been elected Mayor.

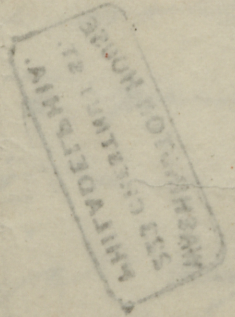
I hope to make a decent living
