TRIBE SET FOR NATIONAL TV BOUT WITH ODU

The William and Mary men's soccer team will look to clinch one of the final two playoff berths for the Colonial Athletic Association Championships when the Tribe battles No. 24 Old Dominion on Thursday, Oct. 26, at 8 p.m. The game will have the added significance of not only a playoff berth on the line, but it will be broadcast live on Fox Soccer Channel (channel 225 for fans in Williamsburg) as part of the NSCAA/FSC College Soccer Game of the Week package. Sean Wheelock, a veteran of Major League Soccer broadcasts and other MLS programming, including the MLS SuperDraft, will serve as the play-by-play announcer for FSC. The W&M-ODU match can also be followed live over the Internet on GameTracker.

The College will look to return to the winning form it had earlier in the season at the ODU Soccer Stadium. W&M captured the ODU Stihl Soccer Classic crown in September, winning a pair of games in Norfolk. The Tribe defeated then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro, 5-1, before knocking off Loyola (Md.), 2-1.

TRIBE NEWS AND NOTES

- The schedule for the 2006 season has tested the Tribe as half of its opponents made an appearance in the 2005 NCAA Tournament. To further point out the strength of the Tribe's schedule, of its 19 regular-season opponents, 11 have spent at least one week in the national top 25.
- W&M is 20-16-8 (.545) all-time against Old Dominion, including an 8-9-4 mark in Norfolk, Va.
- The Tribe was No. 60 in the NCAA RPI standings released on Oct. 24. A total of 10 W&M opponents were ranked among the top 42 in the RPI rankings. The CAA ranked third with five teams among the top 40 in the RPI. Only the ACC (8) and the Big East (5) are ahead of the CAA.
- The last time W&M had a game televised was during the 1996 season. The College's 2-0 victory over Maryland in the NCAA Tournament was broadcasted as the College Soccer Game of the Week.
- W&M's two goal rally to defeat Georgia State on Oct. 20 marked the first time since 2000 that the Tribe had surmounted a two-goal deficit to come away with a victory.



- The Tribe is 1-0-3 in overtime games this season. W&M defeated VCU in OT, while playing to ties with Northeastern, then-No. 23 James Madison and then-No. 22 George Mason.
- Junior back Chris Wayne recorded the first assists of his career against Georgia State. He served in a pair of free kicks that were finished on headers by sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie and senior forward Pat Scherder.
- Junior Ryan Sells earned his second start of the season against UNC Wilmington and scored his first career goal for the gamewinner in the 58th minute. He followed up an Andrew Hoxie shot that was saved for the game-winner.
- Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie notched his ninth and 10th goals of the season against Georgia State and UNC Wilmington. He became the first Tribe player since Pat Scherder in 2003 to score 10 or more goals in a season. Scherder had 11 during his sophomore season.
- Junior goalkeeper Brennan Wergley has recorded shutouts in two of his last three games in goal for the Tribe. He blanked then-No. 22 George Mason on Oct. 15, before shutting out UNC Wilmington on Oct. 22.
- Scoring goals for W&M in 2006 has led to results. The Tribe is 8-0-2 when it has scored at least one goal and 0-7-1 when it is shutout.
- W&M opened the CAA portion of the schedule with a 4-0 victory over Drexel on Sept. 22. It marked the first time the Tribe had won its CAA opener in four seasons.
- -W&M opened the season against five straight teams that played in the NCAA Tournament in 2005. It marked the first time in school history that had occurred. Included in those five contests were four against teams ranked among the top 25 in the country (No. 1 North Carolina, No. 16 Wake Forest, No. 24 South Carolina and No. 8 Virginia Tech).
- The Tribe scored five goals in its victories over VMI and UNCG, marking the first time since the 2003 campaign that the College had two games of five or more goals during a season.
- W&M notched back-to-back five-goal games against VMI and UNC Greensboro, marking the first time since the 2001 campaign that the College has accomplished the feat. In 2001, the Tribe defeated College of Charleston, 5-0, on Sept. 1, before notching a 6-1 win over Marist on Sept. 3.
- Senior goalkeeper Kris Rake recorded his 13th career shutout against Drexel to move past Trevor Upton (1999-02) into fifth on W&M's career shutouts list.
- -Two former W&M players are currently playing in Major League Soccer (MLS) with another playing in the Norway. Steve Jolley (1993-96) is in his 10th season as an MLS vet, playing for the New York Red Bulls. He has appeared in 16 matches with 10 starts, while earning one assist. Wade Barrett (1994-97) is in his first

season with the Houston Dynamo, earning 31 starts, while assisting on three goals. Both the Red Bulls and Dynamo earned spots in the MLS playoffs. Former All-American Adin Brown (1996-99) is the first-team goalkeeper for Aalesunds FK in Norway. Aalesunds is second in the Norwegian Second Division, while Brown, as of Oct. 9, was the second-highest rated goalkeeper and sixth-highest rated player overall in the league. In total, over 27 former Tribe players have played pro soccer at some level.

