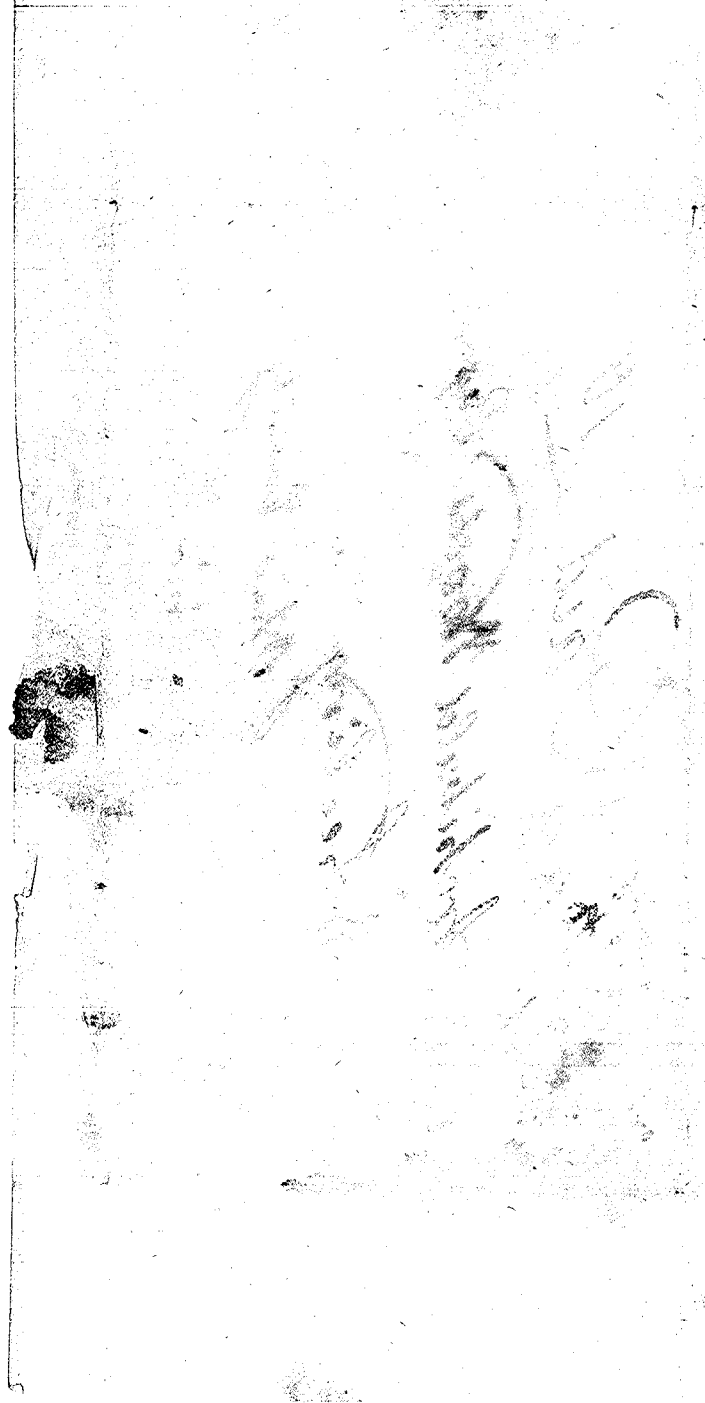
Woodsfield Oct 26th 1819

Col. Woods Sir,

since Mr. Okey has returned he tells me that you and he could not agree about my notes and he also told me that he thought that you would give up my notes and one hundred Dollars for ~~the~~ ^{my} ~~lot~~ ^{lot} & house in town to me, & if you will you shall have it, the reason that I did not propose it to you when I last saw you was that I thought I had offered it to you on the other terms. since you was here I have been offered 5 one hundred Dollars in specie down, for the bare house without the lot and the man would take the house off from the lot but I thought that would not suit you as he would give he unable to pay you for the lot. Sir if you conclude to take it at this proposal please to send me word as soon as possible.
