

Havre... 13th June, 1788.

Sir,

We arrived here, ^{the Inst.} and the Vessel for Virginia had sailed the day before. Which we regret exceedingly, as the Character of the Vessel & Captain was good, We shall remain here until the last of next week, to be inform'd of the Determination of the French Packet.

M^r. Limoufin was so kind as to call upon us yesterday, his Opinion is that there will sail a Packet, in three or four weeks.

You was kind enough to offer us a letter to your friend here, I shall much esteem the favour of your sending me a line to M^r. Limoufin as there is a probability that we shall remain here some time.
