W&M is ranked ninth in the nation by womensfieldhockey.com, 14th in the NFHCA Division I Coaches Poll, and 18th in the BPRRatings.com computer rankings ... The Tribe has won nine of its last 11 games, including victories over No. 8 Princeton, No. 11 Delaware and No. 14 Virginia ... W&M's only losses during that stretch were at No. 3 Duke (3-2) and home against No. 4 North Carolina (1-0) ... Jordan Steele leads the team with 29 points and five assists, and is tied for first with 12 goals ... Kelly McQuade also has 12 goals and is second with four assists and 28 points ... Stacey Gaenzle has started 15 games in goal with a 1.35 goals against average, 68 saves and one shutout.

In the CAA Tournament

This will be W&M's 13th appearance in the CAA Tournament, where the Tribe has a 10-12 record all time ... For the second straight year and third time in the last four seasons, W&M will be the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament ... This will also be the second straight year W&M has faced Delaware in the semifinals ... Last season the Tribe defeated UD, 4-1, in the semifinals, before falling to Old Dominion, 2-0, in the championship game.
