



The 2006-07 season brought numerous milestones to the William and Mary men's tennis program. The College finished the year at 16-12, earning an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament as part of a CAA-record four schools earning a spot in the tournament. It marked the 10th time in school history and the second time in the last three seasons that the College earned a spot in the NCAA Tournament.

The hits didn't stop there either as the College garnered its highest ITA ranking in school history. On April 10, the Tribe moved up to No. 31 on the strength of its 4-3 upset of then-No. 23 Old Dominion on April 3. The Tribe spent a program-best five straight weeks ranked in the top 40 nationally and finished the year at No. 45 in the final poll. The Tribe tallied eight wins over ranked competition during the season and all 12 of the W&M losses were to teams ranked No. 34 or higher in the final national rankings.

Head coach Peter Daub eclipsed a career milestone of his own during the 2007 spring campaign. Daub tallied his 200th win at the College on March 9 as the Tribe defeated George Washington, 7-0, in its first outdoor home match of the season. Daub became only the eighth W&M head coach in any sport to win 200, or more, contests at the institution.

The College brought home numerous honors during the 2007 campaign as well. W&M totaled six CAA weekly honors, the most in a single season for the Tribe. Keziel Juneau earned CAA Singles Player of the Week honors on two occasions, becoming one of only two players to accomplish that feat in a single season. He also teamed with Alex Cojanu to earn CAA Doubles Team of the Week honors on a trio of occasions, becoming only the second Tribe doubles pair to take home three weekly honors in a season. Colin O'Brien and Richard Wardell joined the parade as well earning CAA Doubles Team of the Week honors on March 18.

W&M placed a trio of players among the All-CAA teams as Cojanu headlined the group, earning first-team singles honors after garnering third team honors during the previous season. O'Brien was a second-team selection in singles, while Juneau was a third-team singles honoree. All three players were First-Team All-CAA in doubles as the College was the lone team to place two pairs on the first team. Cojanu and O'Brien were First-Team VaSID All-State selections in doubles, while Juneau was a second-team honoree in both disciplines. Juneau did however take home the VaSID Rookie of the Year honor as the top first-year player in the state of Virginia.

O'Brien and Cojanu became the second W&M doubles team in the last 50 years to earn a spot in the NCAA Doubles Championship. The pair started off the year in dramatic style, capturing the ITA Mideast Regional Doubles Championship in November. O'Brien and Cojanu continued their stellar run, defeating the No. 1-ranked doubles team nationally in John Isner and Louis Flores of Georgia in the teams' dualmatch on Feb. 4. The tandem advanced to the NCAA Round of 16 before falling to the eventual national champions from Middle Tennessee State. They finished the year at 20-8 overall and ranked No. 21 nationally. Cojanu and Juneau also finished the season ranked nationally at No. 35.



NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

The College of William and Mary's 1946-47 men's tennis team posted the finest record in Tribe history when it claimed the team title at the National Intercollegiate Tournament in Los Angeles, in June of 1947. The netters, coached by Dr. Sharvey G. Umbeck, tallied 10 points to clinch first-place honors. Leading the way for the Tribe was Gardner Larned, who won the national singles title that same year by defeating Vic Seixas of North Carolina 6-3, 9-11, 4-6, 6-3, 6-1. Other members of the 1947 team included Tut Bartzen, Fred Kovaleski, Bob Doll, Bren Macken, Howe Atwater, Lyman Chennault, Dick Randell, Jim Macken, George Fricke, Bill Ozenberger and Bob Galloway.

In 1948, Kovelski and team captain Bartzen, returning as the nation's fourth-and fifth-ranked players, guided the Tribe to its second-straight national team title. In addition, the duo captured the national doubles championship, a feat that has yet to be repeated in William and Mary men's tennis history.


