James Grant and Bethu's Woods agree as follows: The said
 said Grant contract and engages to build a logg house
 for the said Woods of the following dimensions and to
 finish the same on or before the first day of October
 next. The said Grant is to build a logg house the loggs
 wherof is to be 22 feet long and 18 feet wide to be thought
 and one being and being on each side after raising
 and being with good top strength and the height
 and breadth being with blocks. The said Woods is to
 find nails for the same. The said Grant is also to lay the
 down floor with shand shingles to be well done and
 to build a chimney the fire place wherof is to be
 six feet wide at the back and to lay it with a
 back wall and shank and good the same with
 is to make a better hand and also the gables ends high
 they are made to be set out one above in front
 they are made to be set out one above in front
 and make a hang a door with wooden hinges is to
 be and the first in the raising of the house and
 to raise the said house so as to leave no way or back
 and is to raise the house one story and a half high
 and the down story 8 feet high the other 4 1/2 feet
 say the high stink work is to be done within the time in
 the high stink work is to be done within the time in
 a workman like manner - within the time in
 the said Woods engages on his part in consideration
 of the said house being built as aforesaid. And to be
 raised on a debt in the town of Woodfield which shall
 be pointed out to the said Grant. That he will pay
 him forty dollars one piece of silver 34 dollars
 and a half at N. Wells at after dollars the reason
 advanced at N. Wells is to pay in each kind
 of the forty said Woods is to pay in each kind
 twenty five dollars within one month this 23rd day of
 June 1813 -
