TRIBE MEETS No. 2 GEORGIA IN NCAA ROUND OF 16

The William and Mary women's tennis team, seeded No. 15 in the NCAA Tournament, will travel to Athens, Ga., to battle the host and No. 2 seed Bulldogs of Georgia on May 18 at 6 p.m. Georgia is hosting the NCAA Championships, May 17-28, at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex on both Henry Feild Stadium and McWhorter Courts. The Tribe's opening match against UGA will be played on Henry Feild Stadium courts. Live stats and live video (Henry Field Stadium only) will be available online at GeorgiaBulldogs.com.

The Tribe is making its first appearance in the Round of 16 since the 2003 season. W&M rolled through Richmond (4-0) and No. 19 Wake Forest (4-1) during the NCAA Regional, May 11-12, in Williamsburg. The College is making its sixth straight appearance in the NCAA tournament and has appeared in 12 of the last 13 NCAA Tournaments. Overall, it is the Tribe's 16th appearance.

slots for the win. The Bulldogs needed a three-set, 3-6, 6-4, 6-4, win from Evgenia Subbotina over Klaudyna Kasztelaniec at the No. 5 slot to claim the team victory.

The two teams have met on a pair of occasions in the NCAA Tournament. In 1997, the College tallied a 5-0 win over the Bulldogs to advance to the quarterfinals, while UGA dealt the Tribe a 5-2 setback in 1998 in the quarterfinal round.

The SEC Champion Bulldogs reached the Round of 16 with 4-0 wins over South Carolina State and Auburn. The victory over the Tigers avenged UGA's only loss of the season. They are 23-1 on the year. The only common opponent between the two teams is Georgia Tech. The Tribe knocked off the Yellow Jackets, 4-3, while the Bulldogs notched a 5-2 win.

Natalie Frazier is the Bulldogs' top singles player. She is 29-8 on the year, 16-4 at the No. 1 slot and is currently ranked No. 7 nationally. Frazier garnered the ITA Southeast Region Senior Player of the Year honor earlier this week. The Bulldog lineup features three more ranked players in No. 32 Monika Dancevic, No. 68 Yvette Hyndman and No. 72 Darya Ivanov. The Bulldogs top doubles team is Ivanov and Hyndman. The pair is 15-7 on the year and ranked No. 7 nationally.

MOULTON-LEVY, ZORICIC SEEDED AT NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Senior Megan Moulton-Levy and sophomore Katarina Zoricic became the first W&M team to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Doubles Championship. Moulton-Levy also became the first Tribe player to garner a seed in singles (No. 8) since 1998. The singles and doubles competition will be conducted May 23-28 at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex in Athens, Georgia, following the conclusion of the team championship (May 18-22). The University of Georgia will serve as host. It marks the third straight season in which Moulton-Levy has appeared in both the singles and doubles championships, while Zoricic is making her second showing at the doubles championship.

Moulton-Levy and Zoricic were automatic qualifiers to the doubles championship through the CAA. Moulton-Levy was also the automatic qualifier for the CAA in singles as well. Zoricic is one of eight alternates for the NCAA Singles Championship and would earn a spot in the field as individuals drop out. Moulton-Levy and Zoricic are 8-2 against the 32-team field and 3-0 against the top eight seeds, while Moulton-Levy has amassed a 12-4 ledger against the 64-player singles field to go along with a 5-2 mark against the top 16 seeds.

It marks the sixth straight season and the 10th in the last 11 years that the Tribe has had both a singles player and a doubles team in the NCAA Individual Championships. Lauren Nikolaus was the last W&M player to garner a seed at the NCAA Championships before Moulton-Levy, also coming in at No. 8. Nikolaus and Michelle O were the last Tribe doubles team to garner a seed at the tournament as a No. 5-8 choice.

ON THE SHORT LIST

Senior Megan Moulton-Levy and sophomore Katarina Zoricic are both on a short list of women's players who have advanced at the most recent national championship events. In fact, as a team, they are the only pair to advance to at least the semifinals of the first two national championship events this season. The W&M duo advanced to the semifinals of the 2006 All-American Championships in October, before winning the ITA National Indoor title in November.

Moulton-Levy is the only player nationally to advance to at least the quarterfinals of the last three national championship events, dating back to last season's NCAA Singles Championships. She became the first W&M player to make it to the semifinals of the NCAA Singles Championship last season. This season, she made it to the quarterfinals of the All-American Championships, before advancing to the semifinals of the ITA National Indoor Championships.

