Dear Sir having learned of Mr May  
in answer to how sent by him to you  
that you wished us to write to you and let you  
know ~~what~~ what terms we proposed to  
take your house and lot in this place  
we will now let you know on what  
conditions would be willing to buy it

We would be willing to pay you six hundred  
dollars with interest from the first <sup>a next</sup>  
possession to be given on that day;

as follows one year want of ~~one~~ <sup>one</sup> hundred and  
fifty dollars in one year <sup>from the time of</sup> getting the  
property and one hundred and fifty dollars  
yearly after that. We will pay interest on  
(all that is not paid) from the time <sup>of getting</sup> possession  
if these terms suit you you will please write  
as soon as possible to us or ~~to us~~ <sup>to us</sup>.

this is all we can do we felt a disposition to  
try to pay for the property <sup>and</sup> therefore we  
will make no big offers nor <sup>shall</sup> what we  
can meet if you conclude to let us have it  
we want to know soon as we wish to put up a shop  
by the first spring by attending to this you
