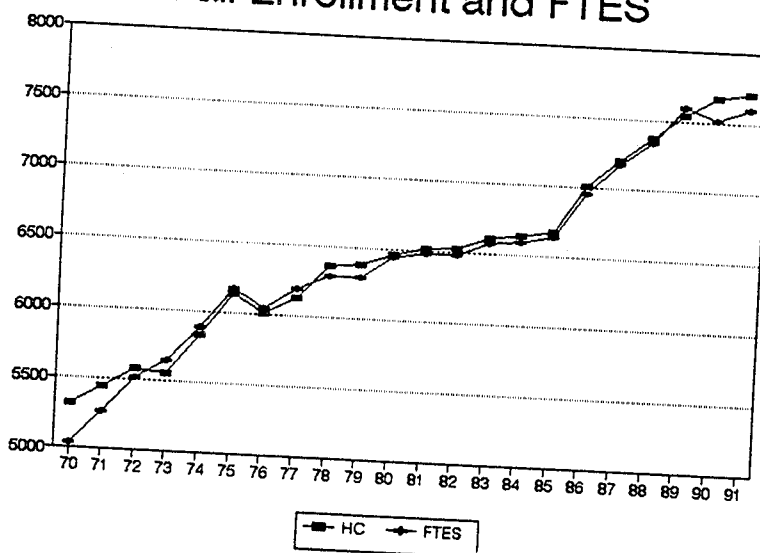

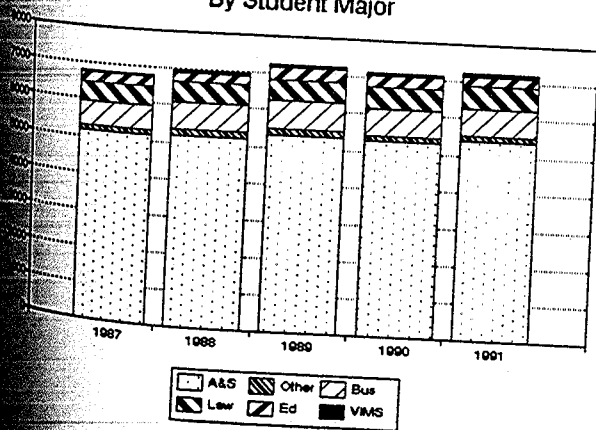

Fall Enrollment and FTES

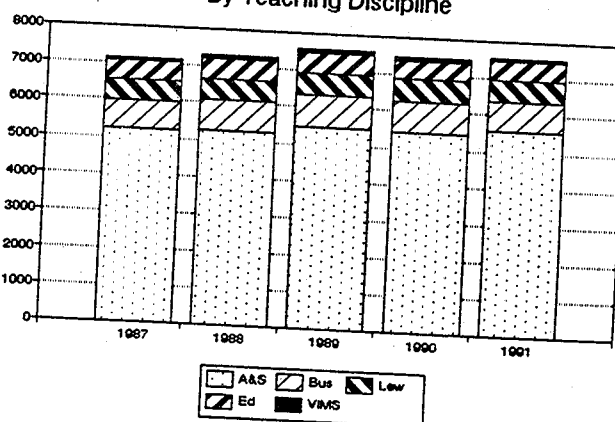


Five Year Trends - Fall 1987-1991
