, the Green and Gold won the inaugu-

ral Tip-Off Classic with wins over Hartford and Radford ... In head coach **Tony Shaver**'s first season at W&M, the Tribe beat St. Francis (NY) before losing to host George Washington at the Red Auerbach Colonial Classic (Nov. 28-29, 2003) ...W&M is 4-2 in regular season tournament games under Shaver ... Prior to Shaver's arrival in Williamsburg, the College had not reached the finals of a regular season tournament since December of 1981.

Three Players Earn First Start vs. Maine

Three W&M players earned their first career start in their first game wearing the Green and Gold ... Freshmen Calvin Baker and Peter Stein started in their first career games ... Junior transfer Adam Payton played 52 games in his two seasons at Vanderbilt, but had never started a game before this season.

I Walk the Line

Junior forward **Corey Cofield** has attempted at least 10 free throws in 19 of his 59 career games ... The CAA's leader in free throws made (144) and attempted (179), he ranks 17th all-time at W&M with 270 made foul shots and is 18th with 379 attempts ... Cofield is a .712 career free throw shooter, making 80.4% of his attempts last season.

Much Ado About Nothing

- Four of the eight Maine players that played against the Tribe in the season opener, including one starter, did not score a point in the game.
- W&M held Holy Cross scoreless for six minutes and two seconds of the second half (from 15:49 through 9:47) and didn't allow the Crusaders to make a field goal for eight minutes and 50 seconds in that period (15:49 through 6:59).
- The Tribe didn't allow Maine to score a point until the 16:35 mark of the first half.
- Five current players (seniors **Brian Hutt** and **Nate Loehrke**, junior **Corey Cofield** and freshmen **Alex Smith** and **Peter Stein**) have combined to take 816 shots from the field, but none of them have attempted a single three-pointer in college.

Season Openers

W&M is 54-47 (.535) all-time in the first game of the season and has won seven of its last 10 season-opening games ... The Tribe has now had decisive wins in all three of its season openers under head coach **Tony Shaver**, winning those games by an average of 24.7 points ... This is the fourth straight year and the sixth time in the last seven seasons that the Tribe has started the year at home.

Junior forward **Corey Cofield** already has 784 points in his career (13.3 ppg) ... This season, he is likely to become the 27th player in school history to score 1,000 points, and just the 14th to reach the milestone in less than three seasons ... The last player to score 1,000 points at W&M was 2004 graduate **Adam Hess**, who is 10th in school history with 1,341 points in less than three full seasons wearing the Green and Gold.

Best Things in Life are Free (Throws)

W&M led the CAA and was 53rd in the nation with a .725 free throw percentage last season, the 10th best mark in school history ... Three players made more than 75 percent of their shots from the line, led by **Corey Cofield**, who was fourth in the CAA with a .804 FT%, leading the league in free throws made (144) and attempted (179) ... **Laimis Kisielius** (.767) and **Hawley Smith** (.752) each also made over 75 percent of

their foul shots ... As a team, W&M was at least .750 from the line 11 times, including three games over 90 percent.

Facility Upgrades

During the summer, W&M Hall underwent a major renovation project with the installation of a new hardwood floor ... The \$750,000 project included a wall-to-wall, 16,900 square foot permanent wood floor, large enough for two full basketball courts when the arena's bleachers are retracted ... The floor was manufactured by Connor Sports Flooring Corporation and was installed by Recreation Plus of Hopewell, Virginia.

Back-to-Back Games

This is the third straight season and the fourth time in the last five years that the Tribe has opened the season with games on consecutive days ... Last season, W&M started the season by hosting the first Tip-Off Classic, winning both games ... Before

W&M head coach Tony Shaver and his staff completed their recruiting for next season's class with the signing of four individuals on the first day of the early signing period (Nov. 9). The four future Tribe players are 6-10 forward **Steven Hess**, 6-2 guard **Matt McFadden**, 6-3 guard **David Schneider** and 6-7 forward **Danny Sumner**.

Steven Hess, 6-10, F, Gastonia, NC (Gaston Day School)

Hess averaged 16 points and nine rebounds for Gaston Day School last season, helping his team reach the semifinals of the state tournament in North Carolina's largest independent-school classification. He is a McDonald's All-American nominee and was an All-Southern Piedmont Athletic Association selection.

Matt McFadden, 6-2, G, Medford, NJ (Shawnee High School)

McFadden averaged 13 points, five assists, four rebounds and 2.5 steals per game last season at Shawnee High School. A three-time team captain, he was an All-Olympic Conference selection last year, helping his team to a 25-2 record, as Shawnee HS won the South Jersey Group 4 championship and advanced to the semifinals of the state tournament.

