# 2005-06 William and Mary Tribe

#### Tribe Takes on Towson Prior to Two-Week Break for Finals

William and Mary's men's basketball team will travel to face Towson Saturday at 4:00 PM in the Tribe's last game before the College's final exam period ... W&M policy prohibits any athletic teams from competing during the exam period, which this year runs from Dec. 5-15 ... W&M comes into Saturday's game with a 4-2 record overall and a 0-1 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play ... Towson is 2-2 overall and will be playing its first conference game of the season.

#### **Storylines**

Saturday's game will be the 15th meeting between William and Mary and Towson ... The Tribe leads the series with the Tigers, 9-5, including a 6-3 record against Towson since they joined the CAA for the 2001-02 season ... W&M is 2-4 all-time at Towson, but has won two of the last three times it has played on the Tigers' home court ... In their last meeting, the Tribe won, 57-50, at Towson on Feb. 26, 2005 ... W&M swept the season series against Towson last year, also beating the Tigers, 83-65, in Williamsburg on Jan. 26 ... The first meeting between the two teams was in the 1948-49 season, resulting in a 94-31 W&M win, still the biggest margin of defeat in Towson's history.

For the second time in as many weeks, **Calvin Baker** was named the Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Week on Monday (Nov. 28) ... The only player to win the award this season, Baker leads the Tribe and is second in the CAA in scoring (16.7 ppg) ... He scored a career-high 28 points on 9-11 shooting from the field in the win over Campbell (11/26).

The Tribe's three-game winning streak came to an end on Wednesday with a 75-66 loss to UNC Wilmington ... Junior **Laimis Kisielius** led W&M with 13 points in just 19 minutes of play ... Still intact is the Tribe's three-game winning streak on the road, which began with last season's 57-50 win at Towson on Feb. 26 ... W&M last won three straight road games during the 2002-03 season ... The Tribe's last four-game road winning streak came near the end of the 1982-83 season, when the Green and Gold won at VMI, James Madison, Richmond and Delaware.

Freshman guard Calvin Baker has been named the CAA's Rookie of the Week twice this season (Nov. 21 and Nov. 28) ... The only player to win the award this season, he leads the Tribe and is second in the league with 16.7 ppg, shooting .397 from the field, .344 from the three-point line and .750 from the foul line ... Baker was voted to the W&M Tip-Off Classic all-tournament team to start the season ... At Woodside (Newport News, VA) High School, he was named the Virginia Group AAA Player of the Year by the Virginia HS Coaches Association and was picked as the state's co-player of the year by the Associated Press ... A twotime Daily Press Player of the Year, he led Woodside to state championships in 2004 and 2005 and was the MVP of the state's East-West All-Star game in July of 2005.

#### Cofield Starting Strong Again

Junior forward **Corey Cofield** appears to be picking up where he left off last season as one of the top players in the CAA ... The Tribe's leading scorer (13.2 ppg) and rebounder (6.9 rpg) last season, Cofield is second on the team with 12.5 ppg and leads the team lead with 6.2 rpg ... Monday he led the Tribe with a season-high 21 points and also had seven rebounds in just 28 minutes ... The 2004 CAA Rookie of the

# Year, Cofield just missed his 12th career double-double in the season opener vs. Maine (11/19), with 19 points and nine rebounds in just 23 minutes.

#### **Happy Birthday**

Freshman forward **Chris Darnell** turns 19 years old on Saturday when the Tribe takes on Towson ... Head coach **Tony Shaver** will be 52 years old on Jan. 28, when W&M hosts James Madison ... Senior forward **Hawley Smith** will be 23 years old on March 4, the second day of the CAA Tournament.

#### W&M Opens CAA Play Early

Wednesday's conference opener against UNC Wilmington was the Tribe's earliest game against a CAA opponent in school history ... It was the second CAA game of the season, after Georgia State defeated Delaware, 99-72, in the CAA's first game on Nov. 22 ... W&M is 8-13 all-time in CAA openers ... Before this season, the Tribe had won the last five times it played its first conference game at home, including two wins over UNCW ... W&M is now 2-2 when the Tribe takes on the Seahawks in its first CAA game of the season.

#### **Defense Improving in 2005-06**

A big area of improvement for the Tribe early on has been the team's defense ... Last season, opponents shot .450 from the field and .366 from three-point range, but so far this year, W&M has held the opposition to .409 from the field and .299 from long range ... The Tribe has held four of its six opponents to less than 40 percent shooting from the field and has allowed just one team to shoot better than 30 percent from the three-point line.

#### Solid Start

W&M's 4-1 start to the season was the best for the team since opening the 1992-93 campaign with a 6-1 record ... That season, however, two of the team's first four wins were against non-Division I teams Virginia Wesleyan and Shenandoah ... This is the first time in W&M history that the Tribe has opened a year with at least four wins in its first five games against current countable Division I opponents ... W&M is 2-0 on the road this season (as many road wins as the Tribe had in the previous two seasons combined) ... W&M hadn't won its first two road games in a season since the 1959-60 campaign, when the Tribe won at VMI (79-78) and at Tennessee (77-71).

