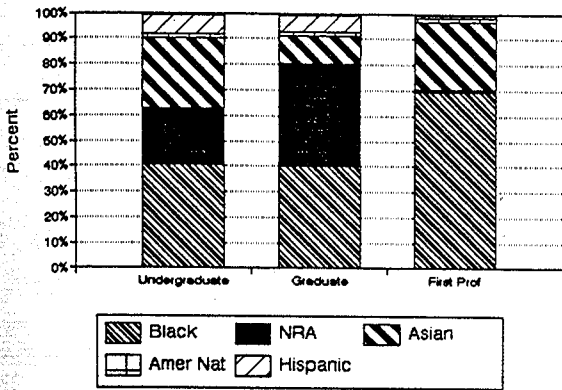

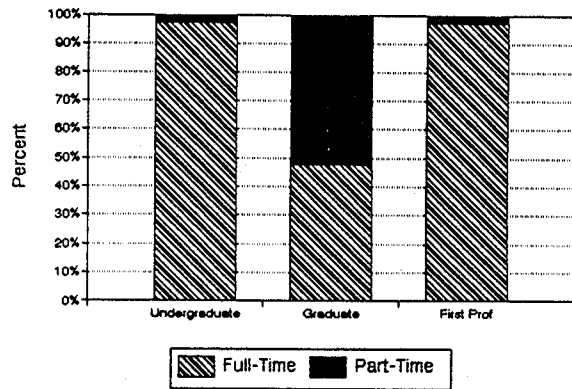

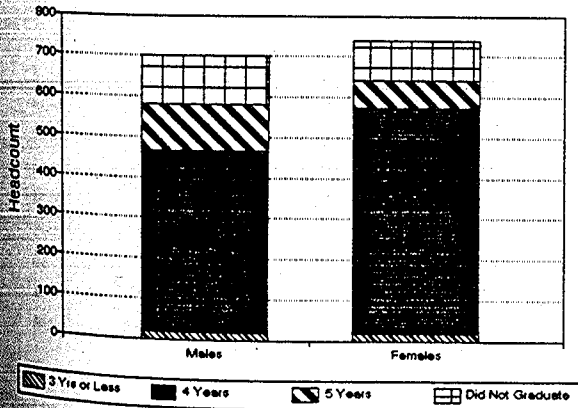
