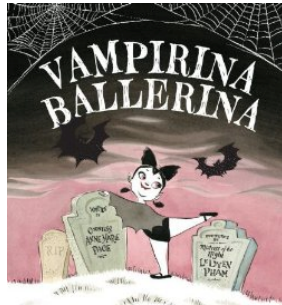

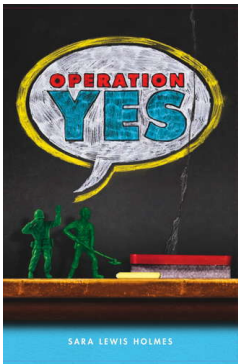
Celebrate Homecoming at Swem

- **Behind-the-scenes Tour of Special Collections:** 3 p.m. in the Special Collections Research Center, reservations required (swemrspv@wm.edu)



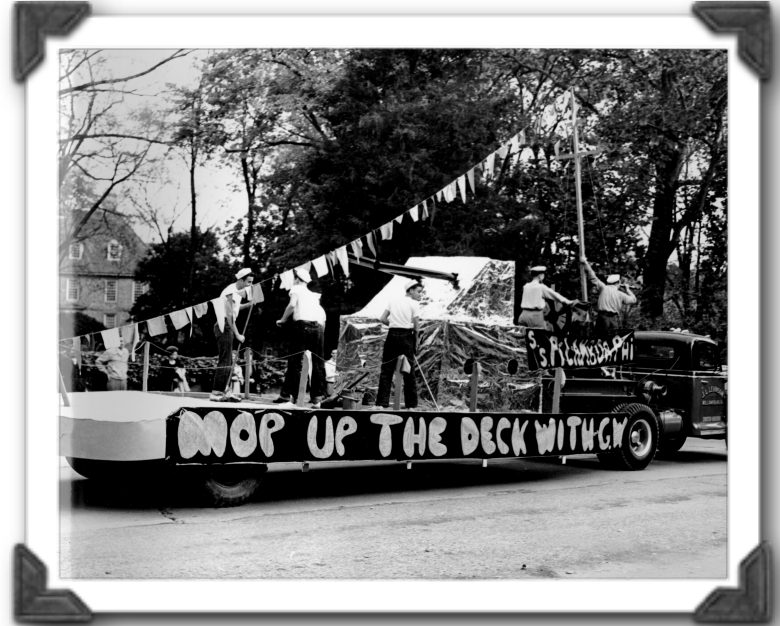