REGIONAL AWARDS ROLLING IN

The awards continued to roll in for All-American Megan Moulton-Levy. The senior captain was named the 2007 East Region Senior Player of the Year and the East Region Arthur Ashe Award winner for Leadership and Sportsmanship by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) on May 14. It marks the second straight season in which Moulton-Levy has received the regional Arthur Ashe Award, and she became the first W&M player to earn region player of the year honors since Lauren Nikolaus in 1998. The Monroe, Mich., native went on to win the national ITA/Arthur Ashe Award for Sportsmanship and Leadership last season.

Moulton-Levy is now one of eight finalist for both the national ITA/Arthur Ashe Award and the national senior player of the year award. The winners of the national awards will be announced on May 22 in Athens, Ga. It marks the fourth time in which a W&M player has received the

ITA East Region Senior Player of the Year honor. Along with Moulton-Levy and Nikolaus, Johanna Sones (1997) and Karen van der Merwe (1993) also received the distinction. Nikolaus went on to be named the ITA National Senior Player of the Year.

MOULTON-LEVY NAMED MOP

Senior Megan Moulton-Levy was named the Most Outstanding Performer of the 2007 Colonial Athletic Association Women's Tennis Championship for the second time in her career. The Monroe, Mich., native also received the honor in 2005. She helped lead the Tribe to its 19th CAA Championship when W&M defeated No. 26 VCU, 4-0, on April 22. During the CAA Championship, Moulton-Levy went 3-0 in doubles and 1-0 in singles.

At the CAA Championship, Moulton-Levy and Zoricic defeated a pair of First-Team All-CAA doubles teams in Georgia State's Dariana Kozmina and Rachel Malina and VCU's Olga Borisova and Marianna Yuferova. The Tribe pair started the championship match against VCU with a convincing 8-2 win over the No. 6-ranked VCU tandem, helping the College captured the opening point of the match. Despite only going 1-0 in her CAA singles matches, Moulton-Levy led her other two matches by a set, including a 6-4, 3-3 lead over No. 25 Tatsiana Uvarova of VCU as the Tribe clinched the victory in the title match.

KNOCKING OFF No. 1

The Tribe defeated the second No. 1 ranked team in school history, defeating then-No. 1 Georgia Tech, 4-3, in Champaign, Ill., on Feb. 10. On the strength of a gritty effort from sophomore Katarina Zoricic, the Tribe knocked off the USTA/ITA National Indoor Champion Yellow Jackets.

With the match even at three, Zoricic was not only locked into a battle with No. 25-ranked and reigning ACC Player of the Week Kirsten Flower of Georgia Tech, but fighting severe cramping in her legs as well. Despite cramping during the second set and battling the injury following every point in the decisive third, Zoricic clinched the Tribe upset claiming the three-set match, 7-5, 5-7, 6-2. The College knocked off then-No. 1 Georgia, 5-4 in Athens during the 1995 season.

The College opened the match by claiming the doubles point. The nation's top-ranked team of Zoricic and senior Megan Moulton-Levy continued to dominate the competition at the No. 1 slot, de-

feating Kristi Miller and Whitney McCray, 8-4. After the Yellow Jackets pulled even in doubles with a win at the No. 3 spot, the freshman duo of Ragini Acharya and Magdalena Bresson clinched the vital point, downing Amanda Craddock and Flower, 8-6, at the No. 2 position.

W&M received singles wins from Acharya at the No. 3 slot as she swept No. 95 Christy Striplin, while Moulton-Levy rallied from a set deficit to knock off No. 15 Miller. Georgia Tech was coming off winning the USTA/ITA Indoor National Championship on Feb. 4 with a 4-2 win over Notre Dame. During its run to the title, the Yellow Jackets defeated four top-15 teams, including then-No. 1 Stanford in the semifinals. The victory over the Cardinal snapped Stanford's NCAA record 89-match winning streak.

TOP OF THE CHARTS

Senior Megan Moulton-Levy and sophomore Katarina Zoricic won the program's second individual national championship in November, claiming the ITA National Indoor Doubles Championship. Following the victory, the pair moved into the perch of No. 1 in the country in doubles. The Tribe duo has held true to the position, residing in the spot throughout the spring dual-match season. Moulton-Levy and Zoricic are 40-2 as a team this season.

RECORD WERE MADE TO BE BROKEN

School records have been falling by the wayside all season for the Tribe, both as a team and as individuals. The College opened the season with 11-straight victories, marking the most consecutive victories to open a season in school history. Included in those 11 victories was a win a then-No. 1 Georgia Tech in Champaign, Ill., on Feb. 10.

