William Rogers, died testate - see will recorded in York Co.

1. Had four half sisters, & brothers - viz, Lees, Gily, who married Henry Thompson - both dead, leaving children - viz.

one daughter, Frances.

William dead, Senie Rogan deatt - sold her interest  
to Cooper perhaps some others.

James, lives in Missouri, St. Charles County. Has  
given power of atty to Thomas Pullock deatt.
