he is now nor what he is doing.

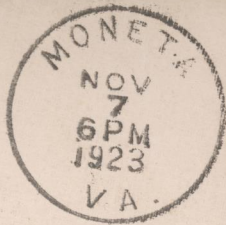
I wrote to B. L. James for blanks
