

Havre .. 13<sup>th</sup> June, 1788.

Sir,

We arrived here <sup>9<sup>th</sup> Inst. and  
the Vessel for Virginia had sailed the day before.  
Which we regret exceedingly, as the character of the Vessel  
& Captain was good, we shall remain here until the  
last of next week, to be inform'd of the determination  
of the French Packet.</sup>

M<sup>r</sup>. Limousin was so kind as to call upon us yes-  
terday, his opinion is that there will sail a Packet,  
in three or four weeks.

You was kind enough to offer us a Letter  
to your friend hope, I shall much esteem the favour of  
your sending me a line to M<sup>r</sup>. Limousin as there  
is a probability that we shall remain here some time.
