

Give immediate notice to Mr Tritty,
and the person he hath assigned the
bonds to, that there is a suit depending
in the general court to subject the land
you purchased from him to the pay-
ment of a judgment recovered by
the King against Thomas Tritty;
and, if Mr John Tritty will not ac-
cant the bargain, and deliver up your
bonds for payment of the purchase-
money, which I would advise you to
propose to him, inform him that you
will not pay the money, ^{until} the suit be
ended, or you can be satisfied that you
will not be eviled. If John Tritty
or his assignee should bring a suit for
the purchase money, you should im-
mediately apply for an injunction; to
obtain which you must in the secre-
tary's office give security for the debt
damages and costs he may recover of
you.