SCOUTING No. 24 OLD DOMINION

Old Dominion clinched a spot in the CAA Tournament with its 1-0 victory at Georgia State on Oct. 22. The victory also snapped a two-match losing streak for the Monarchs, who are 11-4-1 overall and 6-3-1 in the CAA. ODU has lost its last two matches at home falling to Towson, 3-1, on Oct. 15, before UNC Wilmington defeated the Monarchs, 3-0, on Oct. 20.

The Monarchs enter the contest ranked in a pair of national polls. Old Dominion is tied for 24th in the latest NSCAA rankings and No. 29 in the College Soccer News poll.

Edson Elcock leads the Monarchs in scoring with 21 points on eight goals and five assists. Zachary Kinney ranks second on the team in goals and points with seven and 14, respectively. Jared Kent is tied with Elcock for the team lead in assist with five. Trevor Banks, Ross Mackenzie and Ambane Emmanuel have each found the back of the net on three occasions for ODU.

Sean Sigrist has started the last five matches in goal for ODU, replacing the injured Evan Newton. Sigrist has a GAA of 1.27 with 11 saves and two shutouts over his six contests. Newton, who was injured against JMU on Oct. 8, started the first 11 games of the year for ODU. He has a GAA of 0.88 with 35 saves and five shutouts

W&M holds a 20-16-8 all-time record advantage against ODU, but the Monarchs hold a 9-8-4 advantage in Norfolk. The last time the Tribe won in Norfolk was during the 1996 season. W&M defeated ODU, 4-1, on Oct. 26, 1996, on its way to a 20-3-1 overall record and a spot in the NCAA Quarterfinals. Last season, ODU defeated the Tribe in Williamsburg, 2-0.

HOXIE CONTINUES TO REEL IN CONFERENCE HONORS

After becoming the first W&M player to earn two CAA Player of the Week honors in a single season on Oct. 9, sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie continued to roll, winning his third league player of the week honor on Oct. 23. Although he had won two previous honors, the Oct. 23 accolade was the first outright award for Hoxie. He shared the distinction with Kurt Morsink of James Madison on Sept. 18 and Sean Kelley of George Mason on Oct. 9. Hoxie had a hand in four Tribe goals over the weekend in victories over Georgia State (4-2) and at UNC Wilmington (2-0).

The player of the week nods make Hoxie one of only the four W&M player to have three weekly honors during his Tribe career. Current Major Indoor Soccer League (MISL) player Carlos Garcia (1999-02), current Major League Soccer (MLS) player Wade Barrett (1994-97) and former MLS player Paul Grafer (1992-95) are the other three Tribe players to accomplish the feat in their careers. As a team, it marks the fifth time a W&M team has had three weekly honors in a single season. The College also had three player of the week honors in 1994, 1995, 2000 and 2001.

Trailing 2-0, 24 minutes into the game against Georgia State, Hoxie had a hand in both Tribe goals before the half to knot things up. The 6-4 striker headed home a free kick from junior back Chris Wayne to draw the Tribe within a goal in the 26th minute. He then created the opportunity that led to an own goal, evening it in the 31st minute. Hoxie saw his scoring chance knocked away by the GSU goalkeeper, but the ball deflected off a Georgia State defender and into the net, tying the match at two. Scherder scored the final two Tribe goals in the second half for the victory.

Hoxie had a hand in both Tribe goals in a 2-0 victory over UNC Wilmington. Junior back Ryan Sells scored on a rebound off Hoxie's initial shot in the 58th minute. It was Hoxie's fourth assist of the season. He added the capper in the 87th minute after he corralled a failed clearance by the UNCW defense, beat four defenders and then chipped the Seahawks goalkeeper.

Hoxie earned the honor on Oct. 9 after scoring both W&M goals in a 2-1 come-from-behind victory at VCU. He also earned Brine CAA Player of the Week honors on Sept. 18 after earning MVP honors at the ODU Stihl Soccer Classic. During that event, he scored two goals, including the eventual game-winner against then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro. He also assisted on the Tribe's first goal against Loyola (Md.).



CONFERENCE LEADERS

W&M is represented at the top of the conference standings in individual points, goals and assists thanks to sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie and junior midfielder Doug Ernst. With his five-point effort over the weekend, Hoxie moved into the conference lead in both points and goals. Hoxie has 24 points on 10 goals and four assists. He is tied with Kurt Morsink of James Madison for the league lead in both points and goals. Ernst continues to lead the conference in assists after recording his eighth of the year against Georgia State on Oct. 20.

