We have carefully examined the Vouchers for the respective charges which we found correct. and Examined also the amt. of the appraisement and account of sales together with other Credits appearing on the Books of the said Executor. The Debts against the Estate amount to three Thousand four hundred and eighty three Dollars seventy two cents which being taken from the credits herein stated leave a balance due from Joseph Pientis Executor on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1815 of nine hundred and sixty one dollars and nine cents which we Report to the Court.
