Ristaucrat Appoints Two New Distributors

Hatcher Amusement Co. To Cover Western Half Of Kansas; Automatic Coin Machine Co. To Cover Eastern Half Of Kansas And Western Half Of Missouri

APPLETON, WIS. — Joe Cohen, head of Ristaucrat, Inc., this city, announced the appointment of 2 territorial distributors for the "Ristaucrat '45'" phono.

The western half of the state of Kansas is covered by Hatcher Amusement Company, 712 N. 11th St., Kansas City, Kansas, and is headed by H. D. Hatcher.

The eastern half of Kansas and the western half of Missouri is handled by Automatic Coin Machine Company, 13 W. Linwood, Kansas City, Missouri, and is owned by Victor H. Ross.

Cohen is particularly pleased with these two firms. "Hatcher started off very conservatively with our 'Ristaucrat '45'" phono" said Cohen. "He tried various locations as he went along and learned, as we had informed him, that the teenagers were the best customers and that two plays for five cents was what they wanted. He has steadily increased his route, and today is leading in purchases of our phonograph in his part of the country. All because he found that the low cost of our phonograph, plus the fact that it offered everything the players wanted in better tone music, quickly paid for itself, and continued to show him increasing profits as time went on."

Hatcher will now contact other op-

erating firms in his territory, devoting a great deal of time to the distribution of the "Ristaucrat '45'" phono.

"Automatic Coin is also doing a fine job, and we are happy to see his sales mounting rapidly," said Cohen.

Discussing the success of operators thruout the country with the "Ristaucrat '45'" phonograph, Cohen displayed a letter he received from Ed Lechner, well known music operator of Mayville, Wis., who was among the very first to purchase these phonos. He stated that he paid for his first machine in less than four months.

"Lechner's experience is only one of many," stated Cohen. "We have reports in our offices where operators have paid for their machines in two, three and four months' time. This is not all unusual. In fact, here is a letter from an operator who has been following our suggestion to get into teenager spots and feature two plays for five cents, who has paid for over ten of our phonographs in less than three months. The reasons are simple. The phono is priced low and the 45 RPM records last longer than the average disks, thus permitting the operator to more rapidly amortize the cost, and get more plays for less record costs."

World Wide Distrib To Spring Surprise

CHICAGO—"In just a short while we'll have an announcement to make that will prove a real surprise to the industry," stated Al Stern, head of World Wide Distributors, this city.

This statement was made following a conference of the firm's executives, who in addition to Stern, included Leonard Micon, general manager; Monty West, sales manager; and Bernie Auerbach, manager of the premium department.

Meanwhile, according to Micon, sales of Keeney's "League Bowler" and Williams' "Double Header" are surpassing all expectations. "Why," says Len, "grosses keep right on mounting up with the weeks."

Sale of used machines are more than brisk, according to Stern, with demand from coin firms thruout the country keeping all busy trying to secure the necessary machines to fill orders. However, Micon chipped in, "Our men are out on the road and are buying machines we need, in addition to their selling chores. We'll keep our customers supplied as long as it is humanly possible."

Department of Commerce under which the association acts as Procurement Cooperating Agency for clearance of information relating to purchases made by the Department of Defense and the General Services Administration of the United States Government.

Route Prices Keep Increasing As Demand For Equip Jumps And Biz Improves

CHICAGO — Information has reached here to the effect that route prices, especially in rural areas, have started upward, and are continuing to go higher, than what many believed would be the case.

In an effort to obtain equipment, it is believed, many coinmen have dashed out to the rural areas, to meet with ops who have routes that are confined to the small towns as well as in scattered country areas.

The result has been to fire these men with the belief that the price of their equipment has zoomed many times its original cost.

Not only have rural route prices hiked up accordingly, but, city routes, too, have zoomed in price.

Many operators are now asking prices that are 40% and even more, above what was asked for the same routes, prior to the Korean incident.

Demand for the latest model used machines have driven many to the rural areas, in an effort to dig these machines up on trade-ins against new equipment.