COMEBACK KIDS

On two occasions in 2006 the Tribe has trailed by two goals, only to rally for a result. On senior night, Oct. 20, W&M trailed Georgia State, 2-0, 24 minutes into the contest, before rallying to tie the match before the half. The College went on to score twice in the final seven minutes to claim the victory. On Oct. 10, the Tribe trailed then-No. 23 James Madison, 2-0, in the first half, only to rally and forge a 2-2 tie.

In both contest, senior forward Pat Scherder came to the Tribe's rescue. After allowing a pair of goals to JMU in the first 30 minutes of the contest, Scherder scored off an assist from junior Doug Ernst three minutes before halftime, and then found the equalizer in the 54th minute off a feed from junior Ryan Overdevest. It marked the first time since Oct. 4, 2003 that W&M overcame a two-goal deficit to forge at least a tie. On that date, W&M received goals four minutes apart in the second half from Scherder and Graham Albert to tie College of Charleston, 2-2.

Against Georgia State, W&M trailed 2-0 following a Panther penalty kick in the 24th minute. Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie pulled the Tribe within a goal less than two minutes later, heading home a free kick from junior back Chris Wayne. Hoxie created a scoring opportunity for W&M in the 31st minute and thanks to a deflected shot, the College pulled even on an own goal from GSU. It was then Scherder who shined. The Vienna, Va., native scored two goals in the final seven minutes of the game to propel the Tribe to victory.

It marked the first time since 2000 that the Tribe overcame a two-goal deficit to record a victory. The last time W&M accomplished the feat was against Butler on Oct. 27, 2000. The Tribe trailed the Bulldogs, 2-0, in the opening half at the FIU Classic. The College scored twice in final seven minutes of the first half to tie the score, before scoring three times in the second half for a 5-2 win.

CAA RACE TIGHTENING UP

With only one weekend of CAA matches remaining, the Tribe sits in sixth place in the conference, holding down one of the final playoff spots. Thanks to its perfect 2-0 weekend, the College leaped over two teams and into the final position. W&M is 4-3-3 in the CAA with 15 points. The point total put the Tribe in a tie with UNC Wilmington for sixth, but with its 2-0 victory over the Seahawks on Oct. 22, W&M holds the tiebreaker.

Although the Tribe is currently in position for a playoff spot, a win is almost a necessity. A victory would clinch a playoff spot for the Tribe, while it would need some help with a tie or a loss. In the standings, the teams in positions 5-8 are separated by two points. Towson, George Mason, Hofstra and Old Dominion have already clinched berths in the CAA Tournament, leaving W&M,

Two-fers

Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie and senior frontrunner Pat Scherder are the Tribe's top two offensive threats and the numbers back it up. In total, the duo has scored 18 of W&M's 29 goals (or 62 percent). Included in that total are six multi-goal games. Each player has tallied a trio of two-goal games in 2006. Hoxie and Scherder are the first pair of Tribe teammates with three or more two-goal games in a season since Carlos Garcia (4) and Phil Hucles (3) did it during the 2001 season.

Scherder has a pair of multi-goal games in the Tribe's last four matches. He picked up his third, two-goal contest of the year in the College's 4-2 comeback victory over Georgia State. On senior night, the fifth-year striker tacked a pair of tallies on the board in the final seven minutes to give W&M the win. It was the second time he had led the Tribe back from a two-goal deficit. He scored both W&M goals, one in each half, as the College rallied to forge a tie with then-No. 23 James Madison. He also notched two in the Tribe's 5-1 romp over then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro on Sept. 15. Remarkably, despite entering the year as the Tribe's active goal scoring leader with 16, the two-goal games were the first of his career. Scherder has 24 goals for his W&M career.

Against VCU, Hoxie led a rally scoring both Tribe goals in a 2-1 come-from-behind win. He scored on a penalty kick in the 88th minute, before scoring six minutes into overtime to give the Tribe the victory. He also pulled the trick against then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro and Drexel.

Answering the Call

Before the season, head coach Chris Norris said he had high expectations for junior midfielder Doug Ernst. The third-year head man of the Green and Gold felt it was time for the Alexan-



dria, Va., native to step up his offensive production, given his success at the prep and club levels. This season, Ernst has answered the call and is enjoying a breakout season.

Ernst has found the back of the net on three occasions, but more impressively is first in the CAA in assists with eight helpers. He ranks ninth in the conference in points as well.

