I shall be minus something for the difference in Exchange which when ascertained I will either remit or hand you when either Julia or myself shall visit you. But for my ill. health I had have brought bills in Richmond. but I could not get away from home and am even now writing you in pain having passed a terrible day yesterday. I am able this morning to walk about which I was not yesterday afternoon. and trust that I shall soon regain the ground which yesterday's attack caused me to lose.
