- 1921 - 1922 First tennis team in existence. Thelma Brown - probable coach. 2-1 record (no record of opponents).
- 1922 - 1923 Flat Hat lists first official women's tennis team. No records available.
- 1923 - 1924 No coach listed, may have been Thelma Brown or more likely Martha Barksdale. Eilleen Moody is captain. 0-1 record.

Karen Gallego-Eastern Region Runner Up, qualified for NCAA Singles Championships (lost 1st round), ranked #25 in Nation.
