

# FEAR POST-ELECTION CONTROLS

## Industry Is Concerned About Forthcoming Stringent Controls. Believe New Machines Production Will Be Severely Slashed

CHICAGO — After the many months of warning-articles which have appeared here, it was unusually interesting for your reporter to cover this area and learn, at this late moment, that a realization has developed in a great many members of this industry regarding forthcoming, stringent, post-election controls.

Word has been emanating from Washington almost daily to this effect. It is a well-known fact among the nation's manufacturers.

Yet, it seems few cared to believe in the facts which were staring them in the face and, further, which were being openly announced.

There is definitely no doubt that this, and many other industries, face the most stringent sort of controls from Washington immediately after the elections are over, and political campaigns have simmered into nothingness.

It was learned, from phone calls to the Chicago offices of *The Cash Box*, from leading ops in this area, that they are holding on to used machines which they would ordinarily trade in at this time of the year.

They are holding on to this equipment, they claim, "For," they state, "if these stringent controls do come into effect, these machines will be

worth much more money and will, at the same time, help us keep going, while, on the other side," they state, "distributors and jobbers are giving us the short-end of the trade-in price at this time."

"So," as some stated, "we may as well hold on. The trade-in price certainly can't go any lower than at present. And," they believe, "it surely can go lots higher."

Now there are current rumors that production may be "severely slashed."

Such statements have already come from Washington agencies and, therefore, it certainly is surprising to hear them for the first time being stated by men who are supposed to be able to foresee general conditions.

Some distributors, tho, are holding on to whatever good used equipment they have, and won't let go, "Unless we get our price."

They, too, like the operators, believe that prices can "only go up" and that as long as they can hold out, they should do so. They foresee a more active and higher priced used market ahead.

It will be interesting, therefore, to watch the reactions as controls come into being, more severe controls and for a longer period of time, than any now foresee.

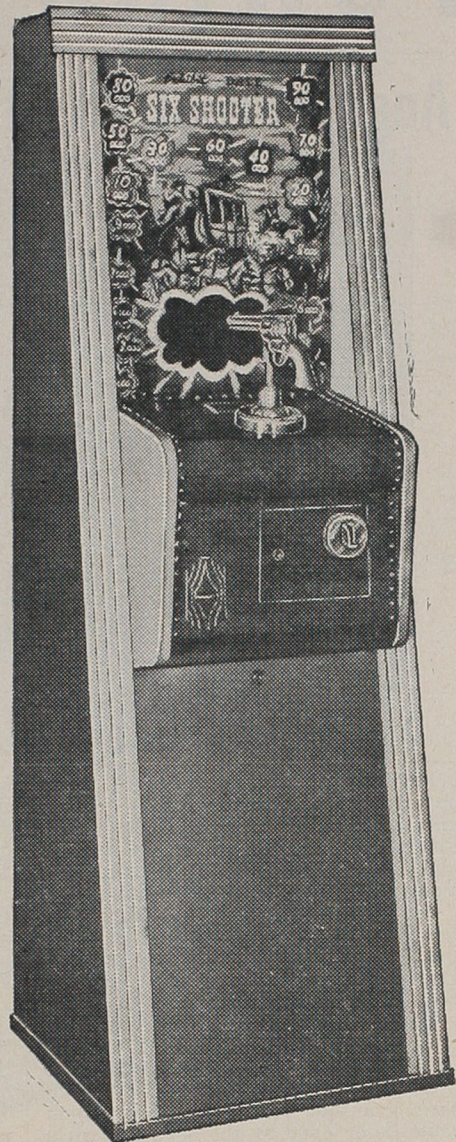

## Mfrs And Distribs Report Sales Up Past Week With Indications Upswing To Continue

CHICAGO—Thruout this city, coin center of the world, business enjoyed a very definite upswing this past week.

All indications point to better business from now on in.

Belief here is that this is due to the fact ops and distribs have aroused themselves to the very apparent facts which are before them in all the press.

With outstanding business journals reporting that Chinese communist intervention in Korea has suddenly spurred preparatory efforts and that controls will be placed into effect much sooner than expected, many now, at long last, realize that whatever equipment they can quickly stock may be the backbone of their business for sometime to come.

There was a sudden buying wave noted at the beginning of last week. Distribs and manufacturers were surprised with sudden orders from areas they never expected to receive business from at this time.

Even the most pessimistic admitted that the upswing was at last under way.

One factory stated that they had hit a low point two weeks ago, and were rather upset and troubled over its cause.

This past week, this same factory stated that biz suddenly jumped, and that each business day orders were

received forcing their production lines to step up.

