## W&M HOSTS TOP TWO TEAMS IN CAA

The William and Mary men's soccer team will host the top two teams in the CAA standing in Towson and George Mason. W&M will host Towson (9-1-2 overall, 5-0-1 CAA) on Friday, Oct. 13, at 7 p.m., before meeting No. 22 George Mason (10-2 overall, 6-0 CAA) on Sunday, Oct. 15, at 2 p.m. The Patriots sit atop of the CAA standing after winning their last nine contests.

The Tribe wrapped up a four-match CAA road trip. Over the stretch, W&M compiled a 1-1-2 record, culminating in a 2-2 tie with then-No. 23 James Madison on Oct. 10. The match was originally schedule for Oct. 6, but was postponed due to inclement weather.

The Towson game on Friday night will have the promotion 'Be a Kid Again.' Any adult that brings a kid to the game, will receive admission at the child's price of \$3.

## TRIBE NEWS AND NOTES

- After not playing an overtime game in the first 11 matches of the season, each of the last three Tribe contests have gone to extra time. W&M is 1-0-2 in those affairs, all of which have come on the road.

- Junior midfielder Doug Ernst leads the CAA in assists with seven on the year.

- W&M opened the CAA portion of the schedule with a 4-0 victory over Drexel on Sept. 22. It marked the first time the Tribe had won its CAA opener in four seasons.

- Scoring goals for W&M in 2006 has led to results. The Tribe is 6-0-2 when it scored at least one goal and 0-6 when it is shutout.

- Despite 16 career goals, senior forward Pat Scherder entered the 2006 season having never tallied a multigoal game. His final campaign in the Green and Gold has been a different story as Scherder notched two-goal contests in a 5-1 win over then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro on Sept. 15 and in a 2-2 come-from-behind tie with No. 23 James Madison on Oct. 10.

- The Tribe claimed its first ODU Stihl Soccer Classic title since 1998 and the fourth overall with its perfect 2-0 mark at the event.

- W&M opened the season against five straight teams that played in the NCAA Tournament a season ago. It marked the first time in school history that had occurred. Included in those five contests were four against teams ranked among the top 25 in the country (No. 1 North Carolina, No. 16 Wake Forest, No. 24 South Carolina and No. 8 Virginia Tech).

- The Tribe scored five goals in its victory over VMI. It marked the most goals the Tribe has scored in a game since the season opener in 2005. In that contest, W&M put eight goals on the board against Saint Joseph's.

- The Tribe scored five goals in its victories over VMI and UNCG, marking the first time since the 2003 campaign that the College had two games of five or more goals during a season.

- W&M notched back-to-back five-goal games against VMI and UNC Greensboro, marking the first time since the 2001 campaign that the College has accomplished the feat. In 2001, the Tribe defeated College of Charleston, 5-0, on Sept. 1, before notching a 6-1 win over Marist on Sept. 3.

- The W&M-ODU game in Norfolk, Va., on Oct. 26 will be televised live on Fox Soccer Channel as part of the NSCAA/FSC College Soccer Game of the Week. It will be the 10th men's contest on television and is slated for 8 p.m. at ODU.

- Senior goalkeeper Kris Rake recorded his 13th career shutout against Drexel to move past Trevor Upton (1999-02) into fifth on W&M's career shutouts list.

- The schedule for the 2006 season will test the Tribe as half of its opponents made an appearance in the 2005 NCAA Tournament. Six of those teams were ranked in at least one of the major preseason top 25.

- Two former W&M players are currently playing in Major League Soccer (MLS) with another playing in the Norway. Steve Jolley (1993-96) is in his 10th season as an MLS vet, playing for Red Bull New York. He has appeared in 15 matches with 10 starts, while earning one assist. Wade Barrett (1994-97) is in his first season with the Houston Dynamo, earning 30 starts, while assisting on three goals. Former All-American Adin Brown (1996-99) is the first-team goalkeeper for Aalesunds FK in Norway. Aalesunds is second in the Norwegian Second Division, while Brown, as of Oct. 9, was the second-highest rated goalkeeper and sixth-highest rated player ovearll in the league. In total, over 27 former Tribe players have played pro soccer at some level.