In the CAA opening victory over Drexel, Ernst notched a pair of assists his second, two-assist game of the season. He became the first W&M player to notched a pair of multiple assist games in a season since Phil Hucles had two, two-assist games in 2003. Ernst's eight assists this season are already the most in a campaign for a W&M player since Bryan Hinkle had nine in 2003.

FRESHMAN STARTERS

Freshmen Price Thomas and Roger Bothe have wasted little time making a significant impact on the W&M program. Both players have started 17 of the Tribe's 18 matches. Thomas has three points on a goal and an assist at the attacking midfielder position, while adding a flare and creativity to the Tribe attack.

Bothe, the 2005-06 Gatorade Virginia State Player of the Year, has shown solid skills defending as well as the ability to make runs up the flanks and get into the offensive attack.

TRIBE CLAIMS ODU STIHL SOCCER CLASSIC

By virtue of its victories over then-No. 29 (College Soccer News) UNC Greensboro, 5-1, and Loyola (Md.), 2-1, W&M claimed the ODU Stihl Soccer Classic. The Tribe and host ODU both finished with perfect 2-0 record, but the Tribe took the title as a result of a better goal differential thanks in large part to its offensive outburst against UNC Greensboro.

In the opening match of the classic, the Tribe scored early and often in the victory over the Spartans. Senior forward Pat Scherder started the barrage with a goal in the fifth minute, before sophomore frontrunner Andrew Hoxie added the second, sending the College to a 2-0 halftime lead. Scherder added his second and junior Doug Ernst scored in the 70th minute before the Spartans got on the board three minutes later. Hoxie iced the game with his second tally of the contest in the closing minutes.

In the second game of the classic against Loyola (Md.), the Tribe again scored early on a goal from Ernst in the 17th minute, but the Greyhounds tied it up before the half. Sophomore Brock Jones added what proved to be the game-winner a minute into the second stanza as the Tribe dominated the second 45 minutes, outshooting Loyola (Md.), 14-4.

The College improved to 24-12-4 (.650) all-time at the event, winning the championship for the fourth time in its 20-year history at the classic. W&M won both its games at the event for the seventh time.

SCORING WITH A QUICKNESS INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

The Tribe broke open a 1-0 halftime lead with goals 20 seconds apart in the 60th minute and a trio of tallies just over three minutes apart against VMI. Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie chipped the goalkeeper from 35 yards after a failed clearance at 60:23, before freshman midfielder Price Thomas hammered home a volley from six-yards out on a cross from senior forward Pat Scherder at 60:43. Junior Chris Wayne added a bending free kick from 25 yards out at 63:28, giving W&M three straight scores in 3:05.

The 3:05 time span between the trio of Tribe goals was the 11th fastest between three goals by one team in NCAA history. The 3:05 was also the fastest in the NCAA since three UMBC players (Drew Perkins, John Clark and Larry Scheller) scored 1:46 apart in a victory over Valparaiso on Oct. 12, 2001.

The W&M goals 20 seconds apart established a school record for the fastest two consecutive goals. The 20-second mark also ranks as the 21st-fastest consecutive goals by a team in NCAA history. According to the 2006 NCAA Men's and Women's Soccer Record Book, it is also the fastest set of goals for a single team in nearly four years. The last time one team scored 20 seconds apart came on Sept. 27, 2002 when Mike Rosenthal and M.J. Serota of UMKC scored 20 seconds apart against Denver.

GAME OF FIRSTS

Four different W&M players scored their first career goals in the 5-0 victory over VMI. Junior midfielder Doug Ernst scored his first career goal, the game-winner, in the 26th minute of play to lead the Tribe firsts. Freshman midfielder Price Thomas, junior back Chris Wayne and sophomore forward Nathan Belcher each scored the first tallies of their career in the second half to push the Tribe to victory. Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie led W&M with three points on a goal and an assist. It marked the first time in his career that Hoxie recorded both a tally and a helper in a single game.

Price Thomas scored on a volley in the six-yard box in the 60th minute. Wayne notched the Tribe's fourth tally of the contest at the 63:28 mark off a free kick, bending it inside the near post to the upper left corner of the goal. In his first career appearance for W&M, Belcher scored less than five minutes after entering the contest to give the College a 5-0 lead. Senior forward Jarrett Thomas hit an outside-footed shot from a severe angle on goal. The VMI goalkeeper made the diving save to deny the chance, but Belcher was there to clean up the mess, pushing the ball in from six yards out.

Along with Belcher, redshirt freshman midfielder Preston Whitlock and senior goalkeeper Scott Kelsey made the first appearances of their W&M careers against the Keydets. Kelsey played the final 16:54 in net, but was not tested.