New products are also expected to have a good effect during this business upswing. Many of these have been warmly received.

The trade feels, many claim, that the time to buy is now, and that there isn't too much time left before factories start tooling for defense work.

"There has been a very definite pickup in business all down the line for all of our products," Pieri reported.

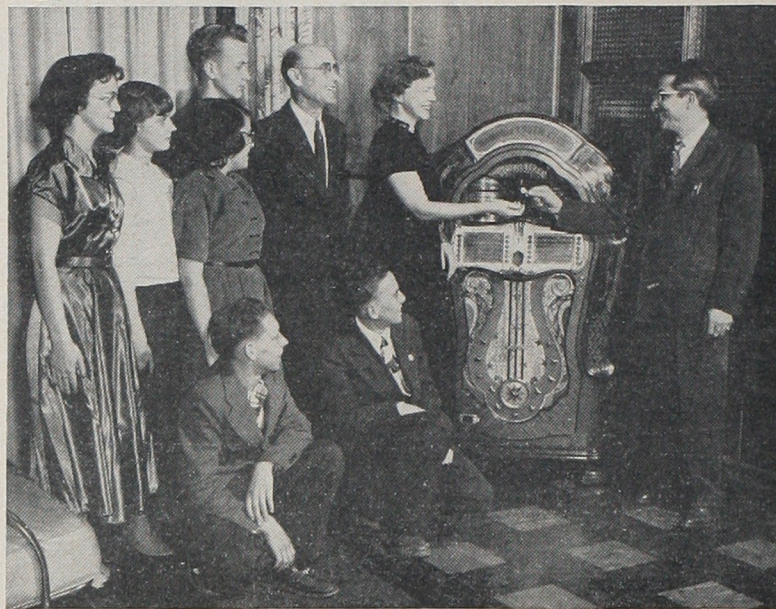
He also stated, "I believe that from now on in all distributors and operators realize that whatever they can get at this time may be the backbone of their business for sometime to come."

