Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Thomas Rollins all my estate and property be it what ever property or of whatever kind it may be it is my wish and desire that the said Thomas Rollins my son should have all that I possess or belonging to me to him his heirs or assigns forever should the above mentioned Thomas Rollins my son die without issue. It is my wish that the said property shall be left to Vincent Watkins to him his heirs forever should the said Vincent Watkins die without issue then the said property to be equally divided between William Watkins's children to them their heirs - executors administrators or assigns forever, and it is also my wish and desire that my son Thomas Rollins live with his grand Father Thomas Russel and his aunt Nancy Russel during Patsy Giddins living at York Town and I do hereby appoint my beloved friend William Puseon to be executor to this my last will and testament dated the 2^d day of June the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifteen signed sealed published and declared by the above mentioned Vincent Rollins to be his last will and testament in the presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the testator