Fall 1991 Enrollment
Minority Distribution by Level



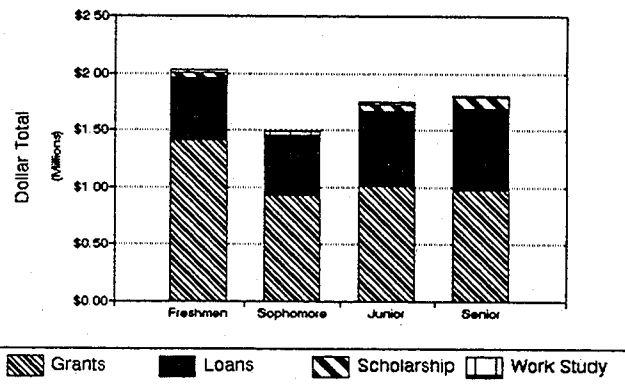
Fall 1991 Enrollment

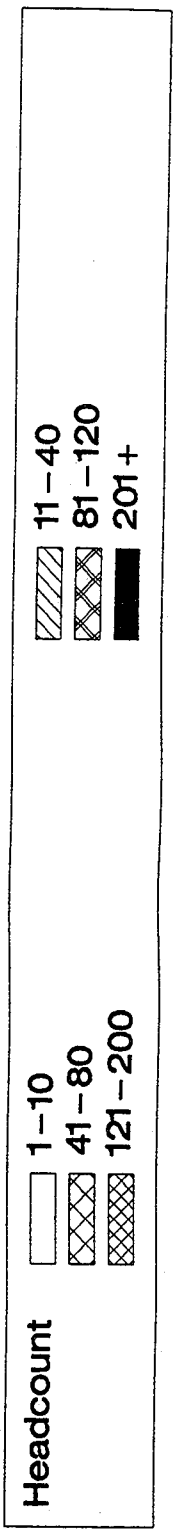
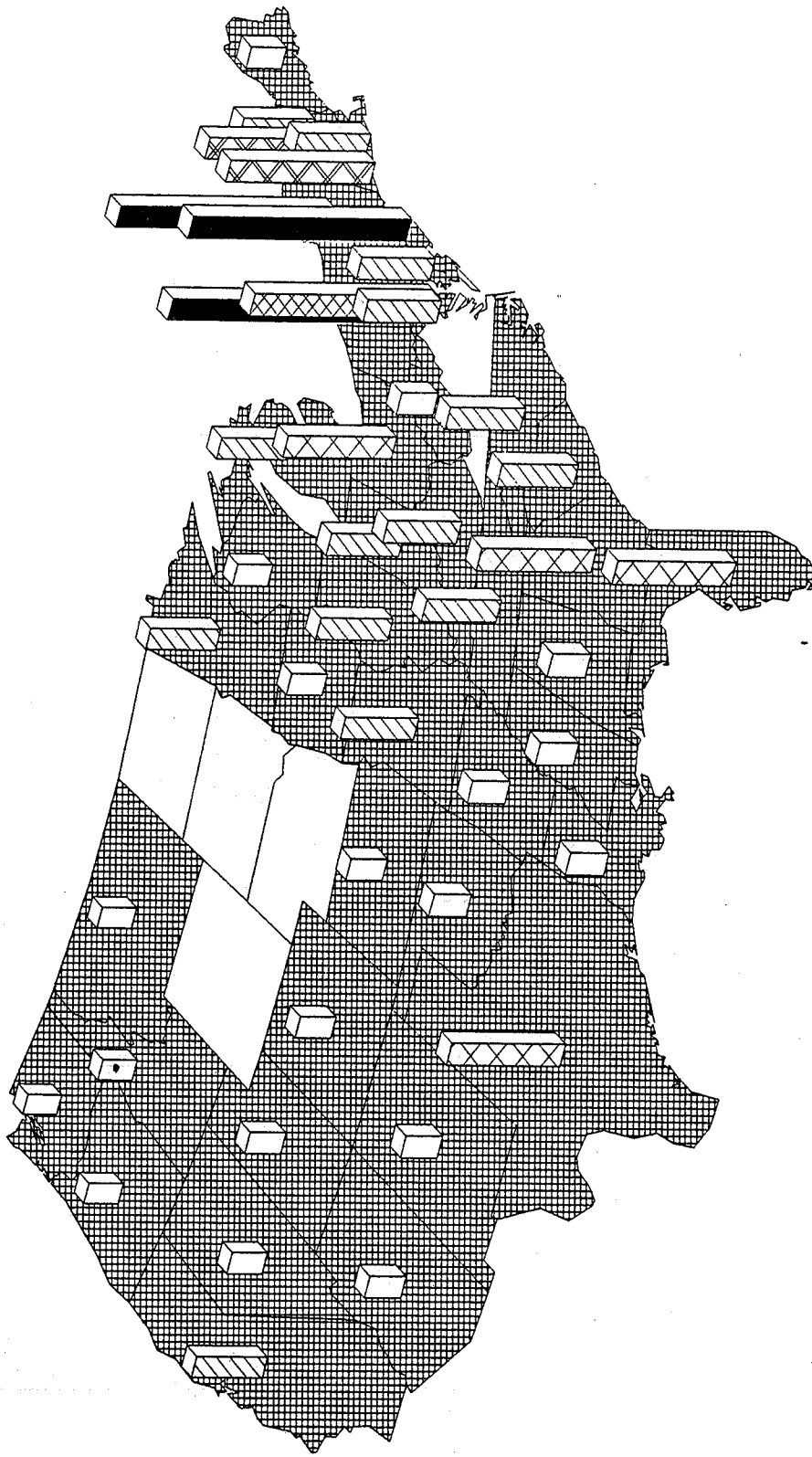

