



- A. Represents a white oak stake, at Frances Conways gate, on the lower side of Conways branch Corner to said Conway in Charles Sees purchase old line
- B. is 3 white oaks on the south side of a branch corner to St. Conway
- C. is 2 post oaks on a hill side in Conways line
- D. is a white oak & a small gum bush in a Valley corner to William Sees purchase
- E. is 2 Red oaks & a post oak near Sees fence in a valley
- F. is a Spanish oak & 2 Maples on the west side of Conways Mill Run just at the fork of Mill Run corner to Sees purchase
- G. is a sycamore stake on the west side of Mill Run corner in Conways line
- H. is a white oak & small gum bush on a hill side corner to Frances Conway
- I. is a large spanish oak on a ridge corner to said Conway
