June 16. 1846

My Dr. Sir:

I have concluded to leave this
for East Hampton, where from her last letter
I presume Julia now is, on Monday
next (the 21st) and hope to reach New
York on Tuesday night in the cars from
Philadelphia. Will it subject you to
too much inconvenience to meet me
at the wharf on that night. I propose
to leave New York on the next morn-
ing for East Hampton. What say
you to remaining there for a day -

night, as I confidently expect to do,
I shall, accidents apart, certainly
reach on Wednesday -