#### **Front Runners**

In the four wins this season, the Tribe has had to play from behind for a total of just four minutes and 39 seconds ... W&M led

or was tied for the entire 40 minutes vs. Maine and Campbell ... At Hampton, the Pirates took a 3-0 lead at 19:28, but the Tribe scored eight unanswered points, taking a 4-3 lead at 18:48 ... At Longwood, the Lancers went ahead, 3-0 at 19:29 and it took the Tribe nearly four minutes before taking the lead for good, 10-9, at 16:03.

#### **Tribe Reaches Finals of Tip-Off Classic**

Although W&M did not win the Tip-Off Classic this season, the Tribe did reach the championship game of its third straight regular season tournament with the season-opening win over Maine ... Last season, the Green and Gold won the inaugu-

ral Tip-Off Classic with wins over Hartford and Radford ... In head coach Tony Shaver's first season at W&M, the Tribe beat St. Francis (NY) before losing to host George Washington at the Red Auerbach Colonial Classic (Nov. 28-29, 2003) ... W&M is 4-2 in regular season tournament games under Shaver ... Prior to Shaver's arrival in Williamsburg, the College had not reached the finals of a regular season tournament since December of 1981.

#### **Transferring Talent**

W&M has two Division I transfers on its roster this season in senior forward Hawley Smith (Temple) and junior guard Adam Payton (Vanderbilt) ... Smith started nearly every game last season, but has not played this year due to an ankle injury suffered a week before the season-opener ... Payton sat out last season, per NCAA transfer rules, but has started every game this year ... Monday, he scored a career-high 19 points on 7-8 shooting from the field in the Tribe's win over Longwood (11/28) ... He had 18 points and seven rebounds in W&M's win at Hampton (11/22) ... #### **W&M Signs Four Early**

1998-99

W&M head coach Tony Shaver and his staff completed their recruiting for next season's class with the signing of four individuals on the first day of the early signing period (Nov. 9). The four future Tribe players are 6-10 forward **Steven Hess**, 6-2 guard **Matt McFadden**, 6-3 guard **David Schneider** and 6-7 forward **Danny Sumner**.

#### Steven Hess, 6-10, F, Gastonia, NC (Gaston Day School)

Hess averaged 16 points and nine rebounds for Gaston Day School last season, helping his team reach the semifinals of the state tournament in North Carolina's largest independent-school classification. He is a McDonald's All-American nominee and was an All-Southern Piedmont Athletic Association selection.

#### Matt McFadden, 6-2, G, Medford, NJ (Shawnee High School)

McFadden averaged 13 points, five assists, four rebounds and 2.5 steals per game last season at Shawnee High School. A three-time team captain, he was an All-Olympic Conference selection last year, helping his team to a 25-2 record, as Shawnee HS won the South Jersey Group 4 championship and advanced to the semifinals of the state tournament.

#### David Schneider, 6-3, G, Phoenix, AZ (Brophy Prep)

Schneider averaged 18.1 points, 6.2 rebounds and 6.1 assists per game last season at Brophy Prep and was a first team all-region and honorable mention all-state selection. His father, Jeff, played basketball at Virginia Tech, ending his college career in 1982 with 276 assists, ninth-most in school history, before being selected in the fifth round of the 1982 NBA Draft by the Houston Rockets.

#### Danny Sumner, 6-7, F, Fairfax, VA (Paul VI)

Sumner averaged 14 points and 10 rebounds a game for Paul VI High School last season, as his team reached the Virginia Independent Schools Division I state final for the second straight year. Sumner was named to the 2005 Virginia Independent All-Tournament team and was an honorable mention Washington Post All-Metropolitan selection. He will be the Tribe's first men's basketball player from Paul VI since **David Cully**, who graduated from W&M in 1996 as the College's all-time blocked shots leader (248) and fifth-leading rebounder (783).

#### **Cofield Closing in on 1,000**

Junior forward **Corey Cofield** already has 827 points in his career (13.1 ppg) ... He is likely to become the 27th player in school history to score 1,000 points, and just the 14th to reach the milestone in less than three seasons ... The last player to score 1,000 points at W&M was 2004 graduate **Adam Hess**, who is 10th in school history with 1,341 points in less than three full seasons wearing the Green and Gold.

#### **Best Things in Life are Free (Throws)**

W&M led the CAA and was 53rd in the nation with a .725 free throw percentage last

season, the 10th best mark in school history ... Three players made more than 75 percent of their shots from the line, led by **Corey Cofield**, who was fourth in the CAA with a .804 FT%, leading the league in free throws made (144) and attempted (179) ... **Laimis Kisielius** (.767) and **Hawley Smith** (.752) each also made over 75 percent of their foul shots ... As a team, W&M was at least .750 from the line 11 times, including three games over 90 percent.