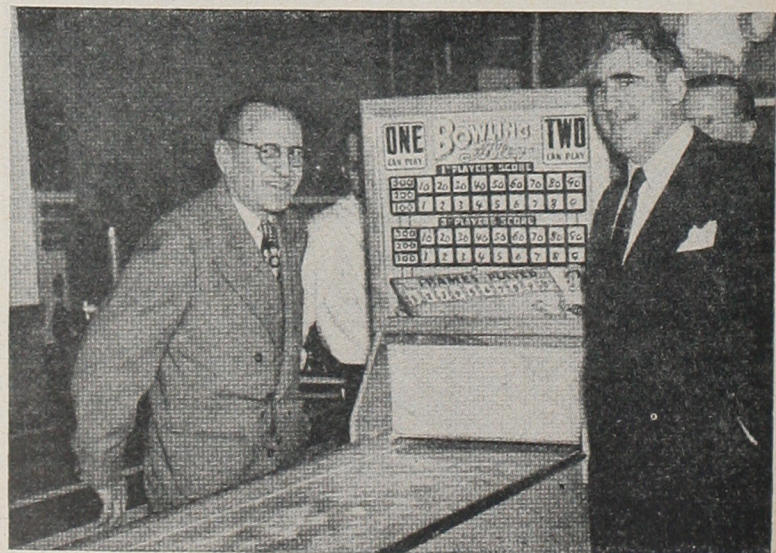

The lengthy article went into quite a bit of detail as to the size

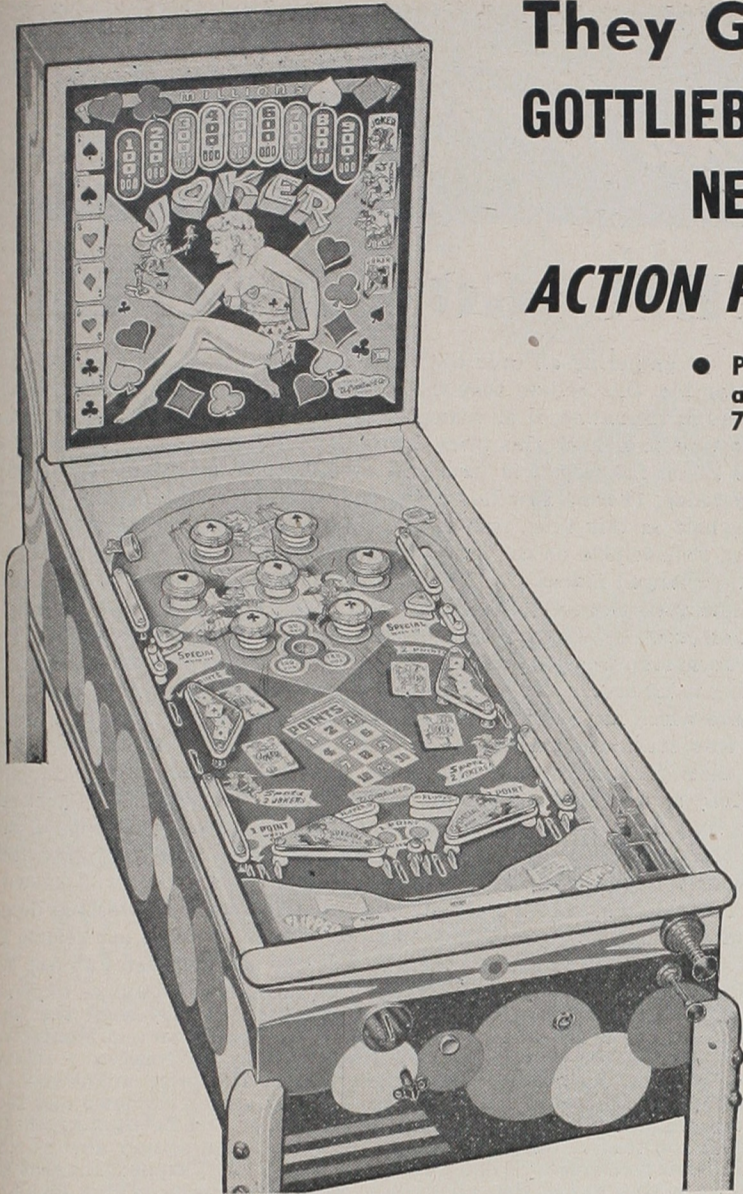
of the games, description of the playfield, method of operations of the coin trade, locations preferable, and some of the problems of the operators.

Will Return In Feb. For 400 More

NEW YORK—France is another foreign market sellers of used five-ball games can add to the growing numbers available since the termination of the past world conflict.

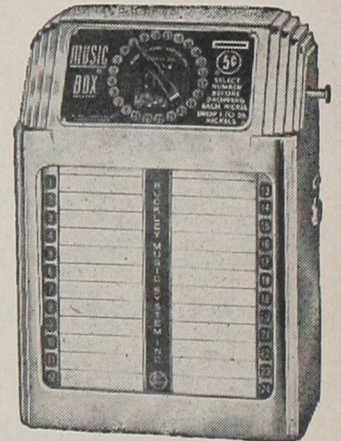
Fernand Goubert of 11 Square Carpeaux, Paris, France, visited *The Cash Box* offices this week, and reported that the French government had just issued a license to him to import five-ball games, and that operations in France will take on great activity, with the limitation that all equipment used be for "amusement only."

Goubert, who had already visited some wholesalers in Philadelphia and Baltimore, where he had bought a number of games, will be covering Grand Rapids and Detroit, Mich., Chicago and Milwaukee. He then returns to New York City on November 20, and will leave for Paris on November 29.

Before returning to his homeland, Goubert will have purchased 20 pin games, and when he returns to the United States in February, he will be ready to buy 400 more games.

