Marsall & I am glad of it.

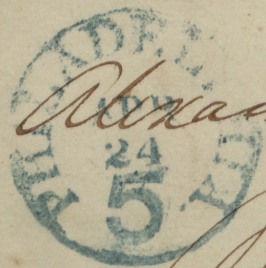
