February 10th 1823

I am under the necessity of making application to you in favour of John Stepp for to get a longer time for him to make the money for you, he has paid last summer to George Paul Seventy six dollars which he has not got a receipt for, there is about 150 dollars due yet and he has a judgment against William King for upwards of 400 dollars which he ^{King} has appealed to the Supreme Court, with the view of getting delay. Stepp says he will transfer the said judgment for to make you safe. Mr Irwin has ordered an execution which if it goes on will strip him of all his property. If you could send on by the first of March to stay the Execution he will give any security to make it safe even if it is the whole of his judgment. our Court comes on the 7th of April next and ~~execution~~ will be issued thirty days before the Court. - I am Sir your with respect