## SCOUTING TOWSON

Towson enters the match with W&M on a seven-match unbeaten streak, including a five-game winning streak. The Tigers have also shutout their last four opponents, not allowing a goal in the last 390:57. Towson is 9-1-2 on the season and 5-0-1 in the CAA, good for second in the league. The Tigers are also ranked fifth in the NSCAA South Atlantic Region.

Aside from the conference ledger, the Tigers and Tribe have only one common opponent in Loyola (Md.). Towson tied the Greyhounds, 1-1, in the second game of the season, while W&M defeated Loyola, 2-1, to win the ODU Stihl Soccer Classic. Towson's lone blemish on the year was a 3-2 overtime loss to Hartwick.

Sebastian Haensel leads the Tigers in scoring with 15 points on five goals and five assists. Four of those tallies have resulted in game-winners for Towson. Pat Healey is second on the team in points (10) and goals (4). T.J. Thompson is second on the squad with four assists to go along with six points.

Towson has made the biggest impact on the defensive side of the field. The Tigers have a team goals against average of 0.55, including eight shutouts. In the national rankings on Oct. 9, the Tigers were 10th in team GAA and seventh in team shutout percentage. The goalkeeping tandem of Billy Chiles and Greg Flaherty have split time for the Tigers with both starting six contest. Chiles has a GAA of 0.32 with 45 saves, while Flaherty has 38 stops and a GAA of 0.78. Flaherty leads the team with four shutouts, while Chiles has three. Chiles ranks second nationally in GAA and save percentage.

W&M owns a 5-1-2 all-time record in the series with the Tigers, including a 3-0 mark in Williamsburg. The two teams played to a 0-0 tie at Towson last season. Tribe goalkeeper Brennan Wergley made six saves in the game to notch the shutout.

## SCOUTING No. 22 GEORGE MASON

The Patriots enter the weekend having moved up seven spots in the College Soccer News top 30. George Mason currently leads the CAA with a perfect 6-0 mark. The Patriots have won nine straight matches since opening the season 1-2, allowing only three goals over that stretch.

George Mason's losses on the year came by identical 2-0 scores to then-No. 3 Virginia and La Salle. In the national rankings

released by the NCAA on Oct. 9, the Patriots are eighth in team goals against average and fourth in shutout percentage, blanking eight of its 12 foes.

Chris Carroll and Adam Lobene are tied for the top spot in points for GMU with eight apiece. Carroll has four goals, while Lobene has three goals and two assists. All three of his goals have proven to be game-winners for George Mason. Josh Fleming and Francis McCardle are tied with Lobene for the team-high in assists with two.

Sean Kelley has played every minute in goal for the Patriots. He is coming off a weekend that saw him blank both Drexel and Delaware to earn Brine CAA co-Player of the Week honors with W&M's Andrew Hoxie. Kelley also earned his third CAA Rookie of the Week honor. For the year, he ranks 10th nationally in GAA at 0.58 and fifth in save percentage. He has eight shutouts with 57 saves.

The Tribe owns a 21-13-3 all-time record against the Patriots with a 12-7-1 ledger in Williamsburg. George Mason has not won a match in Williamsburg since the 1993 season when it walked away with a 4-2 overtime victory. Last season, the Patriots won, 3-2, in Fairfax, Va.

## **Reeling in the Awards, Hoxie Becomes First**

Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie became the first Tribe player in W&M's 22-year history in the CAA to win two league player of the week honors in a season. The Newport News, Va., native scored both W&M goals in a 2-1 overtime victory at VCU on Oct. 8 to win his second honor of the season.

Against VCU, Hoxie hammered home a penalty kick in the 89th minute to draw the Tribe even after junior midfielder Doug Ernst was taken down in the box. Just over six minutes into the overtime period, the 6-4 striker pressured the Ram defense before volleying a shot from 15 yards for the game-winner.

Hoxie also earned Brine CAA Player of the Week honors on Sept. 18 after earning MVP honors at the ODU Stihl Soccer Classic. During that event, he scored two-goals, including the eventual game-winner against then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro. He also assisted on the Tribe's first goal against Loyola (Md.).



