Sir

The Situation of the Public Hospital for Lunatics, has made it necessary for the Court of Directors, to request the Attention of the Legislature. The Failure of the Fund, from which, the Means of supporting so truly laudable & humane an Institution, were to have been drawn, has entirely frustrated the generous Views of yr. last Assembly. The Directors were, therefore, compelled to come to the Resolution, which I have now the Honour to transmit, & they doubt not, from the Importance of the Object, but that it will be deemed by yourself & yr Hon^{ble} the Assembly, to be worthy of Consideration.