The Tribe's terrific tandem of senior Megan Moulton-Levy and Katarina Zoricic eclipsed a few school marks during the season. The pair became the first W&M pair to earn a No. 1 ranking nationally and also became the first to earn the top seed at the NCAA Championships. The duo won a school-record 24-straight doubles matches on their way to a program-best 40-2 doubles mark.

Freshman Ragini Acharya got into the act as well in record-breaking fashion. The Pulaski, Va., native is currently riding a 27-match singles winning streak. She is a perfect 23-0 in dual matches and has not lost a contest since Nov. 11. Acharya's

MOULTON-LEVY FINALIST FOR THE W&M SENIOR FEMALE ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

Senior Megan Moulton-Levy was one of three finalists named of the AEF Outstanding Female Senior Athlete of the Year. She is a three-time CAA Player of the Year earning her final honor this season. The two-time All-American is 29-6 in singles and 41-3 in doubles this season. She has been ranked among the top 10 nationally in singles throughout the season and currently resides at the No. 8 spot. Along with sophomore Katarina Zoricic, the pair is ranked No. 1 nationally in doubles. The duo is 40-2 overall, establishing a school record for wins by a doubles teams. The tandem has held down the No. 1 ranking throughout the spring season.

W&M DOMINATES CAA AWARDS

W&M dominated the Colonial Athletic Association post-season awards with six individuals earning All-CAA honors and the Tribe sweeping the three major awards. For the third consecutive season, senior Megan Moulton-Levy took home the CAA Player of the Year distinction, while freshman Ragini Acharya earned CAA Rookie of the Year accolades and head coach Kevin Epley garnered Coach of the Year honors. In the Tribe's 22 years in the CAA, W&M has garnered 124 All-CAA honors in singles and doubles, 15 CAA Player of the Year awards, seven Rookie of the Year awards and 11 Coach of the Year accolades.

Moulton-Levy continued her remarkable W&M career, becoming only the second W&M player to earn a trio of CAA Player of the Year honors. She joined Lauren Nikolaus in the exclusive club. Nikolaus won three CAA Player of the Year awards from 1996-98. On two occasions this season, Moulton-Levy has garnered CAA Singles Player of the Week honors.

Acharya became the seventh W&M player to earn CAA Rookie of the Year honors. It marked the second straight year in which the Tribe has taken home the CAA Rookie of the Year award after sophomore Katarina Zoricic earned the accolade last season. Acharya also took home First-Team All-CAA honors in singles. Epley took home his third CAA Coach of the Year honor in his four years with the Tribe. It marked the 11th time overall that a W&M

head coach has garnered the CAA Coach of the Year accolade. Including his time at Fresno State, Epley has earned conference coach of the year honors in five of his seven years as a head coach.

Moulton-Levy and Acharya were joined by Zoricic in earning First-Team All-CAA honors in singles and doubles. Zoricic is currently ranked No. 66 nationally in singles, playing primarily at the No. 2 singles position. It marks the second straight season in which Zoricic has earned First-Team All-CAA honors. Moulton-Levy and Zoricic also earned First-Team All-CAA honors in doubles for the second straight season.

Freshman Magdalena Bresson earned Second-Team All-CAA honors in singles. Bresson was joined on the second team by the doubles pair of sophomores Klaudyna Kasztelaniec and Barbara Zidek. It marked the first All-CAA honor in Kasztelaniec's W&M career, while Zidek earned her second All-CAA doubles nod. Kasztelaniec also earned Third-Team All-CAA honors in singles.

WINNING 20

For the 10th time in the last 13 seasons, the Tribe has won 20 or more matches in a season. The College is currently 22-2 after steamrolling the competition at the NCAA Regional. Under head coach Kevin Epley, W&M has posted 20-win seasons in three of four seasons. The 22 victories rank as the fifth most in school history, while the school mark is 25 set by the 2003 team.

FAB FOUR

A lot was made of Tribe's incoming freshman class as it ranked No. 2 nationally entering the season according to the Tennis Recruiting Network. The quartet of Ragini Acharya, Magdalena Bresson, Carmen Pop and Lauren Sabacinski has done little to disappoint in the rookie debuts. Combined the Fab Four have gone 97-26 (.789) in singles and 78-29 (.729) in doubles. The group's singles mark has increased during the dual-match season with a winning percentage of .821 (55-12). The quartet has won 47.5 percent of the Tribe's singles matches in 2006-07, including 52.9 percent during the dual-match season.
