

Still another area to which consideration should be given in the future is the development of degree programs in the arts and sciences. The need for this type of development at R.P.I. was pointed out by a competent committee which studied education opportunities in this area. It was felt that in a community so large as the Richmond metropolitan area there should be a state-supported program leading to the bachelor's degree in general education in the arts and sciences. It was felt also that this responsibility properly should be assigned to the Richmond Professional Institute. When such a development is undertaken only a relatively limited extension of existing courses will be required since the usual liberal arts departments are already in existence and functioning.

3. Provision of adequate physical facilities.

At present many of the programs offered are inadequately housed and lack physical facilities to permit the most effective instruction. Needs include classroom buildings, a library, an auditorium, dormitories, and a student center. Additional space is required for physical education for both men and women. This list is not intended to be inclusive, but rather to illustrate the importance of the realization of this objective to the future development of the College. Not only is the provision of adequate physical facilities important in accommodating the increasing number of students R.P.I. will be called upon to serve, but it has also a direct relationship to objective number one, namely, the strengthening of the existing programs and increasing the effectiveness of instruction.
