Tribe Players to Compete in NCAA Individual Women's Tennis Tournaments

William and Mary women's tennis players will begin play May 23 and 24 in the NCAA Individual Tournament ... Sophomore **Megan Moulton-Levy**, ranked 37th in the nation, was one of 64 players selected to the singles tournament, which begins on Monday, while junior **Megan Muth**, ranked No. 70, also has a chance to compete in the event as the fourth alternate ... Moulton-Levy and senior **Candice Fuchs**, ranked 21st in the nation, were selected to the 32-team doubles tournament, which begins on Tuesday ... This is the fourth straight season and the seventh time in the last eight years that the Green and Gold has had at least one singles player and one doubles team selected to compete in the NCAA's individual tournaments ... The tournament will be hosted by the University of Georgia at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex ... The brackets for both tournaments will be released by the NCAA on Saturday May 21.

About the Tribe

W&M ended the season in the second round of the NCAA Tournament with a loss at No. 11 Clemson ... The Tribe had defeated No. 34 Wisconsin, 4-1, in the first round of the tournament ... W&M is currently ranked 20th in the nation and ended the year with a 20-6 record ... It was the Tribe's fourth straight and 14th overall appearance in the NCAA Tournament ... W&M earned an at-large berth in the tournament by winning its league record 18th Colonial Athletic Association championship ... It was the ninth time that the Tribe recorded at least 20 wins in a season.

Awards Pile up for Megan Moulton-Levy

In her first season of collegiate competition, sophomore **Megan Moulton-Levy** has already earned some significant accolades ... She became the 11th W&M player to be named CAA Player of the Year and the sixth to be named the Most Outstanding Performer of the CAA Tournament ... Last week it was announced that she had been selected as the ITA East Region Rookie of the Year, the fifth Tribe player to earn that honor ... Moulton-Levy is just the third player in school history to earn all three awards in her career and

the first to win them all in the same season ... Current junior **Megan Muth** was named CAA Player of the Year and Tournament MVP last season and was named the region's rookie of the year in 2003 ... Six-time All-American **Lauren Nikolaus** (1998) was named CAA Player of the Year in 1996, 1997 and 1998, was the CAA Tournament MVP in 1997 and 1998, and was the ITA East Region Rookie of the Year in 1995.

Head Coach Kevin Epley Named CAA Coach of the Year Again

For the second straight season, W&M head coach **Kevin Epley** was named the CAA Coach of the Year ... Epley is in his second season leading the Tribe ... It is the fourth straight year that he has been named his conference's coach of the year, after earning the award from the Western Athletic Conference while at Fresno State in 2002 and 2003 ... This is the fourth straight season, and the 10th time overall that W&M's head coach has been named CAA Coach of the Year ... **Brian Kalbas** won the award five times (1995, 1996, 1999, 2002 and 2003) and **Ray Reppert** won the honor three times (1987, 1991 and 1992).

Candice Fuchs Named W&M Senior Female Athlete of the Year

Candice Fuchs was named the 2005 W&M Senior Female Athlete of the Year by the Tribe Club, the athletics department's fundraising arm ... Currently 107th in the nation in singles and 21st in doubles (with sophomore **Megan Moulton-Levy**), she has been ranked as high as 21st in the nation in singles and ninth in doubles (with senior **Kate Boomershine**) in her career.

In the Rankings

Along with the team's national ranking of 20th, three Tribe singles players and two doubles team are also ranked ... Sophomore **Megan Moulton-Levy** is 37th, junior **Megan Muth** is 70th and senior **Candice Fuchs** is 107th ... In doubles, Moulton-Levy and Fuchs are ranked 21st, while Muth and senior **Amy Wei** are ranked 56th.

Fuchs and Moulton-Levy Win ITA East Region Doubles Title

The Tribe doubles team of senior **Candice Fuchs** and sophomore **Megan Moulton-Levy**, currently ranked 21st in the nation, won the ITA East Region doubles title this fall ... The pair won five matches against unranked opponents, including a 9-8 win over current No. 24 Olga Borisova/Marianna Yuferova (Virginia Commonwealth) in the final to claim the title ... It marked the second straight season that W&M took the region's title and was the third regional title in the last three seasons for the Tribe ... Last season, current senior **Amy Wei** and junior **Megan Muth** won the East Region doubles title ... Muth won the region's singles championship as a freshman in 2002.