#### **Facility Upgrades**

During the summer, W&M Hall underwent a major renovation project with the installation of a new hardwood floor ... The \$750,000 project included a wall-to-wall, 16,900 square foot permanent wood floor, large enough for two full basketball courts when the arena's bleachers are retracted ... The floor was manufactured by Connor Sports Flooring Corporation and was installed by Recreation Plus of Hopewell, Virginia.

#### **Back-to-Back Games**

This is the third straight season and the fourth time in the last five years that the Tribe has opened the season with games on consecutive days ... Last season, W&M started the season by hosting the first Tip-Off Classic, winning both games ... Before that, the last time that the College opened the season with back-to-back home games was the 1956-57 campaign, when the Tribe defeated The Citadel (87-74) on Nov. 30 and Hampden-Sydney (98-81) on Dec. 1.

#### Shaver Named to Episcopal HS Hall of Fame

# **Head Coach Tony Shaver**

William and Mary head coach Tony Shaver is in his third season at the helm of the Tribe men's basketball program. Officially hired on May 2, 2003, Shaver is the 31st men's basketball coach in the history of the College.

"Bringing a coach and person the caliber of a Tony Shaver into the William and Mary program certainly makes this an exciting day for the College," said director of athletics Terry Driscoll at the time of the hire. "His resume speaks for itself in terms of his coaching abilities, but beyond that, I believe that he possesses all the intangible qualities that will make him a perfect fit for our school and program."

The Green and Gold continued to make strides in Shaver's second season leading the Tribe. W&M immediately started the season on a high note, defeating Radford and Hartford to win the inaugural W&M Tip-Off Classic, the first regular season tournament title for the College since 1981. The Tribe defeated James Madison in the first round of the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament for W&M's first postseason win since 1997, and just the third in the last 20 years.

Shaver began his Tribe career with a 91-64 pounding of Liberty on Nov. 23, 2003. He also won his first ever Colonial Athletic Association contest, as the Tribe knocked off two-time defending league champion UNC Wilmington, 67-66, in overtime on Dec. 4, 2003. In his first contest against a nationally ranked opponent, W&M also performed well, leading No. 15 Pittsburgh by 10 points midway through the first half, before the Panthers, who attempted 28 more free throws than the Tribe, won 70-55.

There have been individual successes as well for the Green and Gold under Shaver's reign. 2004 graduate Adam Hess, currently playing professionally in Europe, became the first player in school history to lead the CAA in scoring. An outstanding student and athlete, Hess was named the CAA Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year (for all sports) and was a first team Academic All-America and all-conference selection as a senior. Current junior Corey Cofield was voted the 2004 CAA Rookie of the Year, leading all freshmen in the league in points, rebounds and field goal percentage. Cofield earned his second straight selection to the All-CAA third team in 2005, while current sophomore Laimis Kisielius earned a spot on the CAA All-Rookie team last season.

Shaver came to W&M after coaching 17 seasons at Hampden-Sydney, compiling a record of 358-121 (.747). He turned the Tigers into a Division III national powerhouse, leading the men's basketball team to eight Old Dominion Athletic Conference titles, 12 20-win seasons and 11 NCAA Division III Tournament appearances. The winningest basketball coach in the program's history, he was named the ODAC and South Region Coach of the Year in 1995, 1999 and 2000, and was picked as the Virginia Sports Information Directors Division II-III Coach of the Year in 1997, 1999 and 2000.

In 2003, Shaver took the Tigers to the NCAA Division III Final Four, as his team finished with a record of 28-4, tied for the second-most wins in the program's history. In 1999, Shaver led H-SC to the national championship game, where the Ti-

gers lost by one point in double-overtime to Wisconsin-Platteville. The team finished 29-3, setting a school record for most wins in a season.

Shaver also has a firm commitment to his players' success in the classroom. In 1999, one of his charges, Jack Jirak, was named the ODAC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and was also awarded the Gammon Cup as the top-student-athlete at the college. Two of Shaver's players, David Hobbs (1999) and Russell Turner (1992) earned Academic All-America honors. A number of his players have been named to the Academic All-ODAC squad, including six student-athletes in 1998.

Shaver first led the Tigers to the national postseason in 1988-89, just his third season as the team's head coach. That year, H-SC won the ODAC championship, ending the season with a 21-8 record.

Prior to taking over at Hampden-Sydney for the 1986-87 campaign, Shaver spent 10 years as the head boys' basketball coach at Episcopal High School in Alexandria, Virginia. He was named the Virginia State Private School Coach of the Year in 1986, and was twice picked as the Alexandria Coach of the Year, while winning 73 percent of his games.

A 1976 graduate of North Carolina, Shaver was a guard on the Tar Heel men's basketball

team from 1972-75 under head coach Dean Smith. Originally a walk-on, he earned a scholarship his rookie season, when he was awarded the prestigious Butch Bennett Award, presented to the team's most outstanding freshman.

A native of High Point, North Carolina, Shaver and his wife, Ann, are the parents of three sons: Christopher (24), a former standout pitcher on the Tribe's baseball team, who is currently pitching with the Chicago Cubs organization, Austin (21) and Jackson (14).