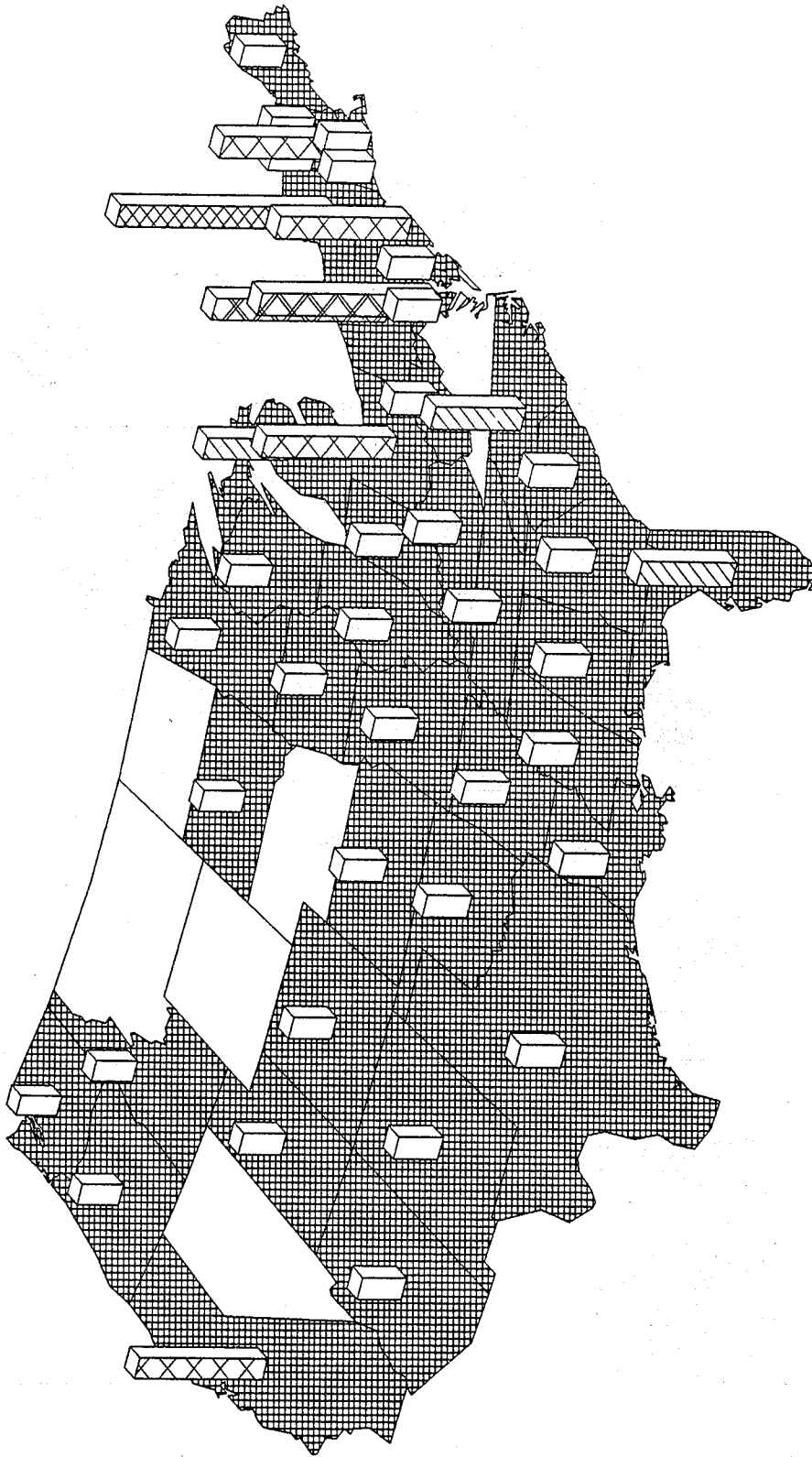

Domicile of Non Resident Undergraduate Students Fall 1991