Seeing 20-20

Four players this season have won at least 20 matches in both singles and doubles ... Sophomore **Megan Moulton-Levy** has the highest combined total with 56 victories (28 singles, 28 doubles) ... Also in the 20-20 club are senior **Candice Fuchs** (25 singles, 29 doubles), junior **Megan Muth** (25 and 26) and senior **Lena Sherbakov** (29 and 25) ... Moulton-Levy's 56 combined wins are the most since Muth combined for 59 victories last season, tied for the eighth most in school history.

W&M Dominated CAA Weekly Awards

On April 12 the Colonial Athletic Association announced that the Tribe's doubles team of senior **Candice Fuchs** and sophomore **Megan Moulton-Levy** were once again selected as the league's doubles team of the week ... It was the third time the pair had been selected for the honor this season, also earning the award on March 16 and April 5 ... Fuchs was also named the CAA Singles Player of the Week on April 12, the third different W&M player to earn the honor this season ... Senior **Lena Sherbakov** earned the award on March 30 and Moulton-Levy received

the honor on March 16 ... Since the league began naming tennis players of the week last season, W&M has taken 13 of the 26 awards.

W&M Wins CAA Record 18th League Title

W&M earned an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament by winning the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament on April 24 ... It was W&M's second consecutive conference title and the 18th time that the Tribe won the CAA in the last 20 seasons ... No other CAA school has won as many league titles in any other sport ... W&M finished second in the CAA the only three years that it did not win the conference tournament.

CAA Dominance

This season the Green and Gold continued its dominance of the Colonial Athletic Association by winning the school's 18th women's tennis title ... Since the conference began sponsoring women's tennis in the 1984-85 season, the Tribe has a record of 103-3 (.972) in all dual matches (including postseason) against CAA opponents ... Of teams that have been in the CAA for more than four seasons, W&M's women's tennis team is the only team (in any sport) in conference history to have never lost a home contest (regular or postseason) to another CAA opponent ... W&M has won 18 of the 21 CAA titles awarded, finishing second the other three times.

Home Sweet Home

The Green and Gold ended the regular season undefeated in its 10 home matches ... W&M also won its final six home matches of the 2004 season, giving the Tribe an active 16-match home winning streak ... The last time the Tribe went undefeated at home in the regular season was 1998, when the team was 11-0 in the regular season in Williamsburg ... W&M also went 2-0 at home in the CAA Tournament that season ... The Tribe ended 1998 in the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tournament.

Two Players Reach the Century Mark

This season senior **Amy Wei** became just the fourth player in W&M history to compile 100 career doubles victories, while senior **Lena Sherbakov** became the seventh Tribe player to win 100 singles matches in her career ... Wei reached her milestone on April 6, when she and junior **Megan Muth**, then ranked 48th in the nation, defeated Cristina Arribas and Alexa Korotkevich (Virginia Commonwealth) on April 6, 9-7 ... Wei ended her career with 103 career doubles victories, third-best in school history ... Sherbakov picked up her 100th singles win on April 23 in the semifinals of the CAA Tournament, as she defeated Molly Molony (UNC Wilmington), 6-3, 6-1 ... She ended her career seventh in W&M history with 102 singles wins.

W&M Earns Highest Ranking in Eight Years

The Tribe was sixth in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association National Rankings on March 15, the highest ranking for W&M since the Tribe was fourth in the nation on March 18, 1997 ... That season the College advanced to the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tournament, ending the year with a record of 23-7 ... The No. 6 national ranking is the second-highest for a W&M team in any sport this season, trailing only the football team, which ended the season ranked third in Division I-AA.

Not a Sin to Win

W&M extended its winning streak to seven matches with a pair of victories over ranked teams in Las Vegas in early March ... The Tribe defeated No. 57 Penn, 6-1, in a neutral-site match on March 9, before beating No. 30 UNLV, 5-2, on March 12 ... It was the Tribe's first trip to Las Vegas since March 6, 2002, when the Green and Gold lost to UNLV, 5-1.

Taking Care of Business

W&M has won 109 consecutive matches (including 71 shutouts) against unranked teams, a streak that has endured for more than 11 years ... The Tribe's last loss to an unranked opponent was March 6, 1994 at San Diego (6-3), when only the top 30 teams in the country were ranked (currently, the ITA ranks the top 75 teams in the nation) ... Since that time, W&M is an incredible 186-15 (.925) against teams outside the top 25.