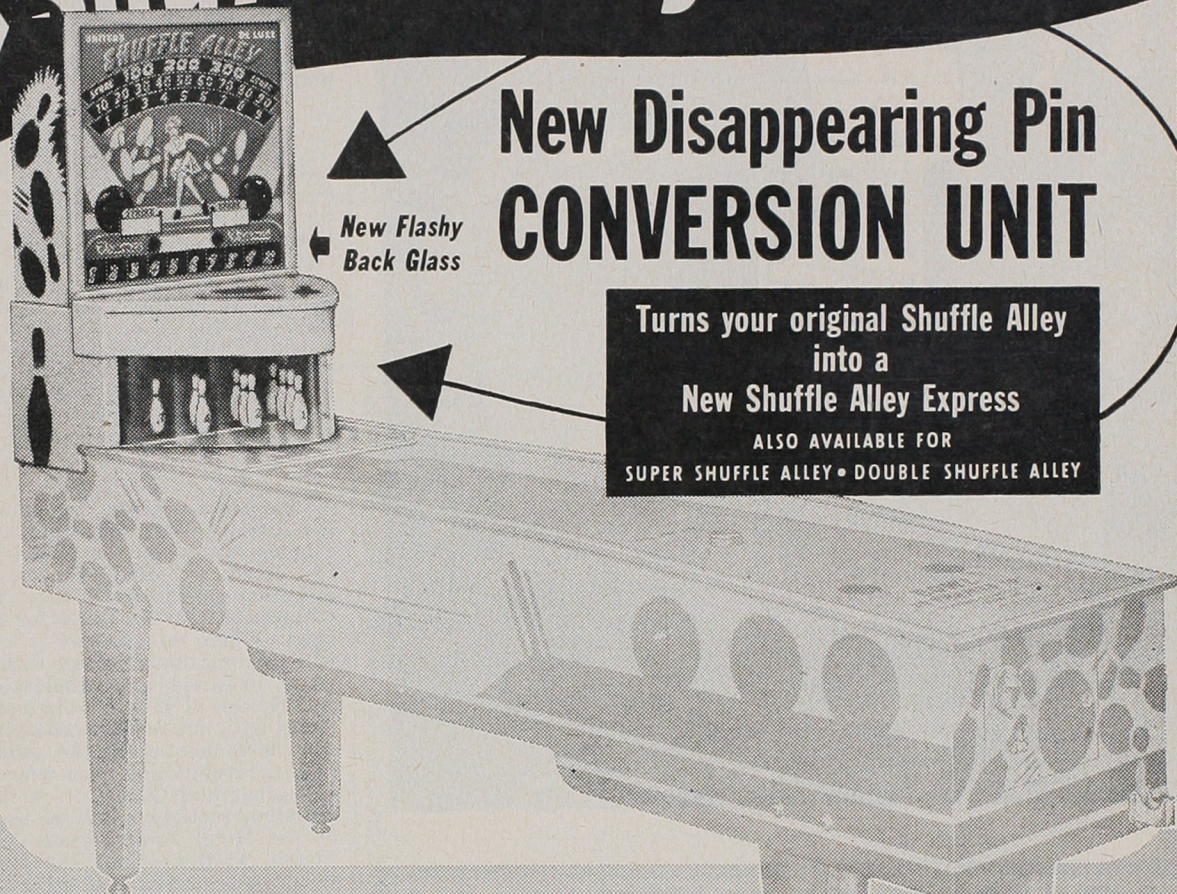
The result is that the average operator is now holding onto whatever he has and wants even more, foreseeing that his route as a unit, will be worth a lot more than what he could obtain for the sale of its individual machines.

Whatever the resultant effect, it is definite that route prices will continue upward, as used machine prices go up, and the new equipment is boosted in price due to higher costs for materials and labor.

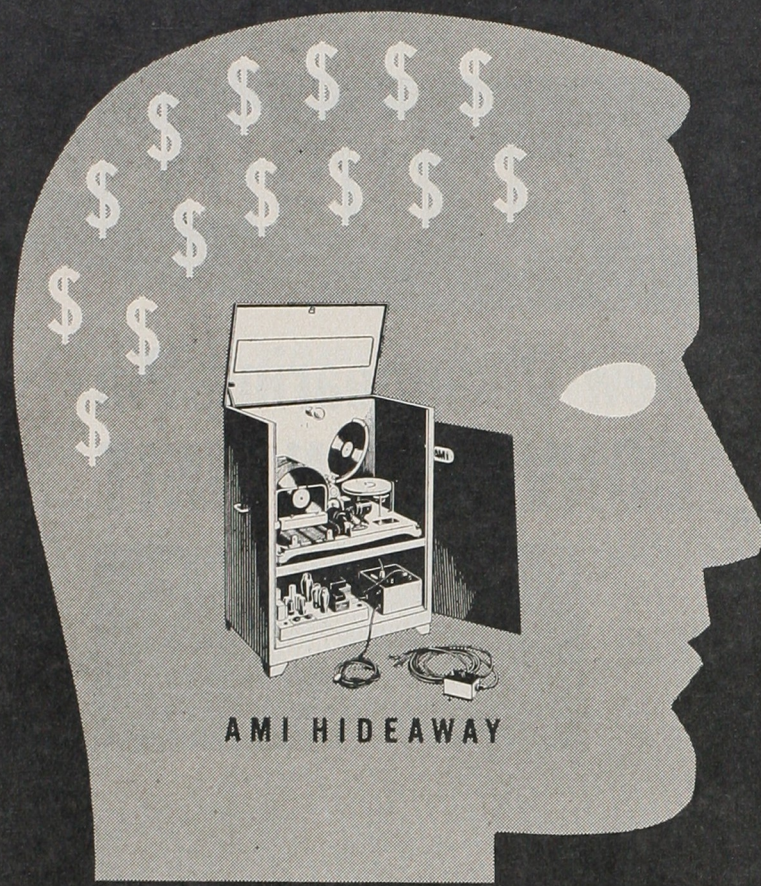

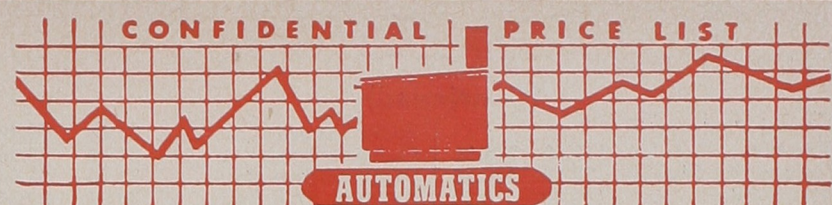

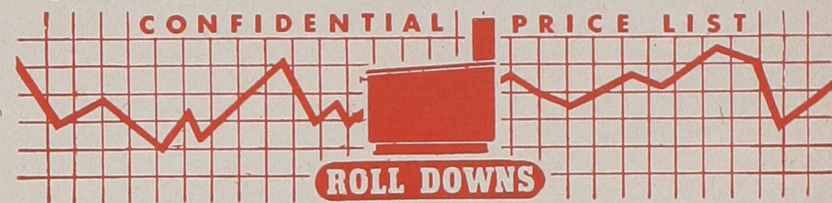
