Monday, July 15, 1850 — I
arise at five. My time was
all occupied until the
usual hour for school;
then went to school; learned
my lessons and enjoyed
the day very well.

I have been attending
Mrs. S. M. Hubbell's School
one week.

16, — I was obliged to
spend the forenoon at
home, came to school in
the afternoon; learned
my lessons; and had a
happy day.

17. — ^{Was} late to school this morning, so, I was obliged to study very hard, in order to learn all my lessons. The weather has been extremely warm, and I am very tired, but not discouraged.

18. — I came to school this morning in season and happy: Engaged in my studies cheerfully, and have succeeded well.

19. — I arose at 6. My time in the morning was not quite all occupied. I came to school; was glad to meet my school-mat, learned my lessons

and feel much encouraged.

20. — As there has been no school I have not written any in my journal since Friday. I attended Church, & Sabbath School. Concert, Sunday, and, enjoyed the day very much. The day has passed of very pleasantness today.

21. — I did my morning work, then came to school and learned my lessons. This afternoon a Mr. Hubbard came and taught us to sing. we had a pleasant time.

24. I have attended school, pursued my usual studies, and had a happy day.

25. I have seated ^{myself} myself to write in my journal; but do not know what to write. I have been in school all day and am tired.

29. I attended a Picknick Saturday afternoon in the grove. We had a very pleasant time. After I came home it rained. I attended Sabbath School yesterday, but did not go to Church. I have been in school today, learned my lessons perfectly, and

enjoyed the day well.

31. I did ^{not} write in my journal yesterday. We had company in school and Mrs. Chubbell dismissed school before the hour for writing our journals, to visit with her brother from Syracuse.

It has been very cool yesterday and today.

Aug 1. I arose at an early hour, and was busy until school time. I had been in school all day, and have learned my lessons except my Geography lesson. I hope that will not be neglected again.

2 I came to school this forenoon, then went home and ironed; came to school in the afternoon, studied while the other scholars ~~th~~ wrote their compositions

3 I attended meeting ~~and~~ on Sunday and sabbath school. This morning I came to school and learned my lessons then I went home. Came to school this afternoon. We had a pleasant rain at noon, Mrs. ~~W~~ Hubblell had some calls from Mrs. Parsons Mr. Seymour and Mrs. O'Bryan Now I go home much pleased

4 I did not come ^{to school} yesterday. My mother wanted me to stay at home to help her. I thought I could come to school in the afternoon but we did not quite complete our work. My cat died with a fit and left two little kittens. I went to bed last night very tired.

5 I did ^{my} work this morning, then came to school. I have ^{been} at school all day and am glad to go home

6 I came to school recited my lessons very well I have not any more to write now I close my happy day.

12. — Saturday afternoon my
Cousins came to see me.
We had a pleasant visit.
Sunday, I went to meet-
ing, Sabbath School, and
the Sabbath School ~~quizzes~~
Concert. This morning,
I arranged my room,
helped ma what she
wished me to, and
then came to school,
have learned my lessons,
and am now ready to go
home, feeling that I have
enjoyed the day well.

13 — I was obliged to ~~be~~
stay at home in ~~effect~~
the forenoon to help
my ma wash. I came to
school in the afternoon,
but was sick and had

to go home and go to bed.
I was sick all night. My
ma thought I was going
to have the Cholera
Morbus, but I did not.

14 — I did not arise till a
late hour; but my
mother had breakfast ready.
I ate and then came to
school. Have not had one of
my ~~less~~^{ons} perfect to-day.

19 I have not written any
in my journal since
Thursday. Since that time
a small little brother has
come to our house.
I went to Church and
Sabbath School, Sunday.
This morning, I was

at an early hour. My
time was all occupied till
the hour for school.

I am going away after
school to spend the night.
I have had a pleasant
day to-day.

20 I arose at 6 did my
morning work, then came
to school. I had some
difficulty in getting my
dinner my fire would
not burn I was vexed
but soon got over it.
I set my dinner then
came to school. It has been
a rainy day I have
arranged my desk and
am now ready to go home
happy.

21 I was late to school
this morning, because
I had to go down street
and could not get back
in time, therefore my
lessons were not learned
very good. It has been a
very warm and pleasant
day.

22 I came to school
early. While we were reading
in History Miss Wright
and Miss Denton called.
I have not learned my
lessons very perfectly to-
day. The day has been
very warm but it has
not hindered me from
studying. Our new
window curtains make
our school room very

pleasant. I now go home
cheerful and happy.

29 My pa. was not
at home this morning,
my ma. called me
several times, but I was
so sleepy that I did
not ^{could} awake, then
my sister, when
she got up, she shook
me. Then I arose, was
sleepy yet, but soon
felt wakeful. I have
spent the day in school,
learned my lessons,
and go home cheerful.

so sleepy that I did
not awake

26. — I arose at an early hour
but my time was all
occupied. I cleansed the
school-room. Saturday,
after I had done my
kitchen work and was
very tired; then ma's
nurse went home to
visit her brother I went
to Sabbath school and
church Sunday.
A stranger preached. His
name was Mr. Wilkins.

24. — I was obliged to stay
at home this forenoon
to assist the lady
who is at work for ma
because ma is sick.

I have attended school this
afternoon, It has been
a pleasant and delight-
ful afternoon for study.
It has been a busy day,
and I am weary.

28, do not know what to
write. I have a severe
pain in my head.
Ma's nurse has gone
home to take care of
her daughter, who is
sick with the ague
and fever.
To-day is my sister's
birth day. I intend to have
some sport with her
after school.

29. — This forenoon
I was obliged to home to
take care of my, blessed
she is sick. This afternoon
came to school about
noon, there was a cry of
fire! fire! It was supposed
at first to be a house, but
it was only some outbuild-
ings. I am glad that it
was not a house, and
that no one ^{was} burned up

30. — The day has been cloudy.
I have spent it in
school and think I have
learned all my lessons
perfectly. Galley is the
appointed for the
execution of Professor Webster
for the murder of Dr.
Parkman. Oh! how sad his
children must feel

31. This forenoon I have been obliged to superintend the housework, because ma is sick, and have been and I have been rather unlucky. When I was placing Spice fires in the oven to bake I had the misfortune to spill some of the fill I must learn to be more careful, and I hope to as I grow older now I must hurry and prepare my self

Sept. 2. Sunday I attended Church and Eld. Smith preached from Acts. 20, 55. I came to school this morning cheerful and happy, ready to commend my studies for the week

The first class Monday morning is a ~~thir~~ ^{thir} ~~king~~ ^{king} class Our motto for last week was *aim at high and noble attainments.* We were all required to report what we thought we had attained during the past week.

3. It was necessary for me to stay at home yesterday, to aid in the work and take care of ma; but came to school this morning. On account of being having been absent, was obliged to ask where all of my lessons were; but I have learned them all perfectly. At recess we had fine amusement,
