To of which payment well & truly to be made We bind our selves & every of us, our & every of our heirs, Executors & Assigns jointly and severally firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals Dated this 22nd day of May 1716.

The condition of this obligation is such that whereas by Hon^{ble} Alexander Leiswood Esq^r his Maj^{ty}'s Govern^r of Virginia he authorized, Deputed & appointed of above Bounden Henry Tyle to be Sheriff of the County of York for a Year ensuing who was accordingly sworn in Court this day. Know ye therefore that if the said Henry Tyle do well & truly perform his duty & place of Sheriff of the County of York faithfully & justly according to the
