

#### **Fit To Be Tied**

The Tribe equaled a school record for ties in a season with five during the 2005 campaign. In those five ties, four came by a score of 0-0. The total eclipsed the previous national record of scoreless ties, but were the second-most during the 2005 season in which San Diego State tied six times, including five scoreless draws. All five ties for the Tribe came during the Colonial Athletic Association portion of the schedule.

#### **Hoxie Earns CAA Honor**

Rookie Andrew Hoxie garnered CAA All-Rookie Team honors during the 2005 slate. The Newport News, Va., native ranked third on a team with 11 points, while tying for second in goals with five. The 6-4 striker started all 18 matches on the front line for the Tribe and notched the game-winning goal in the College's season-opening victory over Saint Joseph's.

#### **Academic Success**

The W&M soccer program continued to demonstrates the College's commitment to student-athletes during the 2005 season. Eight men's soccer athletes earned CAA Commissioner's Awards. Scott Kelsey, Jeff Marklin, Doug McBride, Andreas Nydal, Ryan Overdevest, Patrick Scherder, Ryan Sells and Clayton Voss were all recognized for their accomplishments on the field and in the classroom. Marklin and Overdevest took home 2005-06 W&M Provost Academic Awards. The honor is earned based on cumulative grade point average, with upper-classman needing a 3.50 GPA, or above, in their college career and freshmen needing a 3.75 GPA through their first semester. For the second straight year, Overdevest also garnered the team's Alumni Award, given annually to the player with the highest grade point average.

#### **By the Narrowest of Margins**

In 2005, W&M played some of the top teams in the country tight, only to fall by a single goal. The Tribe fell to five teams ranked among the nation's top 20, including four by one goal. In fact, of the Tribe's nine losses on the 2005 campaign, eight came by a single tally, including three in overtime.

#### **Offensive Outburst**

The Tribe opened the 2005 season with an offensive bonanza of goals in an 8-0 victory over Saint Joseph's. The eight-goal performance was the first for the College since the 2000 season. The last time W&M scored more than eight goals in a game was Sept. 8, 2000, when it defeated Delaware, 9-0. In the victory over Saint Joseph's, Andrew Hoxie, Andreas Nydal and Jarrett Thomas each recorded a pair of goals. It marked the first time since Sept. 6, 1997 that three W&M players had multi-goal performances in the same game. On that date against Robert Morris, Wade Barrett recorded a hat trick, while Dan Zickefoose and Adam Schultz added two goals in the 7-0 win.

#### **Blanking the Opposition**

Junior Brennan Wergley became the first W&M goalkeeper to record three-straight overtime shutouts. After making his first career start against No. 10 North Carolina, Wergley recorded shutouts against JMU (Oct. 21), VCU (Oct. 23) and Towson (Oct. 28). All three games ended in scoreless draws. During the stretch, Wergley's shutout streak reached 426:09. He stopped six or more shots in all six of his starts during the 2005 season, including a career-high nine saves against JMU. Following his shutout performances against VCU and Towson, Wergley earned the CAA Rookie of the Week honor on Oct. 24.

#### **Leading Scorer**

Jarrett Thomas won the Tribe's Golden Boot Award in 2005, topping the team in goals and points. The McLean, Va., native finished his junior campaign with 16 points on seven goals and two assists. Thomas had a pair of two-goal games for the Tribe. He notched two tallies in the season-opener against Saint Joseph's, before knocking in both W&M goals in a 2-1 victory at VMI. For the season, he ranked ninth in the CAA in points and 10th in goals.

#### **Team Honors**

Clayton Voss was named the Tribe's Most Valuable Player for the 2005 season. He was one of just two players to start all 18 matches in 2005 and also received W&M's Pipeline Award by virtue of his team-leading four assists. Earning the Golden Boot award with a team-leading seven goals was junior forward Jarrett Thomas. Three players—Brock Jones, Doug McBride and Andrew Hoxie—shared the team's Best Rookie Award. Brennan Wergley was named the team's most improved player after starting the final six games of the season and posting a 1.20 goals against average. Ryan Overdevest earned the team's Alumni Award with the Tribe's highest grade point average. Jeff Marklin took home the Coaches Award, while the Competition Award went to Voss. Rookie Jeremy Harris was honored with the Freshman Academic Achievement Award. McBride and Hoxie each garnered their second team awards with the Unsung Hero Award and Leibo Award, respectively.


