

Alexandria 16th Augth 1802

Dear Sir,

Mr Henry Moore from this place intending out to the Western Country, I avail myself of the opportunity to send you the Bond of Conveyance I hold, he will receive the Deeds for the Lands therein mentioned to be conveyed as I suppose they are regularly made out and recorded - I hope you went into the neighbourhood where the Land lies last Fall, as you mentioned to me in your Letter of the 3^d of August last, and can inform Mr Moore where and how it lies, and fix'd some persons thereon to take care of it, and pay the Taxes -