## TOP DRAWER SOCCER NATIONAL TEAM OF THE WEEK

Along with the conference player of the week honors, sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie earned a spot on the Top Drawer Soccer National Team of the Week for the second time this season. He also earned the honor following his performance at the ODU Stihl Soccer Classic.

#### Two-fers

Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie and senior frontrunner Pat Scherder have found the back of the net on several occasions for the Tribe this season, including five multigoal games. Against VCU, Hoxie notched his third, two-goal game of the season becoming the first player since 2001 to register three multigoal affairs in a single season. Hoxie has pulled the trick against then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro, Drexel and VCU.

Scherder picked up his second multigoal game of the season, leading the Tribe back from a two-goal deficit to forge a tie with then-No. 23 James Madison. He also notched two scored in the Tribe's 5-1 romp of then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro on Sept. 15. Remarkably, despite entering the year as the Tribe's active goal scoring leader with 16, the two-goal games were the first of his career.

## COMEBACK KIDS

After allowing a pair of goals to No. 23 James Madison in the first 30 minutes of the contest, the Tribe rallied to forge a tie with the Dukes on Oct. 10. Senior striker Pat Scherder scored off an assist from junior Doug Ernst three minutes before halftime, and then found the equalizer in the 54th minute off a feed from junior Ryan Overdevest.

It marked the first time since Oct. 4, 2003 that W&M overcame of two-goal deficit to forge at least a tie. On that date, W&M received goals four minutes apart in the second half from Scherder and Graham Albert to tie College of Charleston, 2-2.

Last season, the Tribe overcame a two-goal deficit, but went on to lose the contest. At then-No. 19 UNC Greensboro, W&M trailed 2-0 and 3-1, before tying the contest up in the 82nd minute. The comeback was short-lived though as the Spartans scored with less than a minute remaining on a free kick to claim a 4-3 victory.

#### **ANSWERING THE CALL**

Before the season, head coach Chris Norris said he had high expectations for junior midfielder Doug Ernst. The thirdyear head man of the Green and Gold felt it was time for the Alexandria, Va., native to step up his offensive production, given his success at the prep and club levels. This season, Ernst has answered the call and is enjoying a breakout season.

Ernst has found the back of the net on three occasions, but more impressively is first in the CAA in assists with seven.

In the CAA opening victory over Drexel, Ernst notched a pair of assists his second, two-assist game of the season. He became the first W&M player to notched a pair of multiple assist games in a season since Phil Hucles had two, two-assist games in 2003. Ernst's seven assists this season are already the most in a campaign for a W&M player since Hucles had seven and Bryan Hinkle had nine in 2003.

## TRIBE CLAIMS ODU STIHL SOCCER CLASSIC

By virtue of its victories over then-No. 29 (College Soccer News) UNC Greensboro, 5-1, and Loyola (Md.), 2-1, W&M claimed the ODU Stihl Soccer Classic. The Tribe and host ODU both finished with perfect 2-0 record, but the Tribe took the title as a result of a better goal differential thanks in large part to its offensive outburst against UNC Greensboro.

In the opening match of the classic, the Tribe scored early and often in the victory over the Spartans. Senior forward Pat Scherder started the barrage with a goal in the fifth minute, before sophomore frontrunner Andrew Hoxie added the second, sending the College to a 2-0 halftime lead. Scherder added his second and junior Doug Ernst scored in the 70th minute before the Spartans got on the board three minutes later. Hoxie iced the game with his second tally of the contest in the closing minutes.

In the second game of the classic against Loyola (Md.), the Tribe again scored early on a goal from Ernst in the 17th minute, but the Greyhounds tied it up before the half. Sophomore Brock Jones added what proved to be the game-winner a minute into the second stanza as the Tribe dominated the second 45 minutes, outshooting Loyola (Md.), 14-4.

The College improved to 24-12-4 (.650) all-time at the event, winning the championship for the fourth time in its 20-year history at the classic. W&M won both its games at the event for the seventh time.

