General Regulations.

1. No Student shall, without permission, keep or shoot fire arms, or make loud noises. All fire arms brought to the College must be delivered to the Steward, who will give a receipt for them.
2. No Student shall play cards, or billiards, game, visit bar-rooms or places where liquor is kept for sale, keep or have intoxicating liquors in his room or possession, write upon the walls of the buildings, injure the property of the College or citizens, swear or use indecent language, or be guilty of any other conduct rendering him an unfit associate for young gentlemen.
3. Hazing or subjecting Students to degrading treatment in any form is strictly forbidden.
4. All Students are required to attend morning roll-call.
5. No Student, after the first week, shall drop any class without the consent of the Faculty.
6. No Student shall go more than six miles from the College without the consent of the Faculty.
7. Board must be paid promptly, monthly in ADVANCE.
8. The Steward and keepers of boarding houses, licensed by the Faculty are required to report all Students guilty of misbehavior in the dining rooms or of violating the rules of the College.
9. The throwing of water or papers from windows or rooms is specially prohibited.
10. Students are not permitted to congregate in each other's room.
11. No one will be allowed to matriculate without pledging his honor to observe these rules.