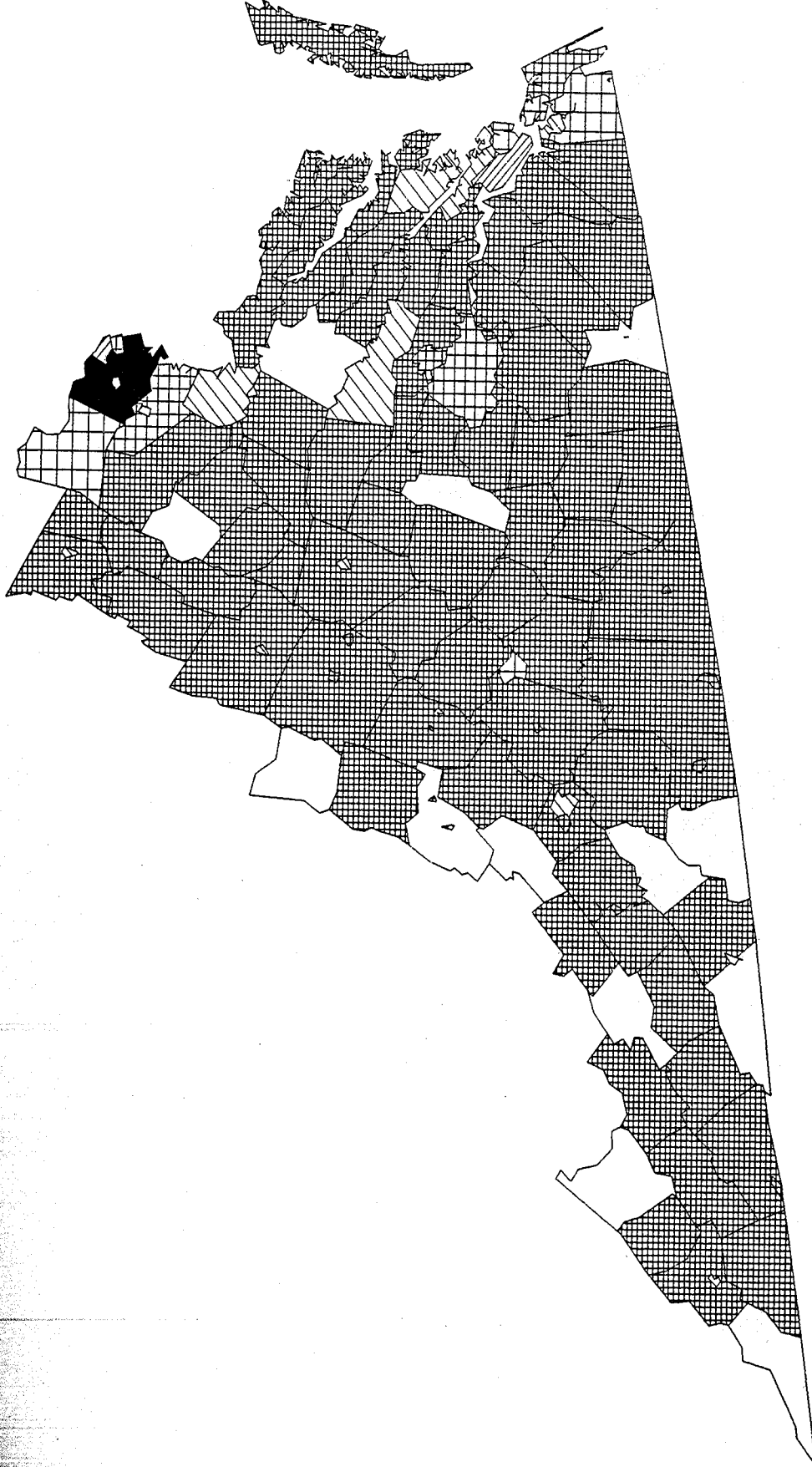
Domicile of Non Resident Graduate Students

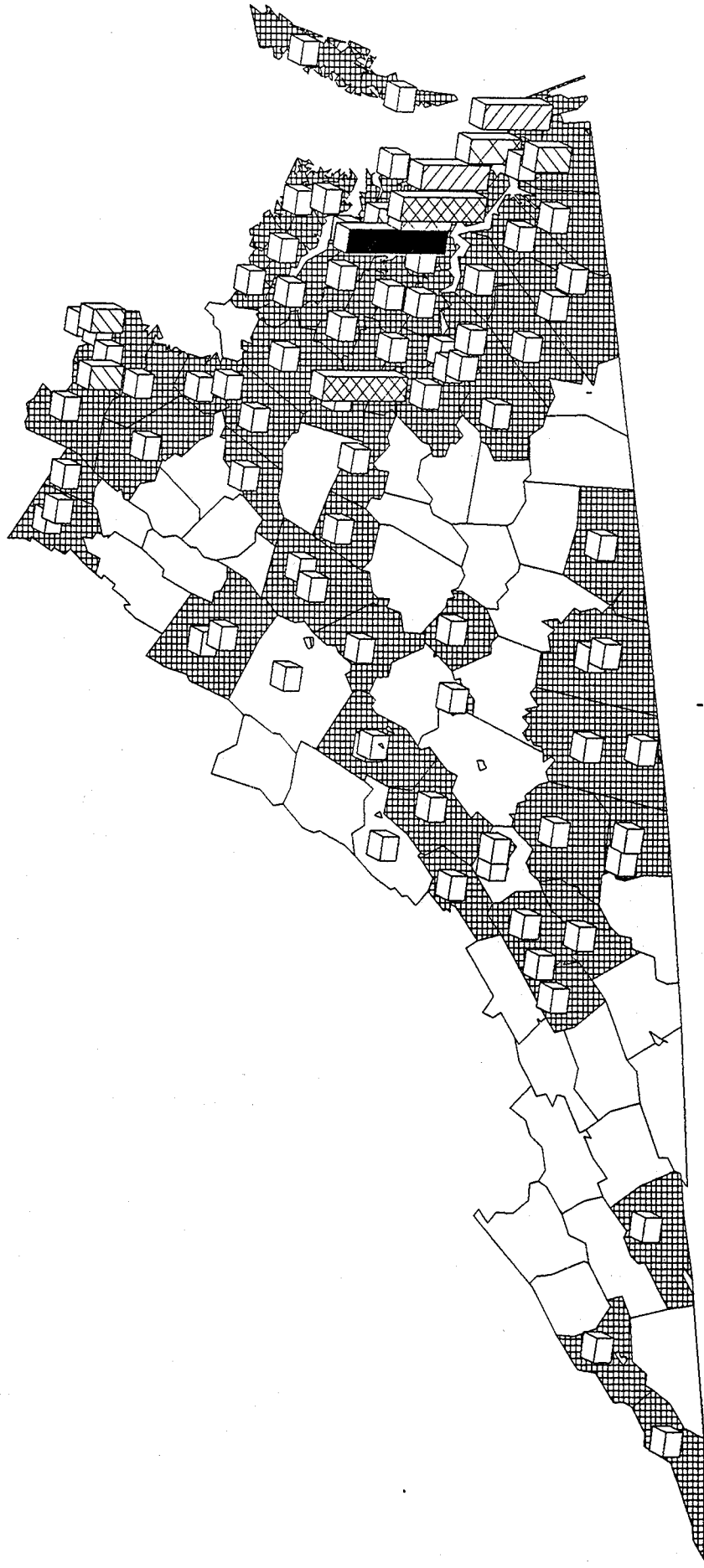