David Schneider, 6-3, G, Phoenix, AZ (Brophy Prep)

Schneider averaged 18.1 points, 6.2 rebounds and 6.1 assists per game last season at Brophy Prep and was a first team all-region and honorable mention all-state selection. His father, Jeff, played basketball at Virginia Tech, ending his college career in 1982 with 276 assists, ninth-most in school history, before being selected in the fifth round of the 1982 NBA Draft by the Houston Rockets.

Danny Sumner, 6-7, F, Fairfax, VA (Paul VI)

Sumner averaged 14 points and 10 rebounds a game for Paul VI High School last season, as his team reached the Virginia Independent Schools Division I state final for the second straight year. Sumner was named to the 2005 Virginia Independent All-Tournament team and was an honorable mention Washington Post All-Metropolitan selection. He will be the Tribe's first men's basketball player from Paul VI since **David Cully**, who graduated from W&M in 1996 as the College's all-time blocked shots leader (248) and fifth-leading rebounder (783).

Head Coach Tony Shaver

William and Mary head coach Tony Shaver is in his third season at the helm of the Tribe men's basketball program. Officially hired on May 2, 2003, Shaver is the 31st men's basketball coach in the history of the College.

"Bringing a coach and person the caliber of a Tony Shaver into the William and Mary program certainly makes this an exciting day for the College," said director of athletics Terry Driscoll at the time of the hire. "His resume speaks for itself in terms of his coaching abilities, but beyond that, I believe that he possesses all the intangible qualities that will make him a perfect fit for our school and program."

The Green and Gold continued to make strides in Shaver's second season leading the Tribe. W&M immediately started the season on a high note, defeating Radford and Hartford to win the inaugural W&M Tip-Off Classic, the first regular season tournament title for the College since 1981. The Tribe defeated James Madison in the first round of the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament for W&M's first postseason win since 1997, and just the third in the last 20 years.

Shaver began his Tribe career with a 91-64 pounding of Liberty on Nov. 23, 2003. He also won his first ever Colonial Athletic Association contest, as the Tribe knocked off two-time defending league champion UNC Wilmington, 67-66, in overtime on Dec. 4, 2003. In his first contest against a nationally ranked opponent, W&M also performed well, leading No. 15 Pittsburgh by 10 points midway through the first half, before the Panthers, who attempted 28 more free throws than the Tribe, won 70-55.

There have been individual successes as well for the Green and Gold under Shaver's reign. 2004 graduate Adam Hess, currently playing professionally in Europe, became the first player in school history to lead the CAA in scoring. An outstanding student and athlete, Hess was named the CAA Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year (for all sports) and was a first team Academic All-America and all-conference selection as a senior. Current junior Corey Cofield was voted the 2004 CAA Rookie of the Year, leading all freshmen in the league in points, rebounds and field goal percentage. Cofield earned his second straight selection to the All-CAA third team in 2005, while current sophomore Laimis Kisielius earned a spot on the CAA All-Rookie team last season.

Shaver came to W&M after coaching 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. The winningest basketball coach in the program's history, he was named the ODAC and South Region Coach of the Year in 1995, 1999 and 2000, and was picked as the Virginia Sports Information Directors Division II-III Coach of the Year in 1997, 1999 and 2000.

In 2003, Shaver took the Tigers to the NCAA Division III Final Four, as his team finished with a record of 28-4, tied for the second-most wins in the program's history. In 1999, Shaver led H-SC to the national championship game, where the Ti-

gers lost by one point in double-overtime to Wisconsin-Platteville. The team finished 29-3, setting a school record for most wins in a season.

Shaver also has a firm commitment to his players' success in the classroom. In 1999, one of his charges, Jack Jirak, was named the ODAC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was also awarded the Gammon Cup as the top-student-athlete at the college. Two of Shaver's players, David Hobbs (1999) and Russell Turner (1992) earned Academic All-America honors. A number of his players have been named to the Academic All-ODAC squad, including six student-athletes in 1998.

Shaver first led the Tigers to the national postseason in 1988-89, just his third season as the team's head coach. That year, H-SC won the ODAC championship, ending the season with a 21-8 record.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. He was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball

team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally a walk-on, he earned a scholar-ship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious Butch Bennett Award, presented to the team's most outstanding freshman.

A native of High Point, North Carolina, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher (24), a former standout pitcher on the Tribe's baseball team, who is currently pitching with the Chicago Cubs organization, Austin (21) and Jackson (14).
