June 18. 1788.

Your favor of the 1st inst. came to hand the night before last. I am sorry to find you have missed your passage. Mr. De Bert had written to me on the subject on the 5th inst. but by some means or other the letter did not get to my hands till the night of the 9th. which was the day you arrived at Havre. not knowing your address at Havre I have taken the liberty of putting the present under cover to ^{Monsieur} Lisonosin and asked his attentions & services to you. the news of the day, so far as to be relied on, are the arrival of Pippas Saib's embassy at Toulon, and pacific dispositions on the Emperor, who has made overtures of peace to the Turks, as there is good reason to believe. the fermentation in this country is great. at Grenoble some of the military have been wounded, but amidst the exaggerations of two parties which render it so difficult for a neutral person to come at the truth, I rather believe no person has been killed here. be so good as to present my respects to the ladies & to accept assurances of the esteem with which I am Sir