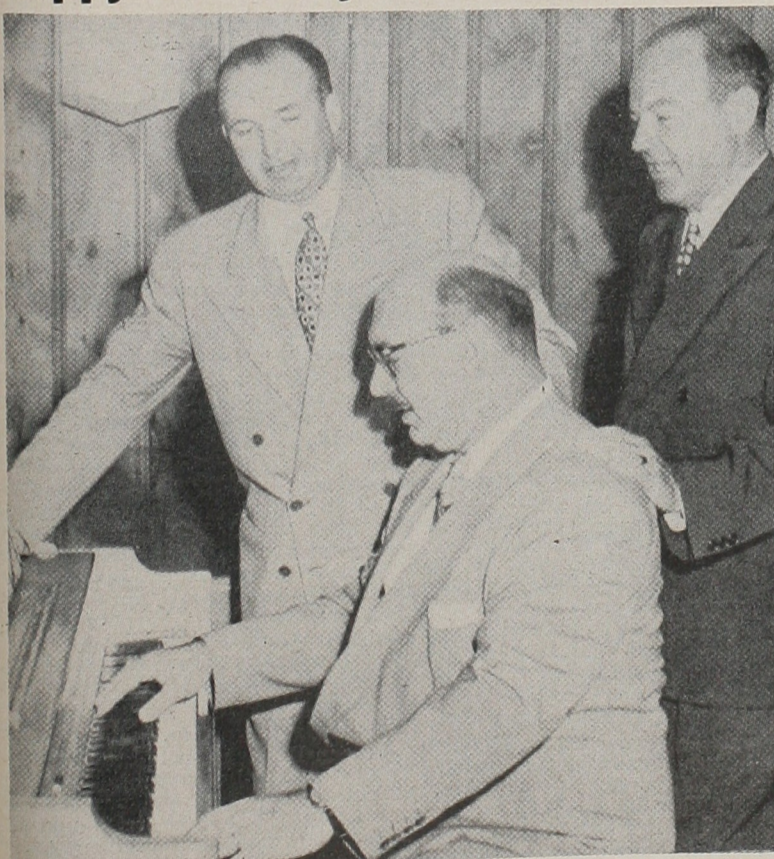

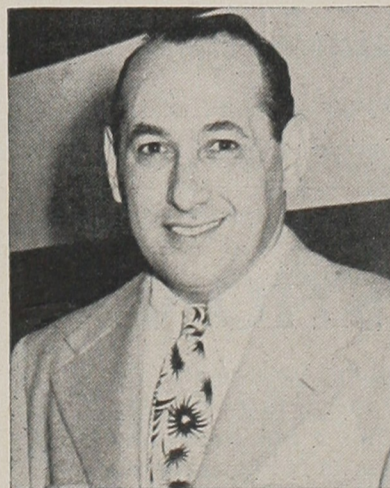

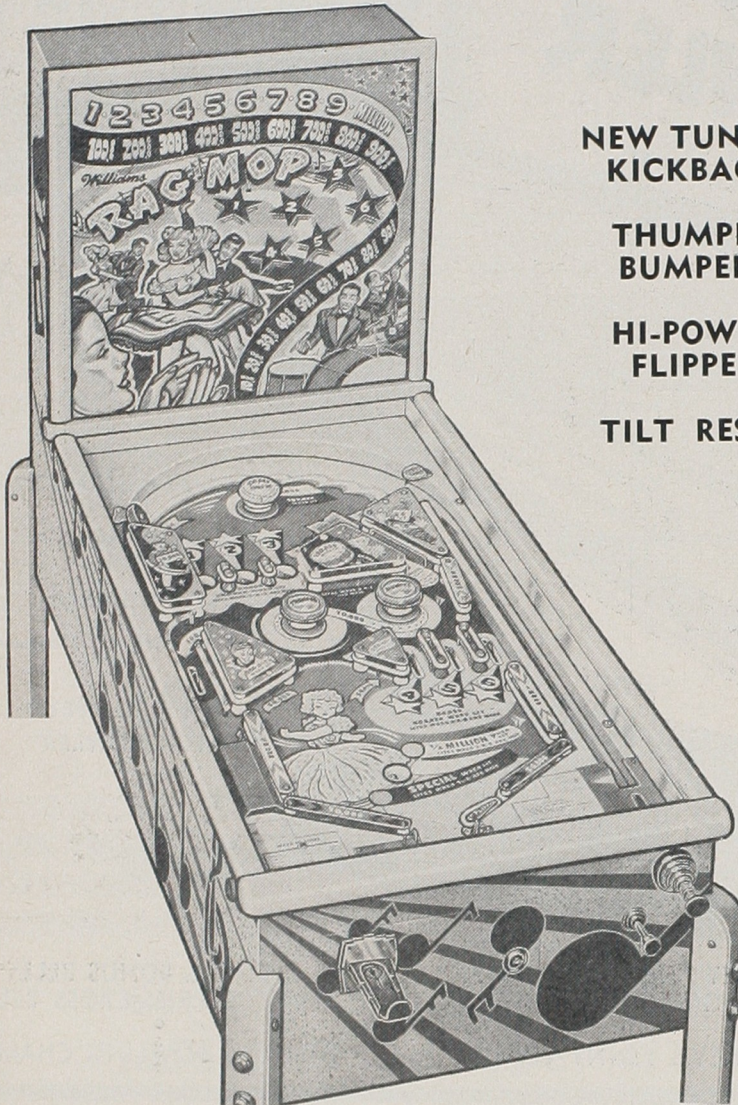

Of course, condition, serial, appearance, demand, territory, quantity, etc., must all be taken into consideration. "The Confidential Price Lists" reports each quotation exactly as it is made and depends on the subscriber to make average price adjustments to fit the peculiarities of his territory.

METHOD: "The Confidential Price Lists" should be read as follows: First price listed is lowest price for the week; Second price listed is highest price. Where only one price appears this should be considered lowest price.