W&M Beats Duke For First Top Five Win in Five Years

When the Tribe upset fifth-ranked Duke, 4-3, on the road on March 2, it marked the first win for the Green and Gold over a top five team in over five years ... Coincidentally, the last time W&M upset a top five team was also the last time that the Tribe had defeated the Blue Devils, recording a 6-3 win over then No. 5 Duke on Feb. 9, 2000 in Durham ... This year's victory over the Blue Devils was also the first time that Tribe head coach **Kevin Epley** had ever led a team to a win over a top five opponent.

Another Big Win

The Tribe's decisive 6-1 win over No. 16 Clemson was its first over a top 20 opponent since defeating No. 14 South Alabama, 4-1, in Williamsburg on May 10, 2003 in the second round of the NCAA Tournament ... It was the Tribe's largest margin of victory against a top 20 team since defeating No. 9 Northwestern, 6-1, in Williamsburg on January 26, 2002.

Conference Confusion

Although W&M is a member of the Colonial Athletic Association, the Tribe played just two CAA schools in the regular season (Old Dominion and Virginia Commonwealth) ... W&M was originally scheduled to play CAA member James Madison on Jan. 30, but that match was canceled when inclement weather prevented JMU from making the trip to Williamsburg ... The Tribe had six regular season matches against the Atlantic Coast Conference (Clemson, Duke, Maryland, Virginia, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest) ... W&M will also played three matches against Conference USA (South Florida, Tulane, TCU) and two each against the Big East (Notre Dame, West Virginia) and the Big 10 (Northwestern, Ohio State) in the regular season.

Season-Opening Success

W&M has won its last 17 season-opening matches and has started the year by winning at least the first two matches in each of the last 14 seasons ... This season, the Tribe opened on Jan. 23 with home wins over East Tennessee State (7-0) and Richmond (6-1) ... It is the 10th straight season that W&M has opened at home.

2004 Fall Review

W&M had a successful fall season, with a team record of 56-34 (.622) in singles and 36-19 (.655) in doubles ... Tribe individuals won the title match in three singles flights and four doubles flights.

W&M in the NCAA Singles Tournament

Entering this season, W&M has had 17 players make 26 appearances in the NCAA Singles Tournament ... Junior **Megan Muth** advanced to the second round in her only appearance in the event, while current senior **Candice Fuchs** also reached the second round as a sophomore in 2003 in her only appearance in the event ... The Tribe has had at least one player reach at least the second round in seven of the last 10 seasons, although no player has gone farther than that in that time frame ... The only time a W&M player won at least two matches at the event was 1992 at the Taube Family Tennis Center in Palo Alto, California ... That year **Julie Shiflet** won three matches before falling in the quarterfinals to Laxmi Poruri (Stanford) and **Karen van der Merwe** won two matches before losing to Heather Willens (Stanford) in the round of 16 ... With a 3-1 (.750) record at the tournament, Shiflet is the only Tribe player with a winning record at the event, although five players (including Muth and Fuchs) have a .500 record in the singles championship ... Entering this season, W&M players have combined for a 15-26 (.366) record at the tournament.

W&M in the NCAA Doubles Tournament

W&M has had 15 doubles teams, made up of 21 individuals, make a total of 16 appearances in the NCAA Doubles Tournament ... This will be the fourth straight season, and the 16th time in the last 19 seasons that the Green and Gold has had at least one doubles team participate in the event ... Last season the doubles team of junior **Megan Muth** and senior **Amy Wei** earned All-America status after advancing to the quarterfinal round ... Beginning with a thrilling come-from-behind three-set win over the top-ranked Stanford duo of Lauren Barnikow and Erin Burdette (2-6, 7-6 (2), 6-2) in the first round, it was the best performance for a Tribe duo since 1998 ... That year the W&M team of **Lauren Nikolaus** and **Michelle O** advanced to the semifinals, the best finish for a Tribe team in the NCAA Tournament ... Senior **Candice Fuchs** will make her third appearance in the doubles tournament, all with different partners ... In 2002 she and **Jessyca Arthur** lost in the first round to Vanderbilt's Sarah Riske and Aleke Tsubanos ... Fuchs and senior **Kate Boomershine** lost to Virginia Commonwealth's Silvia Urickova and Barbora Zahnova in the first round in 2003 ...

With her third appearance in the tournament this season, Fuchs will tie three other W&M players (**Katrin Guenther**, **Julie Kaczmarek** and **Nikolaus**) for the most appearances by a Tribe player in the event ... W&M's teams have combined for a 14-16 (.467) record at the tournament.
