

Defendant vs Marburton.

This cause came on this day to be heard on the papers formerly read, and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court did not see anything any principle in the cause, with the assent of the parties, doth a o t d, that Wood Spencer pay over to the debt Marburton & Harris, all the proceeds of the sale made by him, except the proceeds of the land, such to take one half of such proceeds after deducting all proper expenses of the sale, to be accounted for by them hereafter in this suit. And the Court doth further a o t d that the said Wood Spencer at any time after the end of the present year, advertise & sell at public sale, on a credit of one year, with interest from the date, on Bond & approved security, the slaves Betty & her three children Maria, Edgar & Jenny, with liberty to the purchaser to have the Curb, if he shall think proper so to do, after giving twenty days previous notice of the time & place of sale. And if the said Spencer shall receive any money under this Decree arising from the sale then aforesaid, he is then directed to lend it out to the use of the debt Marburton & Harris, in such proportions as they may agree upon, on their executing Bond & approved security for the same. And the said Spencer is directed to make a report of his proceedings & of the former sale, in obedience to a final Decree.
