About the Tribe

William and Mary enters the NCAA Tournament ranked 36th in the nation with a record of 19-12 ... This season, the Tribe won its 17th Colonial Athletic Association title in 20 tries ... W&M finished second in the CAA the three times that it did not win the conference championship ... This is the Tribe's 13th appearance in the NCAA Tournament and its ninth in the last 10 seasons ... Last year, the Tribe reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, defeating Temple and South Alabama in Williamsburg, before eventually falling to Duke.

Head Coach Kevin Epley

Tribe head coach Kevin Epley is in his first season at W&M, after spending the last three years leading the Fresno State women's team ... This season he was voted as the CAA Coach of the Year, his third consecutive conference coach of the year honor, after earning the award from the Western Athletic Conference in 2002 and 2003 ... This is also his third consecutive season coaching a team to a league title, as he led the Bulldogs to the WAC Championship in 2002 and 2003 ... He led his Fresno State teams to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in each of his three seasons ... Epley was the No. 1 player on the men's team at Southern Methodist and was named to the All-Southwest Conference First Team in 1995.

Tribe Extends CAA Dynasty

W&M has dominated the Colonial Athletic Association in women's tennis like few other teams in any sport or conference ... Including this year's championship, the Green and Gold have won 17 of the 20 CAA titles in women's tennis, finishing second the other three seasons ... Including regular season and tournament matches, W&M has a record of 98-3 (.970) against CAA teams, with two losses coming in the league title match ... No school has won more than 13 CAA titles in any other sport.

Muth Named CAA Co-Player of the Year

Tribe sophomore **Megan Muth** was voted by the CAA's head coaches as the league's Co-Player of the Year, along with Old Dominion's Nataly Cahana ... The 2003 CAA and ITA East Region Rookie of the Year, Muth is currently ranked 25th in the nation in singles and 26th in the country in doubles, with partner **Amy Wei**.

Streiking

W&M is currently on an eight-match winning streak, its longest of the season ... The Tribe ended the regular season by winning five straight matches, then won three matches in the CAA Tournament, on the way to the school's 17th league title ... Individually, a number of W&M's players are also in the midst of impressive streaks ... Freshman **Kristen Dunbar** has won her last nine singles matches, dropping just two sets in a streak that dates back to March 15 ... Rookie **Emily Mowery** has won six straight singles matches, including an impressive run in

the CAA Tournament, where she won three contests at No. 5, while losing just one game ... Junior **Amy Wei** has won five consecutive singles matches, while she and sophomore **Megan Muth** have won seven of their last eight contests at the top doubles position.

Close Calls

The Green and Gold have had plenty of experience in close matches this year, with 11 contests ending with a final score of 4-3 ... W&M has won seven of those matches, including the conference final and two others that began the College's current eight-match winning streak.

Tournament Tested

This will be the third straight year (and 13th overall) that the Tribe has competed in the NCAA Tournament ... Every player on the College's roster has advanced to the national postseason each year she has been at W&M ... In 2002, the Tribe lost to Clemson, 4-3, in the first round at Wake Forest ... Last season, the Green and Gold hosted the first two rounds of the tournament, defeating Temple and South Alabama, before falling to Duke in the third round at Florida ... The current players on the roster have an 8-4 singles record and a 4-5 doubles mark in the Tribe's last four NCAA Tournament matches.

Muth and Wei Win ITA East Regional, Selected to NCAA Individuals

Junior **Amy Wei** and sophomore **Megan Muth** teamed up to win the ITA East Region doubles championship on their way to a 10-1 record in the fall ... The two

have been selected to compete in the NCAA Doubles Championship ... Muth, the 2003 ITA East Region singles champion, has also been picked to compete in the national singles tournament ... Both events will be played at the University of Georgia following the NCAA team tournament.

Taking Care of Business

W&M has won 102 consecutive matches (including 65 shutouts) against unranked teams, a streak that has continued for more than 10 years ... The Tribe defeated its 100th straight unranked opponent on April 17 with a 4-0 win over East Tennessee State in the final match of the regular season ... W&M's last loss to an unranked opponent was March 6, 1994 at San Diego (6-3).

Tough Competition

As always, the Tribe was tested with one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation this season ... 20 of W&M's 25 non-CAA matches were against nationally-ranked teams ... The College has faced nine teams currently ranked in the top 25 and has played 14 matches against 2004 NCAA Tournament teams.

The Illinois Series

W&M has faced Illinois in just two dual matches, both Tribe wins on neutral courts ... The Green and Gold defeated the Illini, 8-1, in Lexington, Kentucky on February 27, 1987 and posted a 7-2 victory in San Diego on March 9, 1994 ... Tribe junior **Kate Boomershine** transferred to W&M from Illinois after her rookie season.

The Duke Series

In one of the Tribe's longest-running non-conference rivalries, W&M has faced Duke 23 times, with the Blue Devils holding a 16-7 lead in the series ... The two teams have met at least once a year, beginning with the 1995 campaign ... Duke ended the College's season last year, with a 5-0 win in the third round of the NCAA Tournament at Gainesville, Florida ... The Blue Devils have been ranked in the top six nationally in each of their last 11 meetings against the Tribe ... W&M last defeated Duke on February 9, 2000 with a 6-3 win in Williamsburg.

The Furman Series

The Tribe has won all three of its matches against Furman in women's tennis ... W&M blanked the Paladins, 9-0, in Williamsburg on March 9, 1989, in the last meeting between the two teams ... The Tribe won at Furman, 6-3, on March 3, 1986 in Greenville and 7-2 in the spring of 1980.

Quick Shots

Should W&M and Duke both win their first round matches, the second round match against the Blue Devils would be the Tribe's fifth match this season against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, all on the road or a neutral court ... That would be just one fewer than the six times (including three postseason matches) that the Green and Gold played against CAA opponents this year ... W&M has a winning percentage of .621 or better at every singles position except No. 4, where the Tribe is just 10-18 (.357) ... The College has lost the doubles point 15 times this season ... W&M is 4-11 when losing the doubles point ... With no seniors on the roster, every Tribe player is expected to return next season.
