Junior Year (2005-06)

Appeared in all 28 game with 15 starts ... Topped W&M in rebounding and field-goal percentage for the second straight season with 4.7 per contest and .554 (112-of-202), respectively ... His .554 field-goal percentage ranked sixth in school history, behind his .563 percentage of 2004-05 ... Ranked second on the team in scoring at a 10.3 clip ... Led the team in rebounding on a team-high 11 occasions, while topping the squad in points on six occasions ... Recorded 16 double-digit scoring games, including a season-high 21 points against Longwood (11/28) ... Finished the contest against Longwood (11/28), 7-of-11 from the field and 7-of-8 from the charity stripe ... Notched his 12th career double-double with 19 points and 11 rebounds at Northeastern (2/2) ... Equaled a career-high with three steals against VCU (2/25) ...