## SCORING WITH A QUICKNESS INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

The Tribe broke open a 1-0 halftime lead with goals 20 seconds apart in the 60th minute and a trio of tallies just over three minutes apart against VMI. Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie chipped the goalkeeper from 35 yards after a failed clearance at 60:23, before freshman midfielder Price Thomas hammered home a volley from six-yards out on a cross from senior forward Pat Scherder at 60:43. Junior Chris Wayne added a bending free



kick from 25 yards out at 63:28, giving W&M three straight scores in 3:05.

The 3:05 time span between the trio of Tribe goals was the 11th fastest between three goals by one team in NCAA history. The 3:05 was also the fastest in the NCAA since three UMBC players (Drew Perkins, John Clark and Larry Scheller) scored 1:46 apart in a victory over Valparaiso on Oct. 12, 2001.

The W&M goals 20 seconds apart established a school record for the fastest two consecutive goals. The 20-second mark also ranks as the 21st-fastest consecutive goals by a team in NCAA history. According to the 2006 NCAA Men's and Women's Soccer Record Book, it is also the fastest set of goals for a single team in nearly four years. The last time one team scored 20 seconds apart came on Sept. 27, 2002 when Mike Rosenthal and M.J. Serota of UMKC scored 20 seconds apart against Denver. After missing the majority of the 2005 season with an injury, senior forward Pat Scherder has shown he is back to full strength in 2006. Scherder ranks second on the team with 14 points on six goals and two assists. He ranks among the top eight in the conference in points and goals.

**RETURN TO HEALTH** 

Scherder notched his first two career multigoal games, both against ranked foes. In the Tribe's 2-2 tie with No. 23 James Madison, the senior striker scored three minutes before the half and then in the 54th minute as W&M overcame a two-goal deficit. He also turned in a two-goal performance in the Tribe's 5-1 win over then-No. 29 UNC Greensboro at the ODU Soccer Classic. He went on to earn All-Tournament honors as the event, marking the second time he earned an All-Tournament honor this season. He also garnered the accolade at the Wake Forest adidas Classic to open the year.

Against Stony Brook, Scherder not only iced the game with his second-half goal, but started for the first time in nearly a year.

Scherder last started a match on Sept. 9, 2005 against Clemson. The Vienna, Va., native earned first-team all-conference and second-team all-region accolades as a junior in 2004, but missed the final 15 games of last season. The speedy forward leads all current Tribe players in career goals with 20.

#### GAME OF FIRST

Four different W&M players scored their first career goals in the 5-0 victory over VMI. Junior midfielder Doug Ernst scored his first career goal, the game-winner, in the 26th minute of play to lead the Tribe firsts. Freshman midfielder Price Thomas, junior back Chris Wayne and sophomore forward Nathan Belcher each scored the first tallies of their career in the second half to push the Tribe to victory. Sophomore forward Andrew Hoxie led W&M with three points on a goal and an assist. It marked the first time in his career that Hoxie recorded both a tally and a helper in a single game.

Price Thomas scored on a volley in the six-yard box in the 60th minute. Wayne notched the Tribe's fourth tally of the contest at the 63:28 mark off a free kick, bending it inside the near post to the upper left corner of the goal. In his first career appearance for W&M, Belcher scored less than five minutes after entering the contest to give the College a 5-0 lead. Senior forward Jarrett Thomas hit an outside-footed shot from a severe angle on goal. The VMI goal-keeper made the diving save to deny the chance, but Belcher was there to clean up the mess, pushing the ball in from six yards out.

Along with Belcher, redshirt freshman midfielder Preston Whitlock and senior goalkeeper Scott Kelsey made the first appearances of their W&M careers against the Keydets. Kelsey played the final 16:54 in net, but was not tested.

## **FRESHMAN STARTERS**

Freshmen Price Thomas and Roger Bothe have wasted little time making a significant impact on the W&M program. Thomas has started every game at the attacking midfielder position and tallied his first career goal against VMI. He has added a flare and creativity to the Tribe attack. Bothe, the 2005-06 Gatorade Virginia State Player of the Year, has appeared in all 14 Tribe games, including starts in the last 13 at back. 
